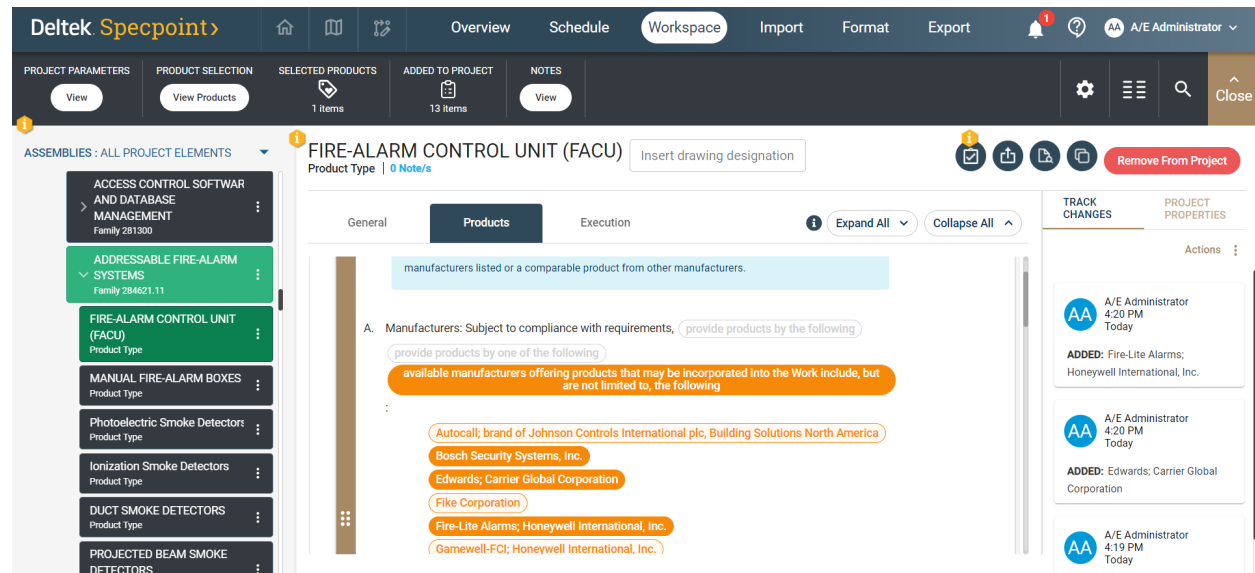

## Software Issues Resolved

This section includes summaries of the resolved software issues in this release.

### Removing Selected Manufacturers

**Bug 2016855:** When you cleared a selection from a given manufacturer in a manufacturer paragraph, navigated away, and returned to the project workspace, the manufacturer remained selected in the manufacturer paragraph. This issue applied only to the **Fire-Alarm Control Unit (FACU)** product type under the **284621.11 Addressable Fire-Alarm Systems** family.

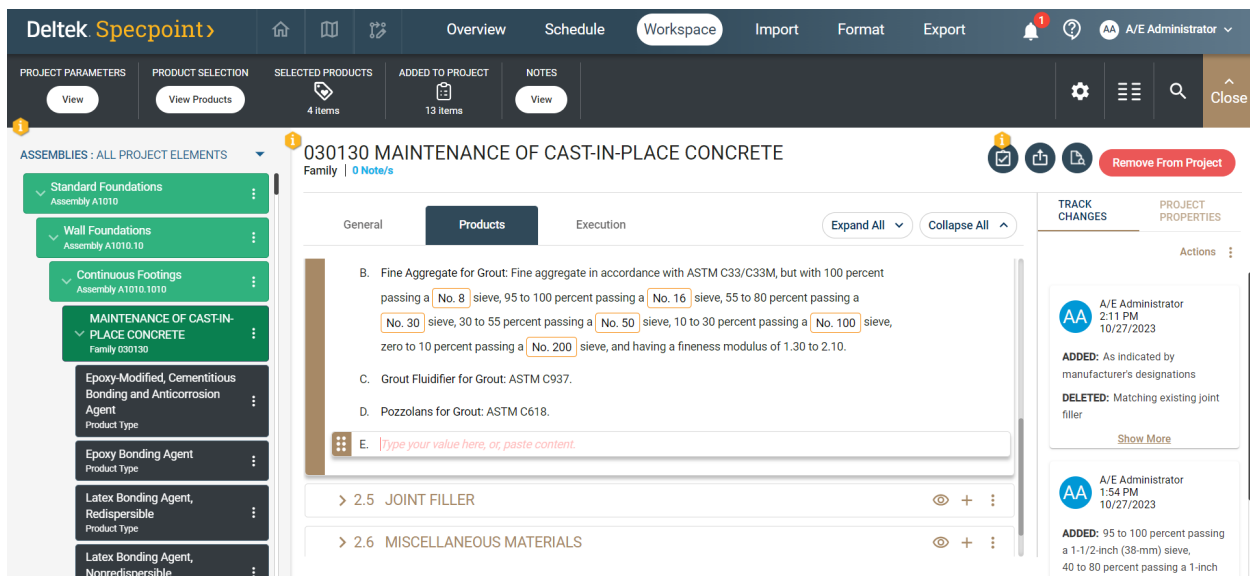

### Saving Changes in the Project Workspace


The project workspace now has improved performance in terms of saving content changes.

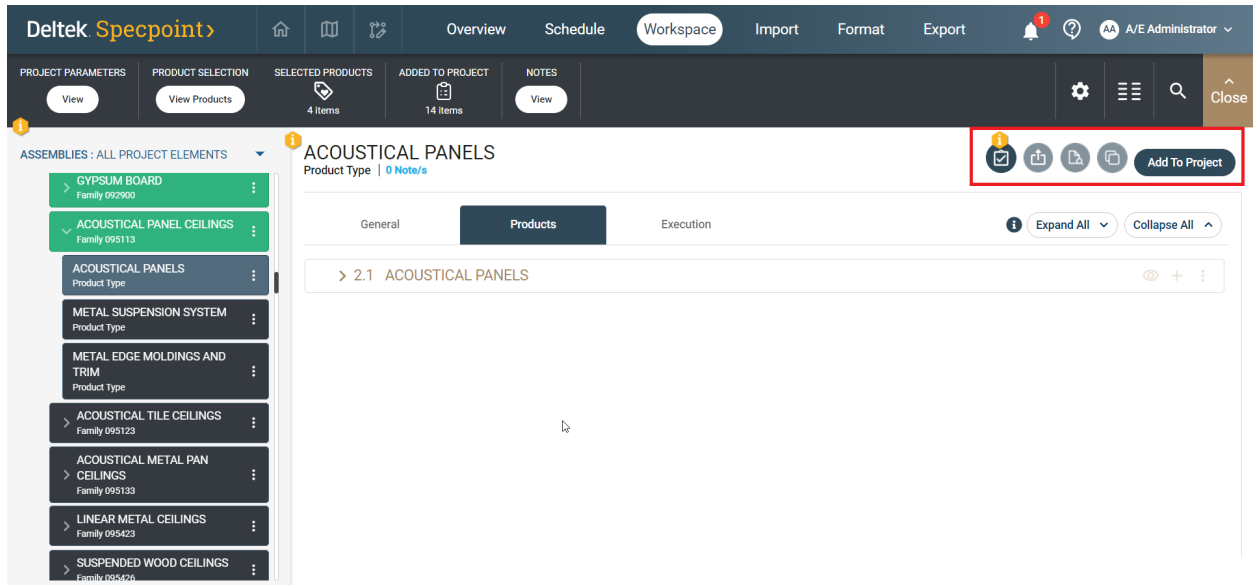


You will realize shorter saving times for the following changes:

- Adding new paragraphs/properties, which includes entering paragraph text
- Editing property keys and paragraph text
- Selecting option set items
- Entering custom entries in insert options
- Removing paragraphs/properties

### Supporting Documents for Unadded Elements

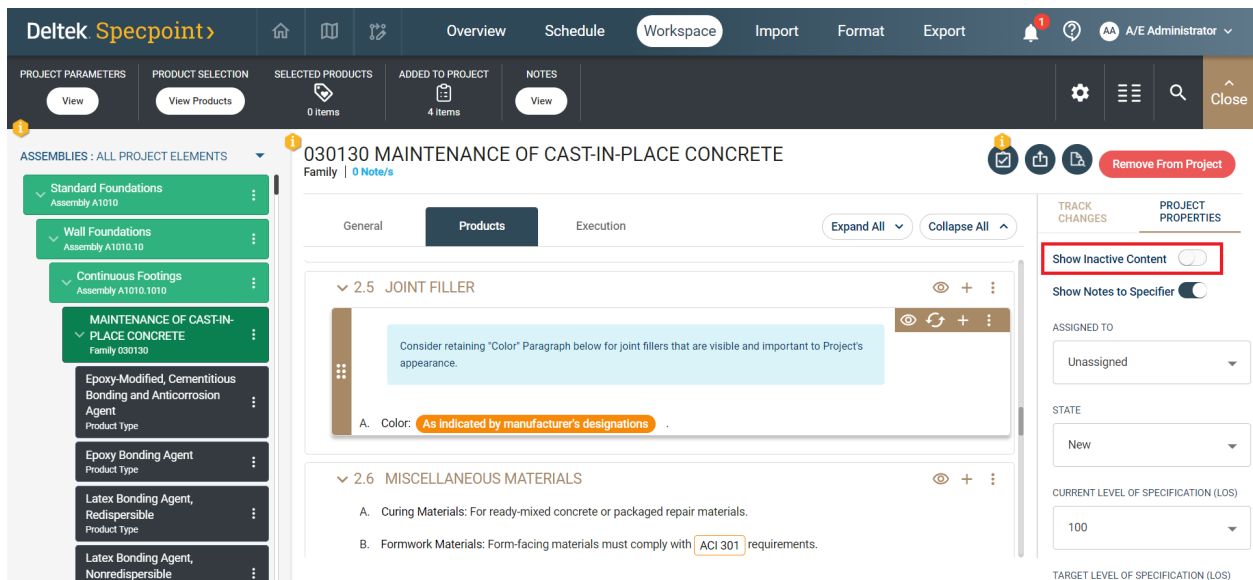
On the element form of the project workspace, the supporting documents button  is now available for families, sections, and product types that are not currently in your project.



You can now view supporting documents for unadded project elements. This enhancement enables you to view related guidance, research, and coordination checklists prior to adding a family, section, or product type into your project.

## Show Inactive Content Option

The **Show Inactive Content** option replaces the **Show Hidden Properties** option on the Project Properties tab of the project workspace. This option continues to hide inactive content items such as inactive articles and paragraphs. In addition, this option hides inactive or unselected option set items and insert options in paragraph option sets.

