**Description:** When the employee's leave type was set up with a compute method of **Units of Hours Worked**, and then the employee reached the end of the leave period, the deferred leave hours did not move to accrued leave if the employee did not have a timesheet for the period. The application also tagged the deferred leave that moved to accrued leave as DEFER instead of ACCRUAL.

**Description:** When you ran the Compute Leave Accrual process for multiple employees, later employees were applied the excess accrual amount from earlier employees. This occurred if the leave type **Year Option** of the subsequent employee was **Anniversary** and it was that employee's anniversary.

**Description:** When computing leave for more than one employee, if an employee processed earlier had a leave ceiling value for a leave compute method of **Annually on Hire Date** or **Annually on Block Grant Date**, later employees with ceilings applied were computed incorrectly.
