Reserved Numbers for SpecText Families for Proprietary Listing Addition

When you add a Proprietary listing to your project and create a new family in the Manage Product Listing dialog box, you are unable to use an element number assigned to SpecText families as a new Family Number, even if your firm did not have SpecText content enabled. This enhancement prevents clashes with submittal requirements and future work with SpecText content.

Best Practices

This section includes descriptions of enhancements for best practices features throughout the platform.

Set Manufacturer Pills as Best Practices in the New Workspace

In the new workspace, you can now tag manufacturer pills in the Manufacturers paragraph and the Basis-of-Design (BOD) Product paragraph as best practices. These pills must be added through the Product Library . To set a manufacturer pill as a best practice, right-click the pill and select the desired options in the Best Practices dialog box.




Software Issues Resolved

This section includes summaries of the resolved software issues in this release.

New Workspace

This section includes descriptions of resolved software issues encountered in the new workspace.

Activated Product Types Displayed at the Bottom of the Sequence with Filter Enabled

Deltek Tracking Number 2606403: When you activated () a product type content of an added family in the new workspace editor after turning on the **Added to Project** filter () from the Elements panel (), the corresponding product type node displayed at the bottom of the sequence under its family instead of its correct position based on the family structure. You needed to refresh the page for the product type node to display in its correct sequence.

Family Not Added to Project After Navigating Away from the Workspace

Deltek Tracking Number 2620578: When you added the **079200 Joint Sealants** family to your project in the new workspace editor, navigated to the Project Overview page, and then returned to the editor, your changes did not save, and the family was not added to the project.

This issue occurred intermittently in the new workspace editor.


Property Keys Displayed as Pills

Deltek Tracking Number 2648706: When you opened a family in the new workspace editor and navigated to the **Part 2 – Products** tab, the property keys/title of **Manufacturers** and **Basis-of-Design Product** paragraphs incorrectly displayed in pills instead of regular text.

Office Masters

This section includes descriptions of resolved software issues encountered with office master content in the project workspace and office master manager.




Unable to Delete Office Master Version in the Element Library

Deltek Tracking Number 2640799: When you attempted to delete () an office master version from the Family Details pane in the Element Library, the screen went blank and the deletion did not complete.

Unavailable Manufacturer in Office Master Family

Deltek Tracking Number 2605680: When you added an office master family with a custom manufacturer in one of its Manufacturers paragraphs into your project, you were unable to select the custom manufacturer in the Manufacturers paragraph in the new workspace editor. The custom manufacturer pill was disabled. This issue applied only for cloned office master versions of specific families, such as **232113 Hydronic Pumping**.

Missing Selected Manufacturer from an Office Master in the Section Preview and Exported Files

Deltek Tracking Number 2645997: When you cloned a MasterSpec office master version of a family in the Office Master Workspace, added a manufacturer () in the Manufacturers paragraph of one of its product types, published the family on the Office Master Dashboard, and previewed () the family from the Family Details pane of the Element Library, the Manufacturers paragraph did not display the added manufacturer in the section preview. This issue also occurred when you selected the manufacturer through the Product Listings window or exported () the family.

Product Selection

This section includes descriptions of resolved software issues encountered in product selection.


Multi-Select Allowed Adding Product Cards Without Required Family or Product Type

Deltek Tracking Number 2638915: When you used the multi-select feature (hold CTRL+click) in the Product Listings window, the platform allowed you to add product listing cards whose associated family or product type was not yet added to the project. This behavior bypassed permission restrictions that limit contributors to adding product cards only under families and product types already added to the project.

Multi-Select Displayed Success Message but Did Not Add Product Listing Cards

Deltek Tracking Number 2638937: When you used the multi-select feature (hold CTRL+click) in the Product Listings window after you selected a lowest-level assembly of an added family or product type in the elements panel of the new workspace, the platform displayed a success message but did not add the selected product listing cards.

AI Disclaimer Icon Overlapping While Scrolling

Deltek Tracking Number 2641959: When you scrolled through the Product Listings window after selecting a family or product type in the workspace, the **AI Disclaimer** icon () partially overlapped the **Results** and **Remaining Products** bar, affecting the visibility of the product listing cards during scrolling.