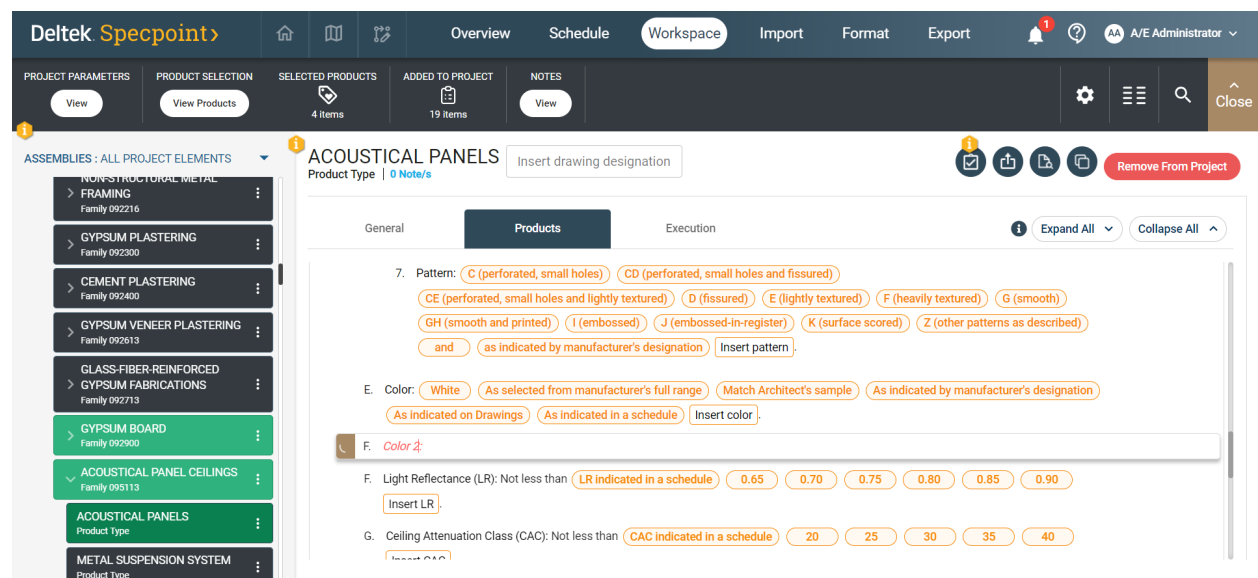

### Project Workspace

This section includes the descriptions of resolved software issues with working in the project workspace.

#### Unable to Modify Property Keys


**Bug 2014010:** When you added a new paragraph, entered a non-unique property key, and modified the property key to make a correction, the paragraph in the project workspace indefinitely remained in loading animation.



#### Unexpected Scrolling When Arranging Contents

**Bug 2005867:** When you arranged or re-ordered articles and paragraphs, the element form of the project workspace unexpectedly scrolled. This issue also occurred when you promoted or demoted paragraphs.

## Unexpected Scrolling When Hovering Over Contents

**Bug 2005872:** When you hovered your mouse over articles and paragraphs, the element form of the project workspace unexpectedly scrolled up and down.

## Unexpected Skipping When Scrolling Through Content Items

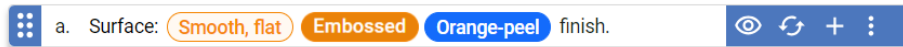
**Bug 2005872:** When you slowly scrolled through a family's or product type's content items, the element form of the project workspace unexpectedly scrolled faster and skipped articles and product types.

## Manufacturer Options and Manufacturer Product Types

This section includes the descriptions of resolved software issues with working with manufacturer options and manufacturer product types in the project workspace.

### Removing Selected Product Listings with Manufacturer Options

**Bug 1975859:** When you removed an added product listing that includes manufacturer options from your project, the platform did not automatically remove the added manufacturer property paragraphs and added manufacturer options in MasterSpec product type property paragraphs.




The platform should remove all manufacturer option-related content that no longer has an association with any added product listing with manufacturer options from your project.

### Automated Changes for Adding MasterSpec Only Product Listings

**Bug 1872143:** When you added product listings that include manufacturer options into your project and then you added a product listing with only MasterSpec options, the platform did not automatically remove all product listings with manufacturer options from the product type. The platform also retained the added manufacturer property paragraphs and added manufacturer options in MasterSpec product type property paragraphs.

### Missing In-line Text in Manufacturer Property Paragraphs

**Bug 1984383:** When you previewed a family or product type, the section preview did not display the in-line text of manufacturer property paragraphs or MasterSpec product type property paragraphs with manufacturer options.

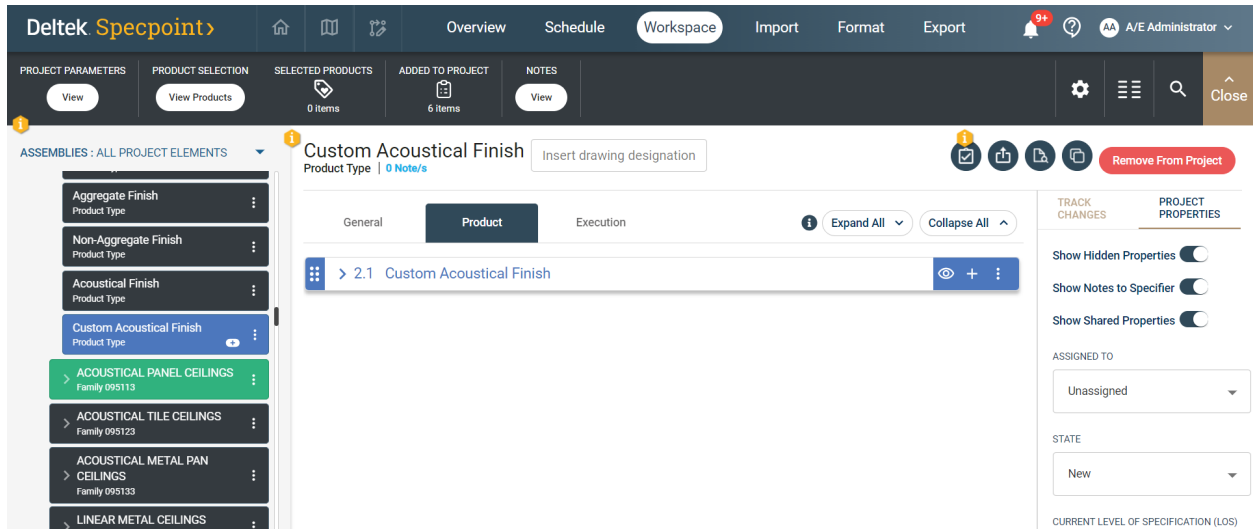
**Note:** In-line text displays before or after a paragraph's option set items and provides context or description to the property.

### Order of Manufacturer Property Paragraphs

**Bug 1972223:** When you added product listings that include manufacturer properties/options into your project, the platform automatically added manufacturer property paragraphs that are in the incorrect order based on the product properties list to your product type content.

### Moved Manufacturer Product Types

**Bug 1965457:** When a manufacturer moved a given manufacturer product type from under one family to another, the Project Elements pane of the project workspace continued to display the manufacturer product type under its previous family instead of its current family.

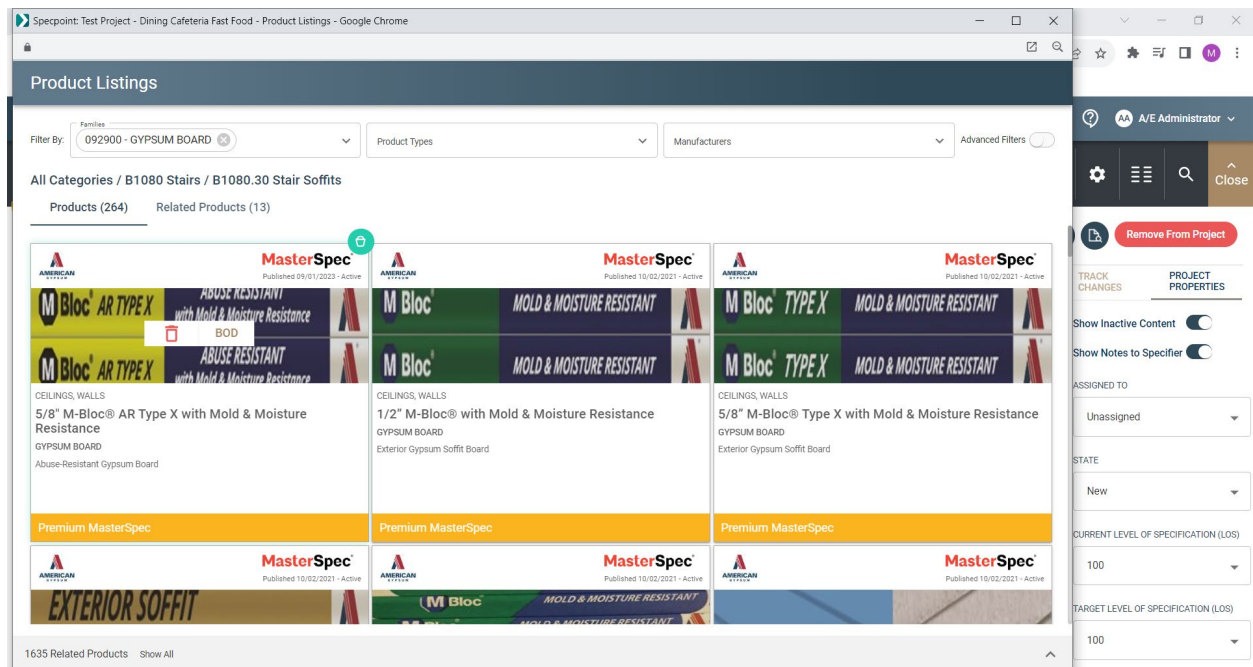


## Intelligent Product Selection

This section includes the descriptions of resolved software issues with product listing selection.

### Unstable View of the Product Listing Window

**Bug 1684642:** When you added a product listing to your project through the Product Listing window, the window unexpectedly scrolled upwards and reset the page UI elements. Your view of the Product Listing window should remain unchanged when adding a listing.

