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Overview

Welcome to the Deltek Costpoint to Cobra Integration 2.0 Release Notes. The Costpoint to Cobra Integration Tool allows you to load the actual costs from Costpoint to Cobra. This tool is flexible and can be used to accommodate the highly configurable nature of both the Costpoint and Cobra systems.

Minimum System Requirements

This Deltek Costpoint to Cobra Integration release supports the following software versions:

- Costpoint 7.1.1, 7.0.1, or 7.0
- Cobra 5.1 (SP1) HotFix#11 – Build 5.01.1752 or later, Cobra 8.0

Features

Standard Integration

The Costpoint to Cobra Integration allows you to extract actual costs from Costpoint into a CSV file, which Cobra uses for reporting earned value and determining estimates to complete (ETC) and overall project health.

Cobra Extraction on Compute Cobra Burden Costs Screen


You can run the Cobra extraction process on the Compute Cobra Burden Cost screen of Costpoint. When you activate this feature, the Cobra extraction process runs after computing burden costs.

Integration through Web Services

The latest version of the integration leverages existing Cobra Web services when running the Compute Cobra Burden Cost process. You could set the invocation of the Cobra Web service to be asynchronous or synchronous on the Manage Cobra Extraction Parameters screen.



The legacy approach of running the integration through CostpointCobra.exe API is **no longer** supported in Costpoint 7.1.1. In addition, this method of integration was de-supported in Costpoint 7.0.1 as of **December 1, 2014**.



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
