**Description:** When multiple checks with the same check date existed on the Manage Employee Earnings History screen and the checks had the same taxable and withholding or accrual amounts, the application computed incorrect YTD totals for local taxes using the YTD method. As a result, the Compute Payroll process calculated local withholdings after the ceiling was already met.