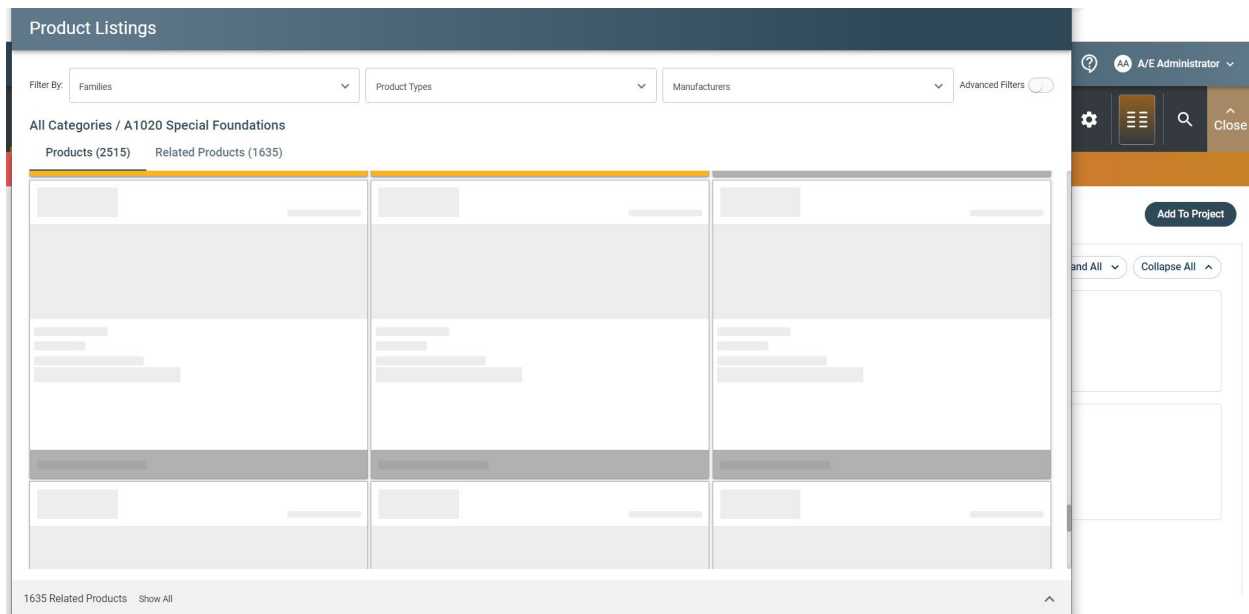


### Unable to Load Product Listings

**Bug 2024202:** The Product Listings window was unable to load more than 50 product listings cards. When you opened this window for a category, family, and/or product type that included a large number of

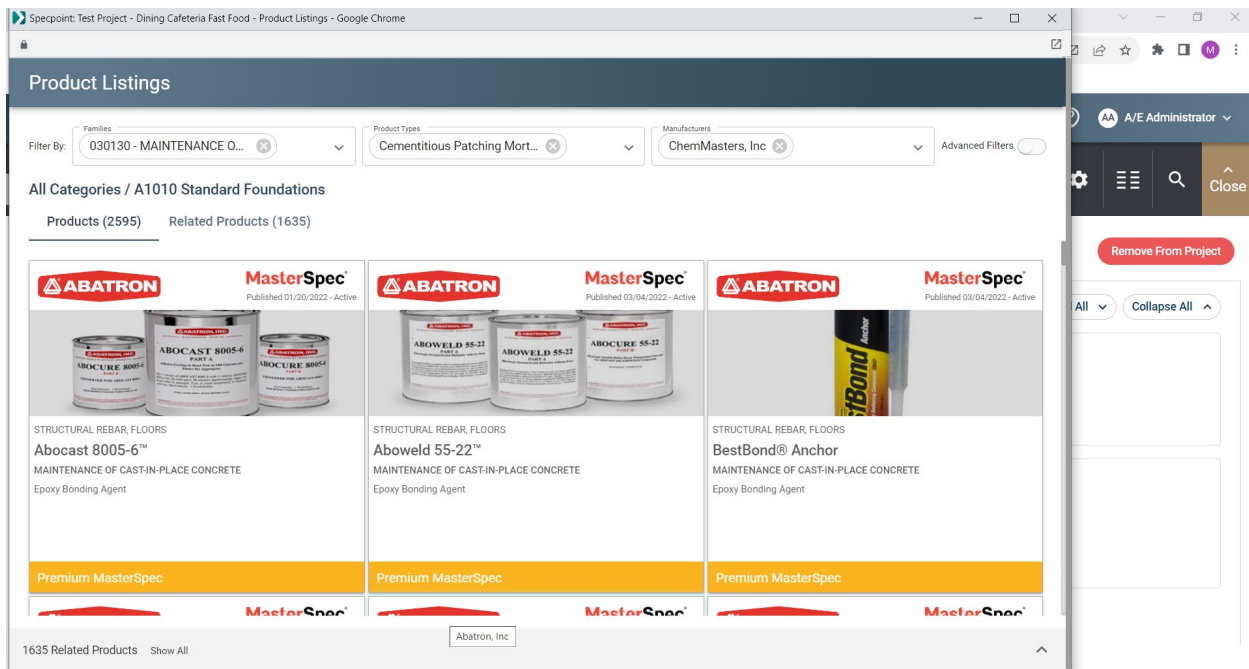

product listings and scrolled down to load more listings, the bottom product listing cards indefinitely remained in loading animation.



## Product Listing Filters at the Assembly Level


**Bug 2024284:** When you opened the Product Listings window from the project workspace with a selected assembly element, you were unable to filter the product listing cards in the window. Selecting options in the filter fields did not have an effect in the available product listings. This issue persisted even when you selected a family or product type element in the origin project workspace while the Product Listings window was open.

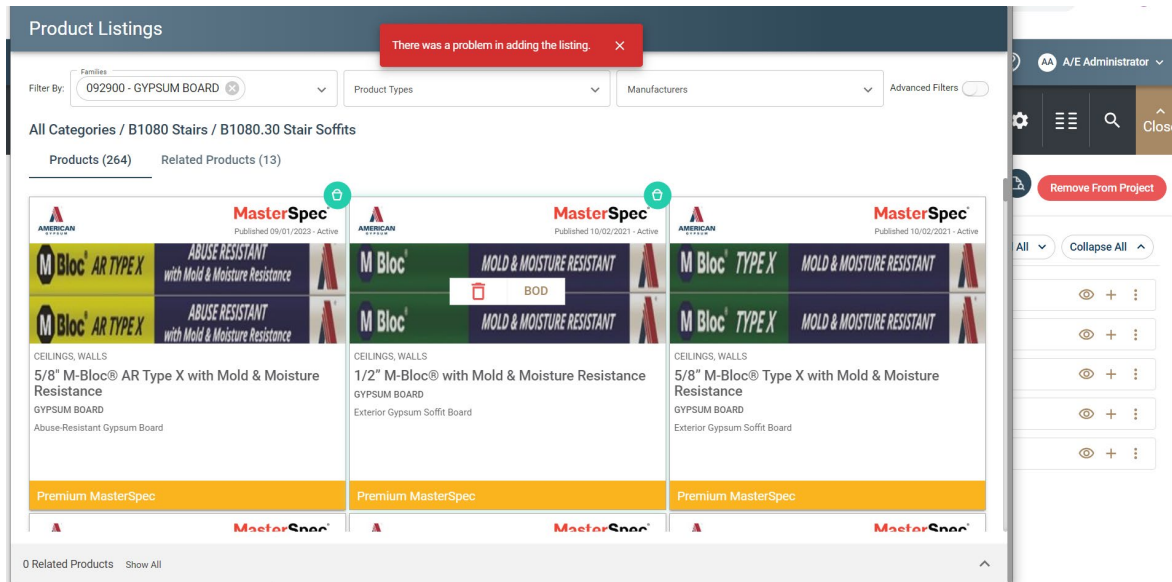

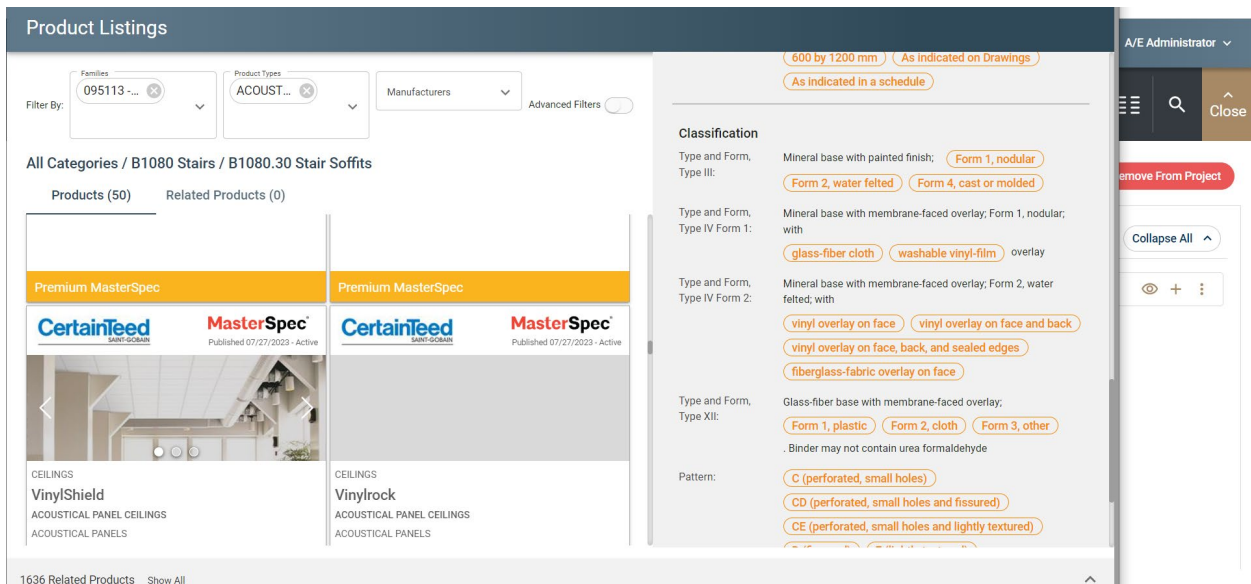
## Error Message After Adding a Product Listing

**Bug 1963956:** When you added a product listing to a project by clicking either  or **BOD**, the Product Listings window displayed an error message.



## Blank Product Properties

**Bug 1963956:** The Properties tab of the Product Details pane in the Product Listings window did not display the selected product properties of product listings. When you viewed the properties for a given listing on this tab, you were only able to view the possible options for each product property, in their default state.