Reduced Product Listings Filter Options After Adding Elements to Project

Deltek Tracking Number 2642113: When you opened the Product Listings window for a family after adding a family or product type to the project, the available **Families** filter options were unexpectedly reduced. Several families that were previously available no longer appeared in the filter list, including families that had already been added to the project, which prevented you from filtering or searching for them.

Incomplete Product Types Displayed in Product Listings Window

Deltek Tracking Number 2620523: When you selected a family in the new workspace and opened the Product Listings window, the **Product Types** filter did not display all product types associated with the family. When you selected a different product type in the Elements panel while the Product Listings window remained open, the **Product Types** filter still did not refresh its full list and displayed only a limited number of product types associated with the parent family. In some cases, the filter displayed only a single product type, requiring you to manually enter the product type name to locate the remaining product types.

Import

This section includes descriptions of enhancements with importing families at the project level or as office masters.




Missing Nodes for Imported Families

Deltek Tracking Number 2569474: When you imported a family into a project and associated it with an assembly, the family node was missing under its associated assembly in the Elements panel of the new workspace or the Project Elements pane of the classic workspace. As a workaround, you needed to search for the family on the search bar.

Preview and Export

This section includes descriptions of resolved software issues with the section preview and the exported project sections.

Unable to Export a Section

Deltek Tracking Number 2640111: When you attempted to export (//) a section from the project workspace, the workspace displayed an error message and failed to export the section file. This issue occurred only in specific sections.

Project Format and Styles

This section includes descriptions of resolved software issues with working on project format and styles.


White Space at the Bottom of the Format Page

Deltek Tracking Number 2630383: When you opened the Format page for a project, the Format page displayed a white space at the bottom of the available tabs, such as Style Guides, Headers & Footers, and Document Settings.

General Issues

This section includes descriptions of resolved general software issues within the platform.

Undelivered Notifications

Deltek Tracking Number 2550259: When Specpoint or MasterSpec released an update, some users did not receive a notification () from the platform. Some users also received duplicate notifications.

Missing Selected Manufacturer Pills in the Section Preview and Exported Files

Deltek Tracking Number 2645997: When you opened a project in the classic workspace, selected an added product type, selected manufacturer pills in the Manufacturers paragraph, entered a custom manufacturer in the **[Insert Manufacturers Name]** field, and previewed () the family, the Manufacturers paragraph displayed only the custom manufacturer in the section preview, and the selected manufacturer pills were missing. This issue also occurred when you selected the manufacturer through the Product Listings window or exported () the family.





The Manufacturers paragraph now includes the **Product Library** button ( Product Library) that enables you to open the Product Listings window and view the available product listings that you can add for the corresponding product type. This button replaces the initial list of manufacturer pills in all Manufacturers paragraphs.

This feature helps you make more informed product selections for your project requirements and better understand the relationship between inline content and product selection.

Selected Manufacturers

When you select product listings for a product type through the Product Listings window, Specpoint adds each selected product listing as a pill/option in corresponding the Manufacturers paragraph. These pills display as selected and are visible only when the Manufacturers paragraph is active.

You cannot click these pills to remove or reselect a product listing. To remove a manufacturer pill, remove the corresponding product listing through the Product Listings window.

Preview and Export Support for Selected Manufacturers

When you preview or export a family that includes a **Manufacturers** paragraph, Specpoint uses the following logic:

- **Without Selections:** If no manufacturer or product type selections exist, the section preview and exported project family display the Manufacturers paragraph with a list of all available manufacturers, shown in bold and brackets.

Updates to Selection Automation in Manufacturers Paragraphs

When you select a product listing, the corresponding Manufacturers paragraph no longer automatically selects the lead-in phrase after **“Subject to compliance with requirements”** in either the new workspace or the classic workspace. Previously, the lead-in option set updated automatically based on whether the selection included a single manufacturer or multiple manufacturers from the manufacturer list.

With this update, each Manufacturers paragraph functions independently.


Corresponding Changes to Basis-of-Design (BOD) Product Paragraphs

Basis-of-Design (BOD) Product paragraphs include the following updates that align with inline product library access and selection:

- BOD Product paragraphs no longer include a list of manufacturer pills for selecting comparable products.

Retain "Basis-of-Design Product" Subparagraph and list of manufacturers below to identify a specific product or a comparable product from manufacturers listed.