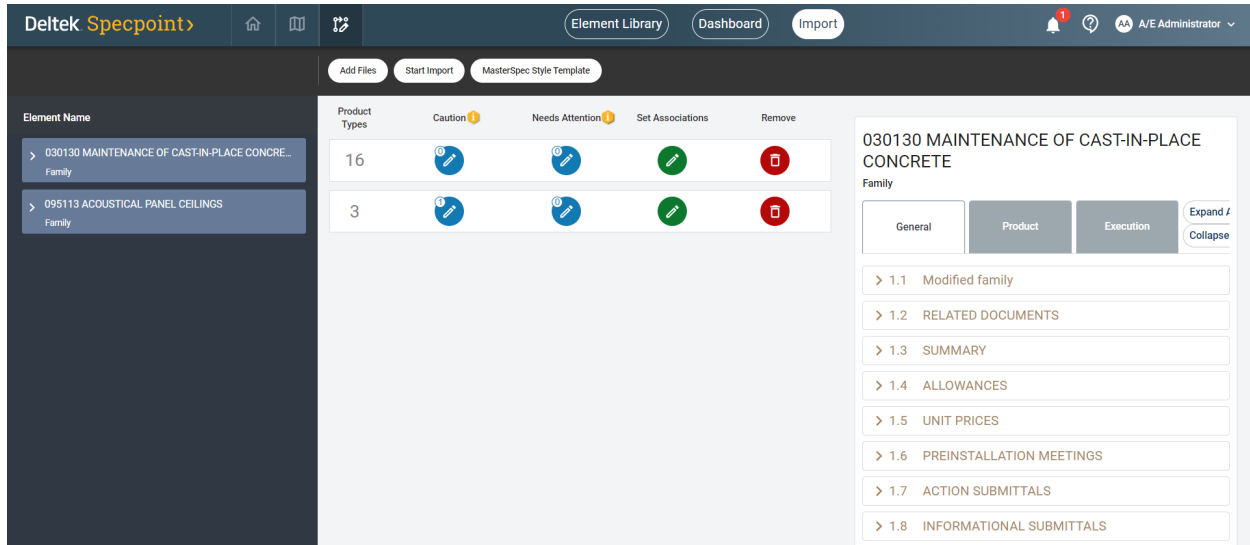

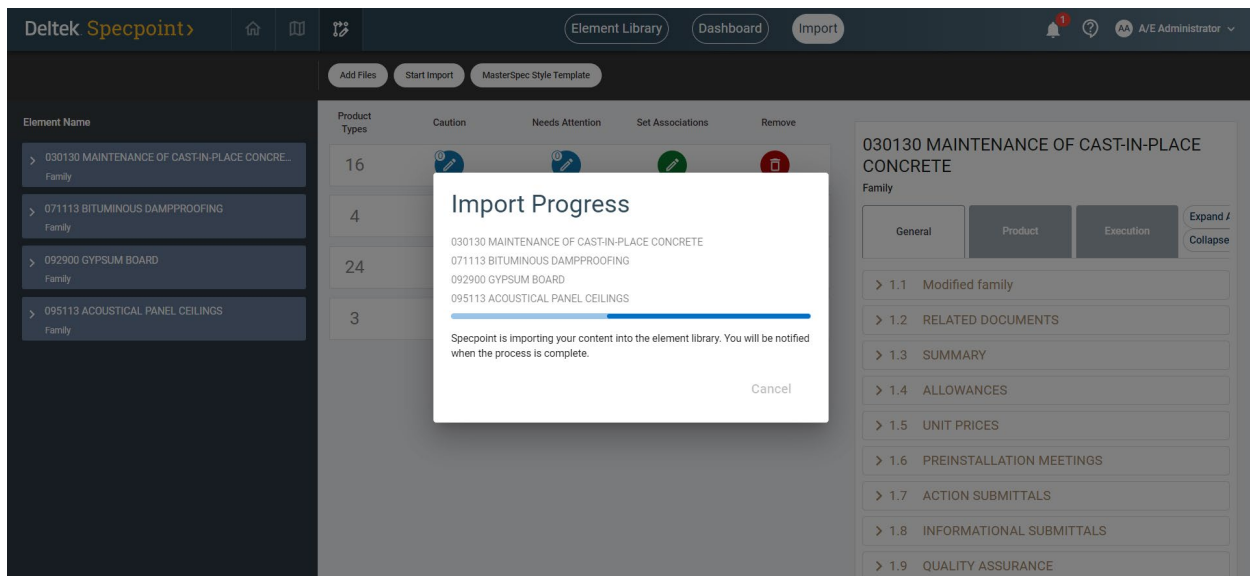
### Unexpected Import Will Override Prompt

**Bug 2013626:** When you uploaded and imported office master families, the platform displayed an unexpected Import Will Override dialog box for cases without existing imported office master families.



### Unable to Import Office Master Families

**Bug 2027707:** When you uploaded and imported office master families, the platform was unable to complete the import process. The Import Progress dialog box of the Office Master Import Page remained in loading animation.

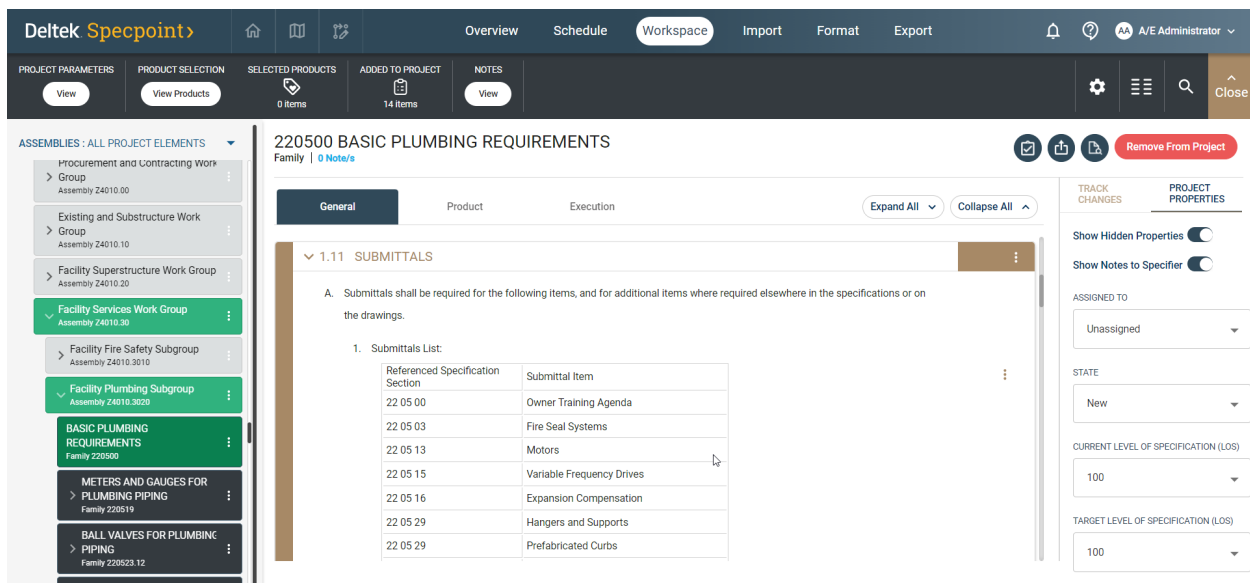

## New Features

### Table Support

Specpoint now supports tables in your imported families/sections. From providing dimensions of engineering systems components to door hardware schedules, tables communicate essential information in project specifications. Use this feature to intelligently maintain tables in a database driven environment.



In the project workspace, successfully imported tables are static or view-only. You cannot modify, move, promote, or demote paragraphs that contain tables. Ensure that the table data is correct before you import the family into your project. You can add notes to tables to coordinate with other members of the project team. Tables are included in the section preview and in exported project files.

The imported tables must follow the required formatting, such as:

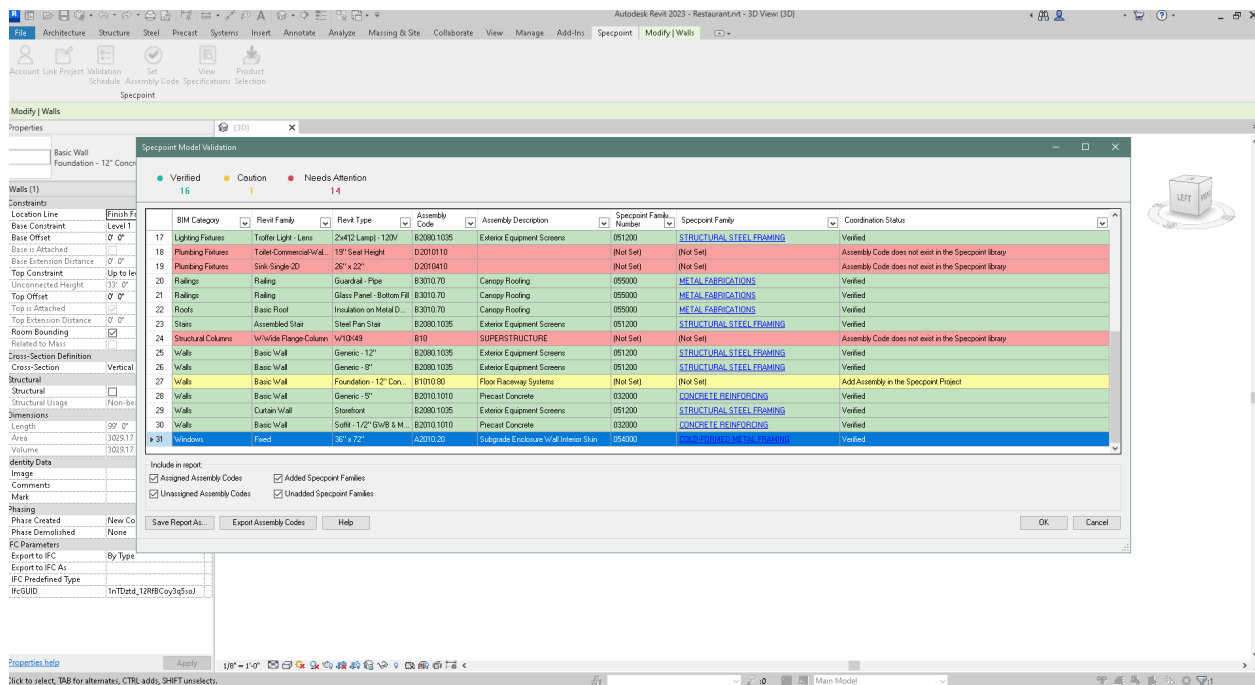

#### Export Specpoint Assemblies

In Specpoint Plug-in for Revit, you can now export the Specpoint assembly code file. This file enables you to use Specpoint assembly codes and descriptions for your Revit® model. This also ensures that you associated your Revit model elements to up-to-date and verified assemblies.



The Specpoint Model Validation report includes the **Export Assembly Codes** button. Click this button to download a TXT file with the following information for each assembly:

- Assembly Code
- Assembly Description
- Assembly or Project Element Level

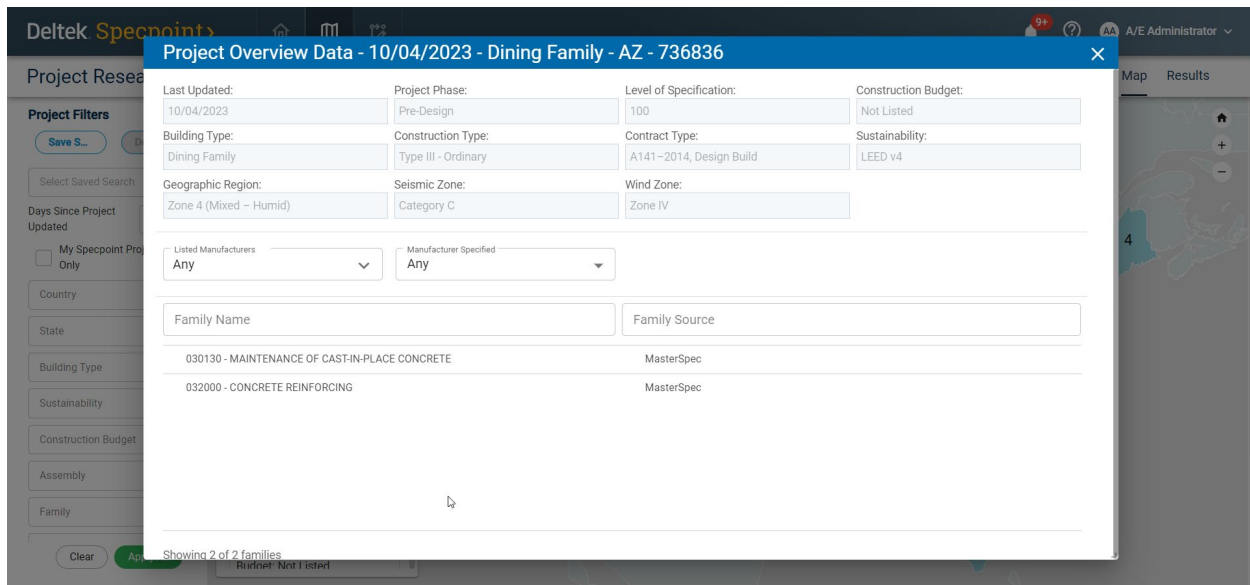

## Software Issues Resolved

This section includes summaries of the resolved software issues in this release.

### Missing Project Families on the Project Research Map

**Bug 1999773:** The Project Overview Data window of the Project Research Map did not display the complete list of added families in affected projects. For a given project, the window did not include families that the project team added after they added an imported family.



Imported families pertain to both project-level import and office master import.

## Section Preview Discrepancies

**Bug 2002662:** The section preview included the following discrepancies:

- The numbering of items beyond the number 10 was incorrect.
- The preview cut off words at the end of lines and continued them on the succeeding lines.

This issue applied to section previews from both the project workspace and the element library.

## Manufacturer Options and Manufacturer Product Types

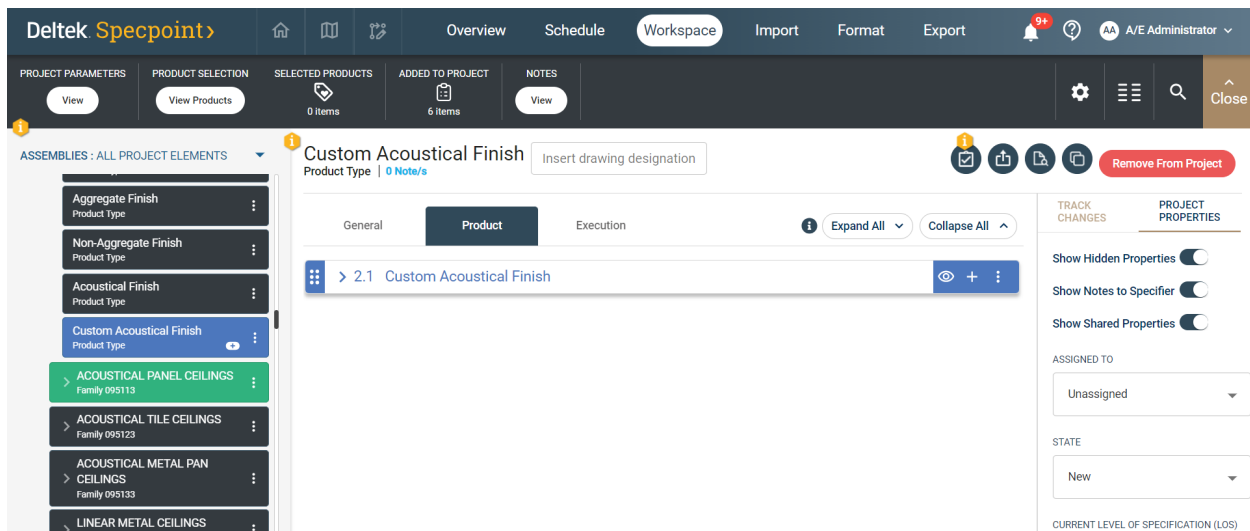
This section includes the descriptions of resolved software issues with working with manufacturer options and manufacturer product types in the project workspace.

### Deleted Manufacturer Product Types

**Bug 1965448:** Deleted manufacturer product types were still available in the Project Elements pane of the project workspace. When a building product manufacturer deletes its manufacturer product type from Specpoint, users from A/E firms should no longer be able to view and add the manufacturer product type to their projects.

### Missing Manufacturer BOD Product Paragraphs

**Bug 1943450:** Some manufacturer product types did not include a manufacturer BOD product paragraph. When you added these manufacturer product types to your project, you were unable to specify content for manufacturers and product listings, which you could have used as a basis of design.



### Missing Shared Properties and Placeholder Text

**Bug 1967638:** The project workspace did not display shared properties for select manufacturer product types even if you selected the **Show Shared Properties** option on the Project Properties tab. In addition, when you cleared your selection for the **Show Shared Properties** option, the project workspace did not display the placeholder text for the manufacturer product type.

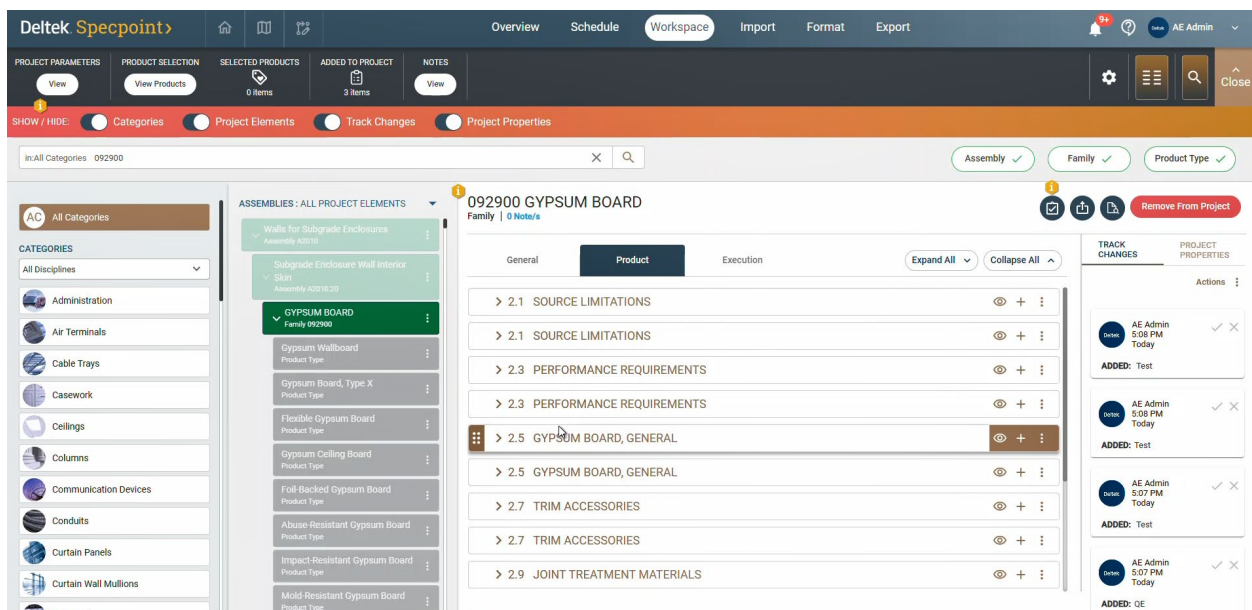

**Bug 2010525:** When you modified shared properties under a family, the project workspace displayed duplicate copies of the family's articles.

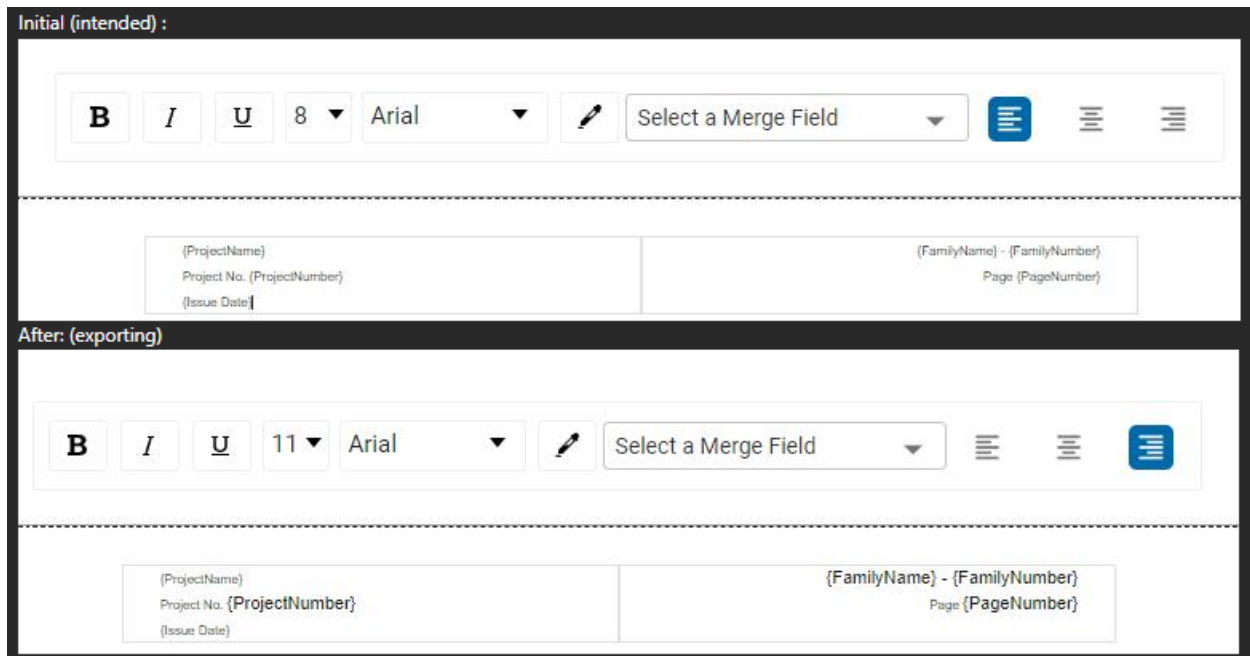


This issue applied to select families, such as **092900 Gypsum Board**.

### Incorrect Header & Footer Settings in Exported Project Files

**Bug 1997581:** When you exported projects that used custom header & footer templates, the headers and footers in the exported project sections included lines in incorrect font styling.





Some merge fields and other text in the header & footer template reverted to the size 11 font.