2. Basis-of-Design Product: Subject to compliance with requirements, provide or comparable product by one of the following:

You can select comparable products from the Product Listings window. In the new workspace, open this window through the **Product Library** button ( Product Library) on action bar or in the corresponding Manufacturers paragraph.


- When you select comparable products through the Product Listings window, Specpoint adds each selected product listing as a pill/option in corresponding the BOD product paragraph. These pills display as selected and are visible only when the BOD product paragraph is active. You cannot click these pills to remove or reselect a product listing.

2. Basis-of-Design Product: Subject to compliance with requirements, provide **Euclid Chemical Company (The); a subsidiary of RPM International, Inc.: DURALPREP A.C.** or comparable product by one of the following:

Manufacturer Selection Support for Cloned Families

Manufacturer selection handling for cloned families now preserves custom selections. When you publish a cloned version of a family with custom manufacturers and then add the family to a project, the platform saves your selections. The manufacturers display as selected pills in the new workspace editor, reducing manual rework and improving consistency.

For added flexibility, the **Product Library** button ( Product Library) remains available for cloned families. You can use this option at any time to review or modify manufacturer selections.

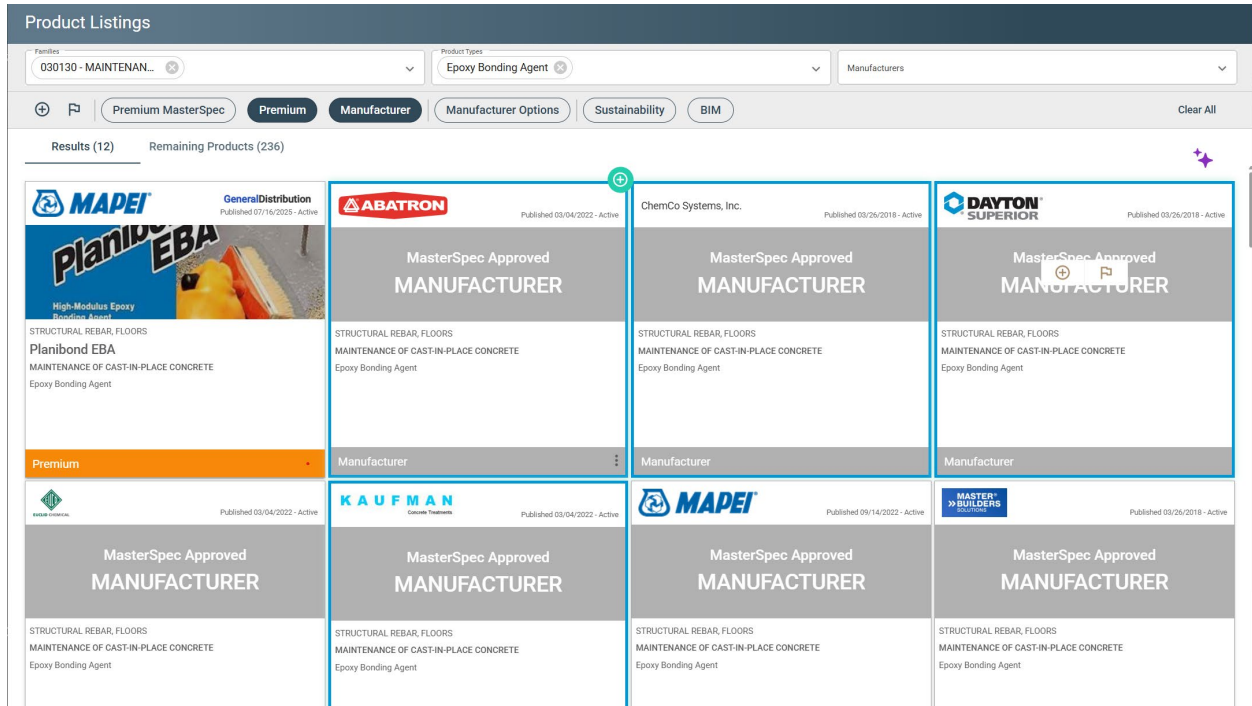

Multi-Select Product Listing Cards for Addition

In the Product Listings window, you can now multi-select cards and add them to your project. To do so, hold CTRL, click each product listing card that you want to select, and then click **Add to Project**.