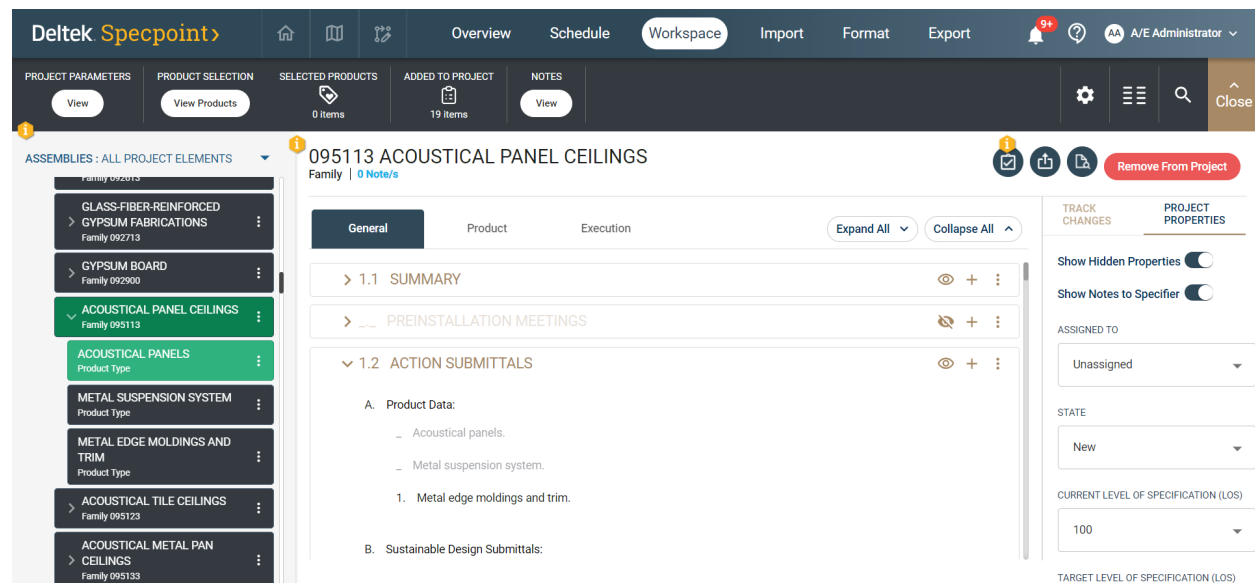

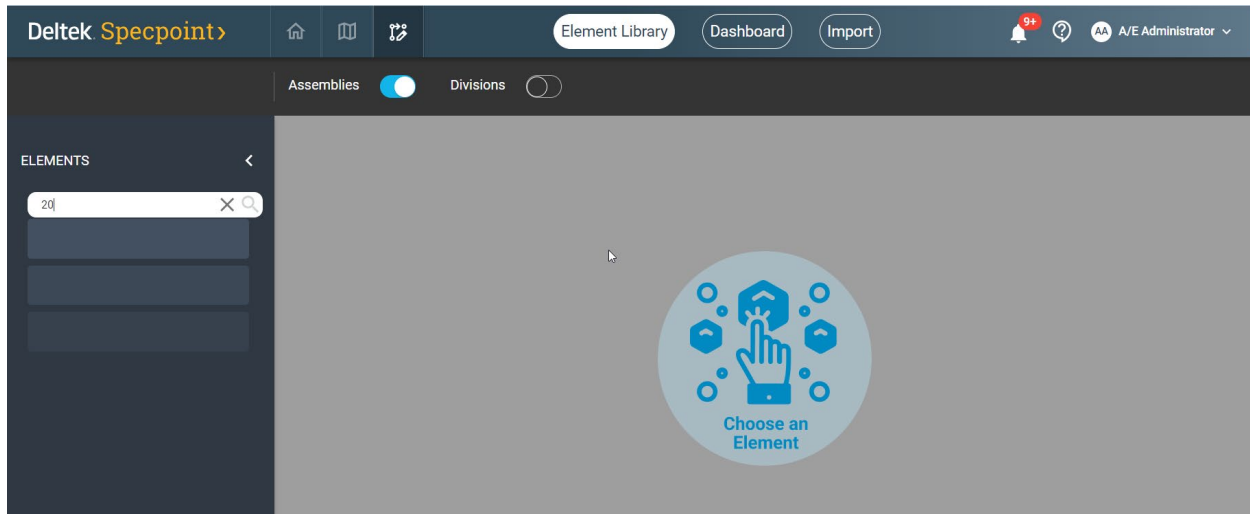

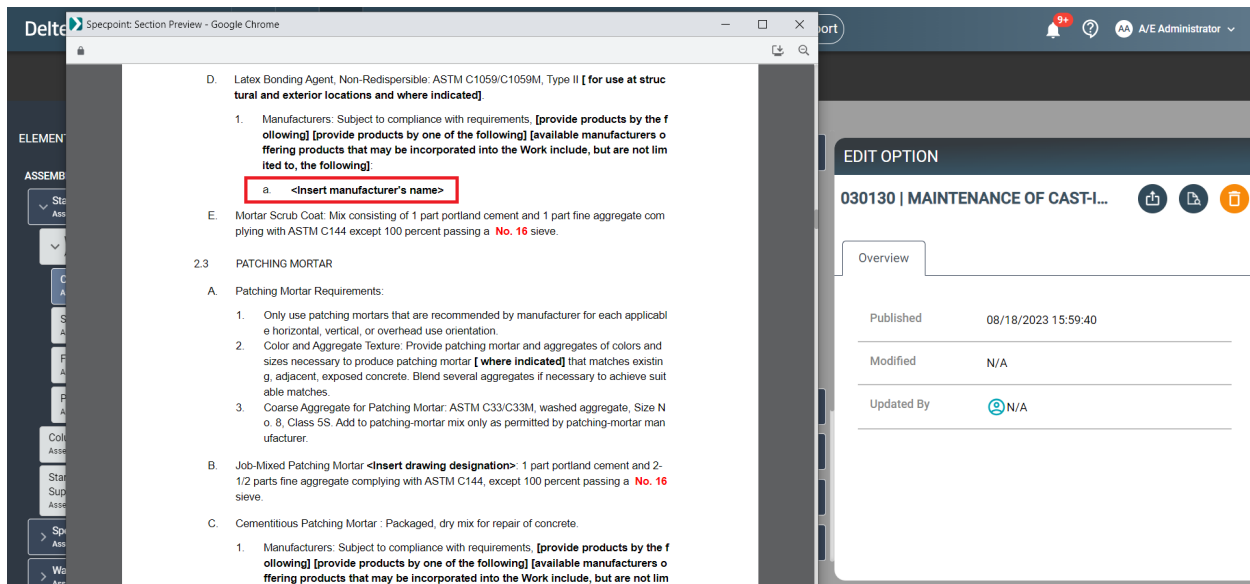
#### Indefinite Loading Times for Element Library Searches

**Bug 2001810:** When you searched using a generic search term in the element library, the Elements pane loaded indefinitely. You were unable to view the relevant search results.



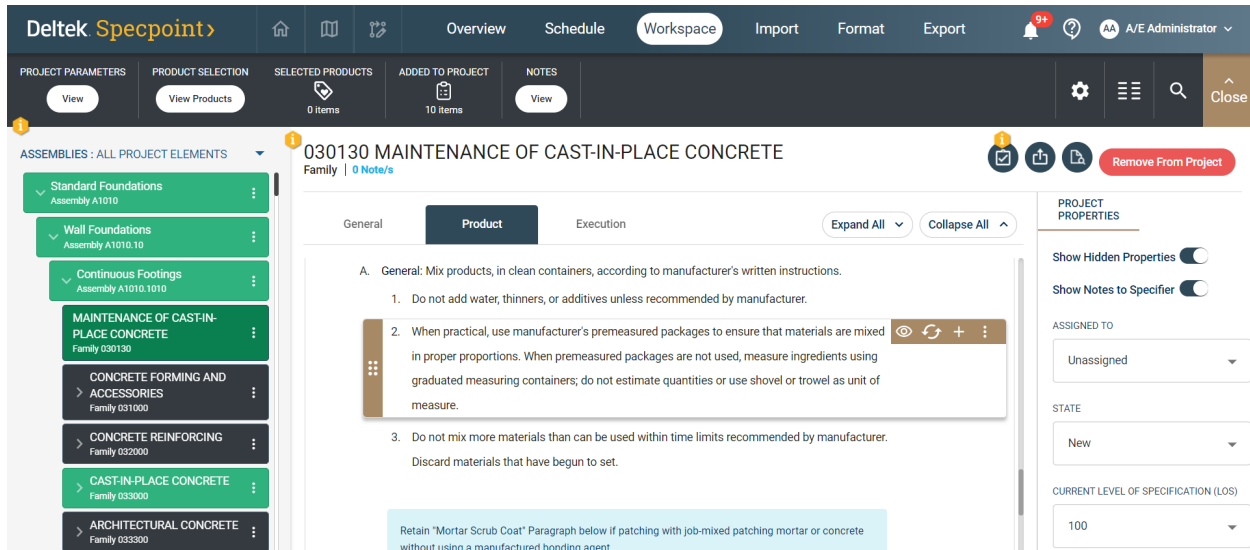
## Manufacturer List in the Element Library's Export and Section Preview

**Bug 1993705:** When you exported or previewed a published office master family from the element library, the family's manufacturer paragraphs and basis-of-design (BOD) product paragraphs included empty manufacturer lists. You were unable to review the included manufacturer for each available product type.



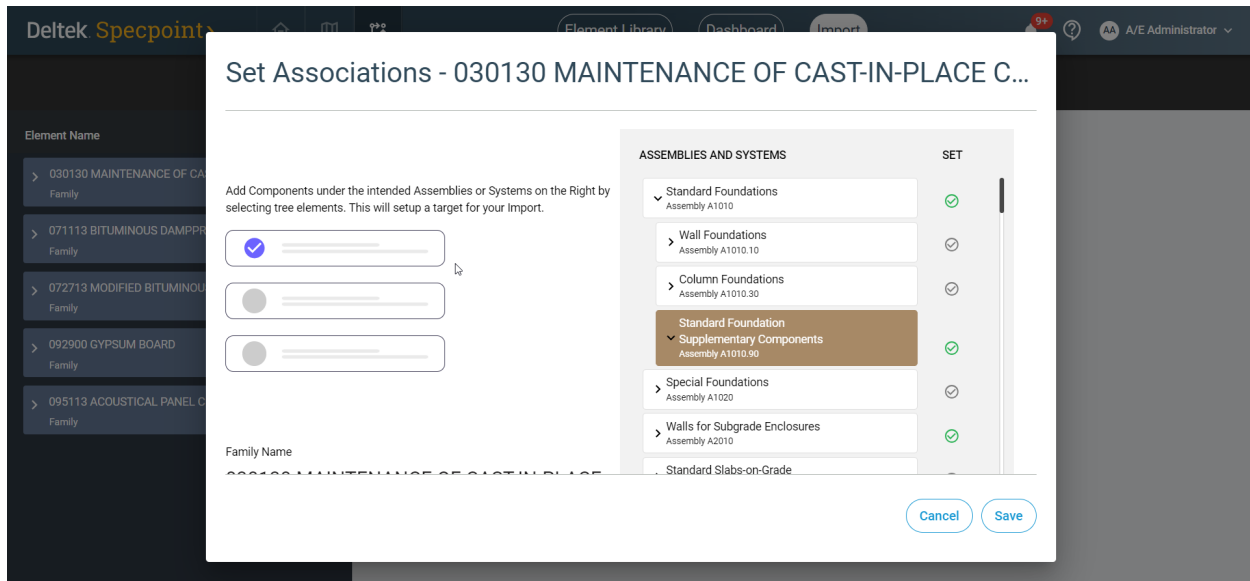
## Overwritten Added Families

**Bug 1969645:** When you imported and published an office master family for your firm, the office master version of the family overwrote the current versions of currently added families in different projects. Specpoint projects should maintain the version of the added family from when the family was added, even when you import and publish a new office master version of the family.



## Missing Associations for a Published Office Master Family

**Bug 2000742:** Published office master families with set associations to the **A1010.90 Standard Foundation Supplementary Components** assembly (during import) did not display under the same assembly in the element library.



You were unable to view published office master families under the **A1010.90 Standard Foundation Supplementary Components** assembly.

## Opening an Office Master Family from the Design Progress Table

**Bug 1997526:** When you clicked an office master family in the Design Progress table of the Project Overview page to open the family, the project workspace displayed a blank form. You were unable to view the contents of the office master family in the project workspace.

### Copying a Manufacturer Product Type

**Bug 1964093:** When you copied an added manufacturer product type, you encountered the following issues:

- The project workspace displayed an error message.
- The project workspace displayed the copied manufacturer product type without its contents, such as its articles and paragraphs.
- You were unable to select product listings for the copied manufacturer product type.

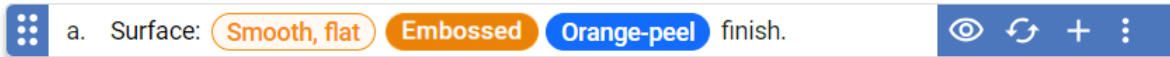

## Copying Product Types with Manufacturer Options

**Bug 1969212:** When you copied a product type that includes manufacturer options, the copied product type includes the manufacturer options in its content items.

**Note:** When you add a product listing with manufacturer options to a product type. Specpoint adds the manufacturer options to the respective product type property.



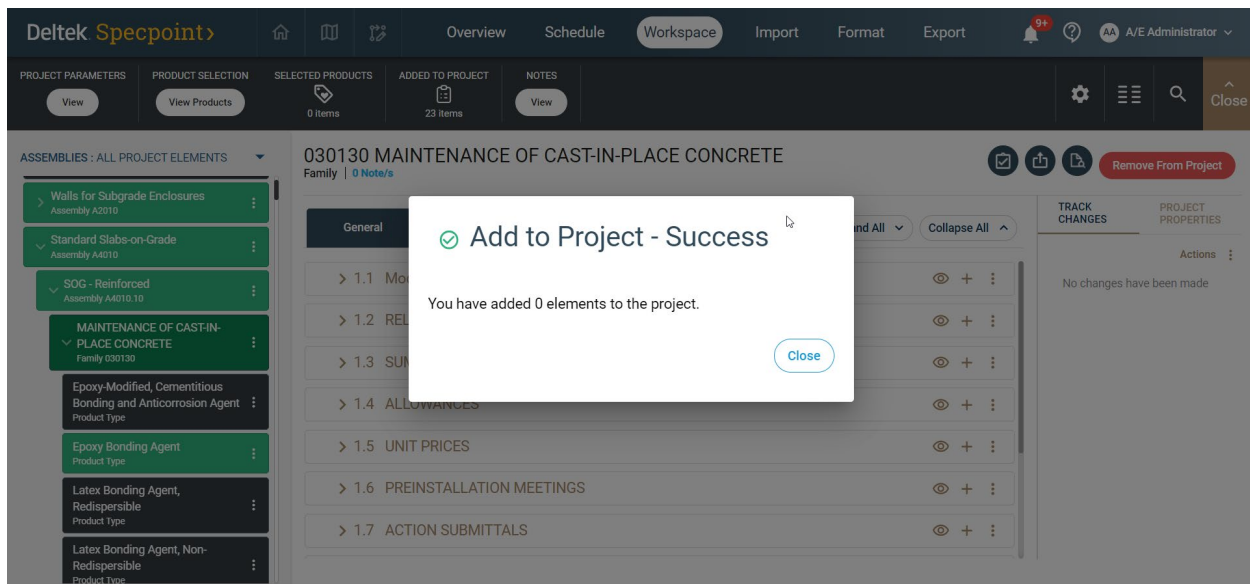
Copied product types should be in the product type's default state and should not include manufacturer options from product selection in the original product type.

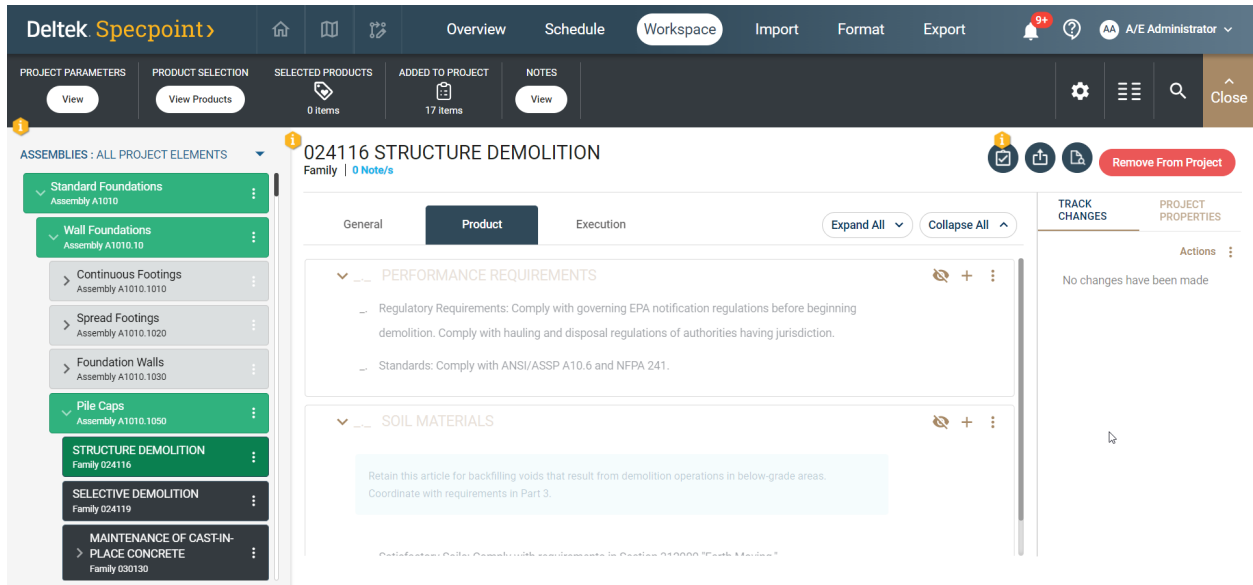
### Element Count for Quick Add

**Bug 1999336:** The Add to Project - Success dialog box, which confirmed the results of the quick add feature, displayed an incorrect element count. You were unable to view an accurate count of your added elements after performing quick add.



### Inactive Content in an Added Family

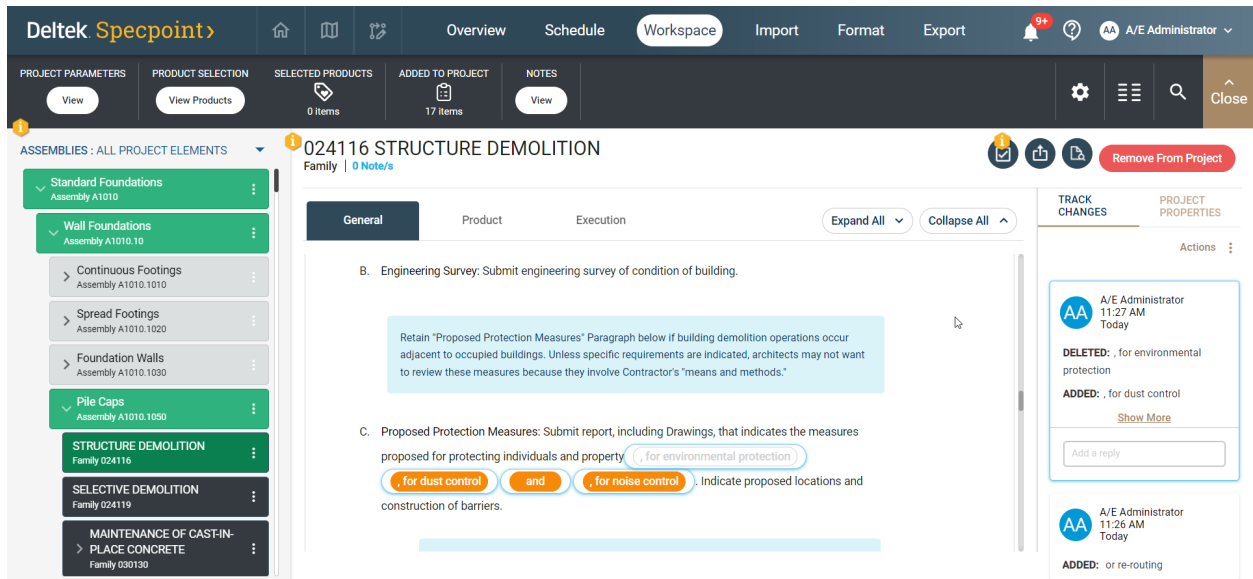
**Bug 1956371:** When you added specific family elements (such as **024116 Structure Demolition**) to your project, the project workspace did not automatically load and activate some of the families' content items. Content under the Product part/tab remained inactive on the element form.



As a workaround, you needed to manually activate the affected articles and paragraphs.

## Automated Scrolling with Selected Track Change Items

**Bug 1987486:** When you selected a track change item in the project workspace and scrolled up and down through the element content items, the project workspace automatically scrolled to return to the selected track change item.

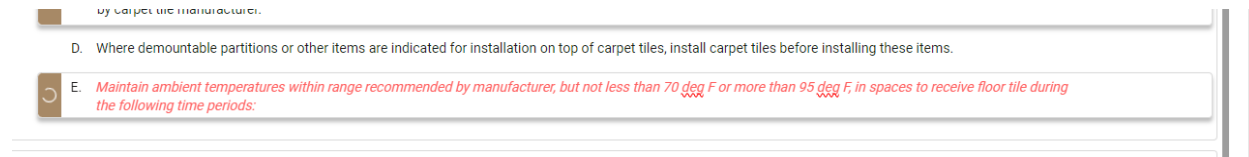


The project workspace should automatically scroll only to locate the selected track change item.

## Loading Icon for Long Paragraph Sentences with Colons

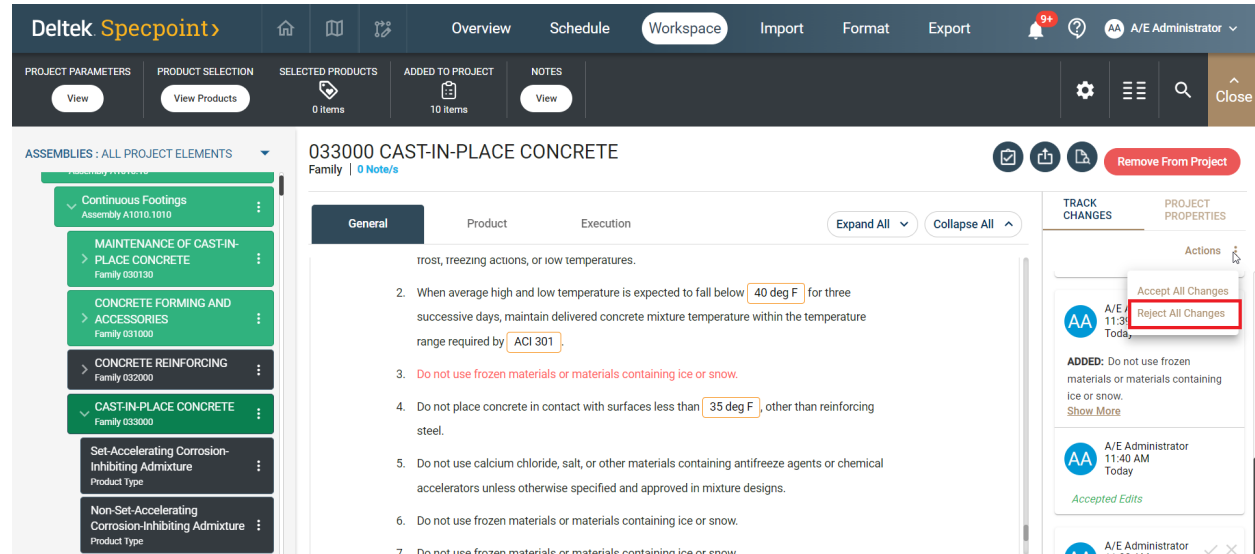
**Bug 1994008:** When you created a paragraph with a long sentence that ends with a colon (:), the paragraph remained in an indefinite loading state and included a loading icon. You were unable to add new paragraphs or add new property keys.

## Rejected Deletion of an Added and Accepted Paragraph

**Bug 1990670:** When you performed a reject all track changes action that included the deletion of an accepted added paragraph, the paragraph content displayed in red font.



The red font indicated that the accepted added paragraph has content that is pending resolution. The given paragraph must be in black font to indicate its accepted addition and rejected deletion.

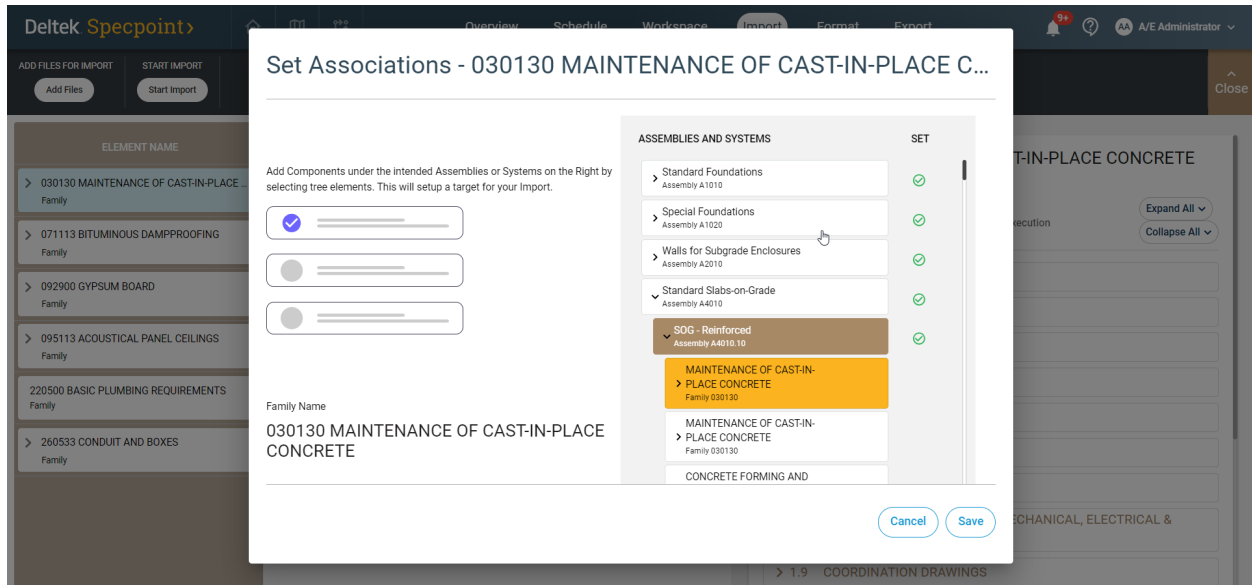

### Project-Level Import Associations

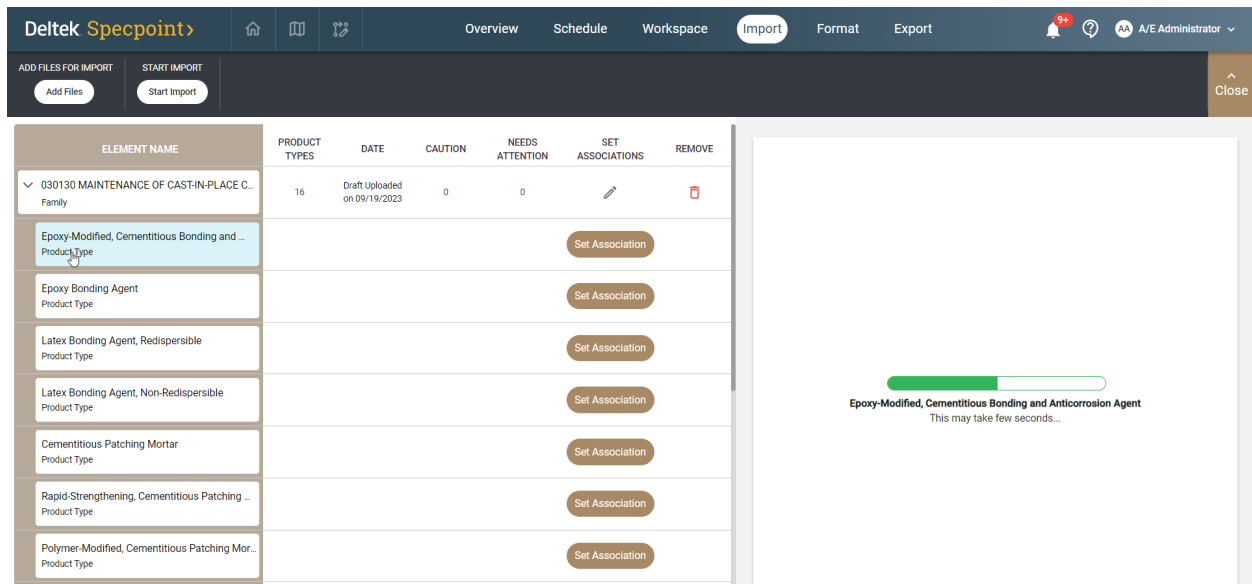
**Bug 2000198:** Some imported families did not display under their associated assemblies after their respective users successfully uploaded, set associations, and imported these families.





## Product Type Preview for Project-Level Import

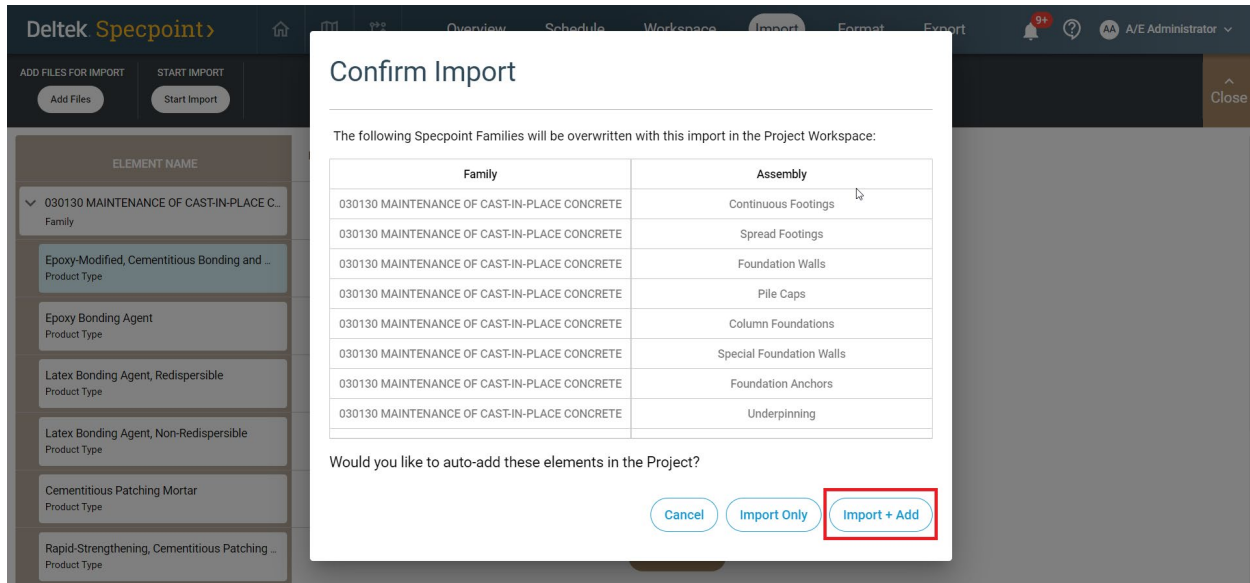
**Bug 2000241:** When you uploaded a family with product types for project-level import and previewed the contents of one of the product types, the Import page displayed only a white screen.



You were unable to preview the contents of the product types.

## Unable to Activate Content after Import+Add Command

**Bug 2002951:** Importing a family and clicking **Import+Add** in the Confirm Import dialog box caused issues in activating paragraphs within the imported family.



When you activated paragraphs within the imported family, the project workspace displayed an error message and the paragraph remained inactive.

## Project Formatting and Styles

This section includes the descriptions of resolved software issues with project formatting and styles.

### Unexpected Space in the Headers & Footers of Exported Project Files

**Bug 1995005:** When you exported projects that used custom header & footer templates, the headers and footers in the exported project sections included unexpected spaces or empty lines.



The issue occurred when you added and then removed a line break or merge field in the header & footer template.

## Table of Contents (TOC) in Exported PDF Files

**Bug 1992306:** When you exported a project manual as PDF files, the table of contents (TOC) did not include the added families/sections. The TOC listed only divisions that contained the included families/sections.