When you have a multi-product selection, the following options are now available:

- **Select All:** Select all available product listings in the current view.
- **Add to Project:** Add all selected product listings to the project.

Use this feature to quickly add multiple product listings to your project.

Window Option and Tab Changes

The Product Listings window includes the following changes:


- The **Categories** filter is now available. Use this option to filter the Proprietary listings on the Remaining Products tab.

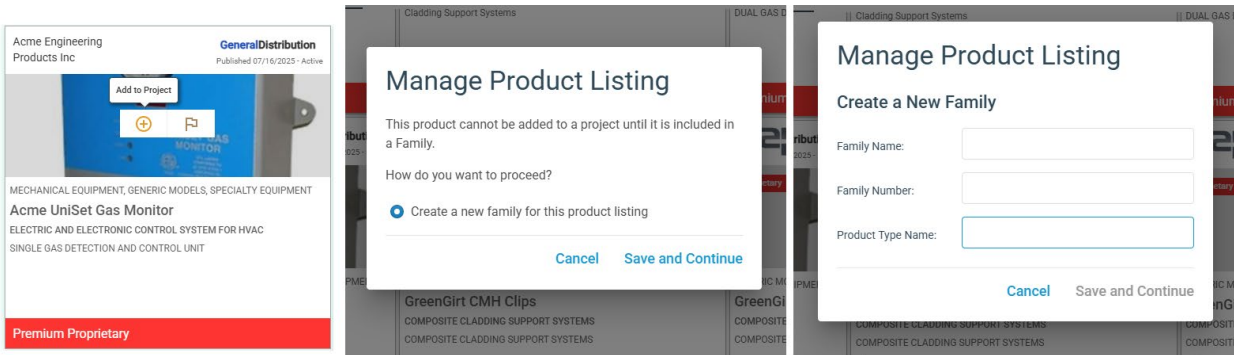

Adding Proprietary Listings to Custom Families

You can now add Proprietary listings to your project and create a custom family and product type for each listing. This feature provides greater flexibility in building out more customized specifications based on unique product listings from registered BPM companies within the platform.

When you click  **(Add Product to Project)** on a Proprietary product listing card in the Product Listings window, the Manage Listing dialog box displays. This dialog box enables you to create a new family and product type in your project for the Proprietary listing.

Manage Listing Dialog Box



In the Manage Listing dialog box, the following options are available:

- **Create a new family for this product listing:** Select this option to acknowledge that you are adding a new family and product type to your project.
- **Family Name:** Enter the name of the new family.
- **Family Number:** Enter the element number for the new family. The number must follow the format ##### or #####.##.
- **Product Type Name:** Enter the name of the new product type.
- **Cancel:** Cancel adding the Proprietary listing and creating a new family and product type.
- **Save and Continue:** Proceed with the next step of the listing addition and element creation.

New Family and Product Type

When you create a new family for a Proprietary listing, the family becomes available under its respective assemblies or divisions based on the family number that you enter. You can work on the new family in the same way you would with a MasterSpec family. In the new workspace, you can select its node in the Elements panel and load its contents in the new workspace editor. The family is also available in the classic workspace.

The family's contents will be based on a generic template and contain all the manufacturer information of the added Proprietary listing.

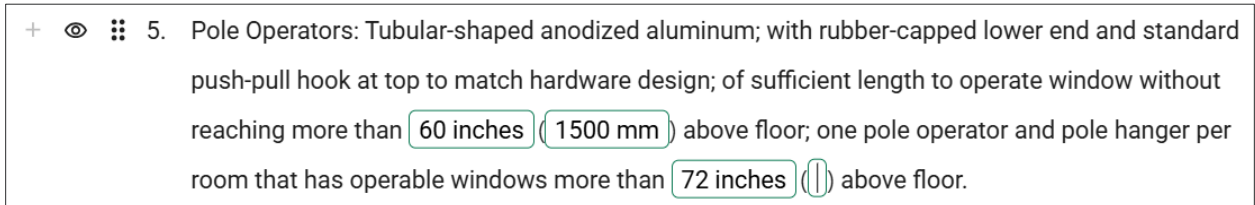

Unit of Measure (UOM) Field Editing in the New Workspace Editor

You can now enter or update values for unit of measure (UOM) fields directly in the workspace editor. This improvement allows you to define measurements using your preferred system, whether **Imperial** or **Metric**.

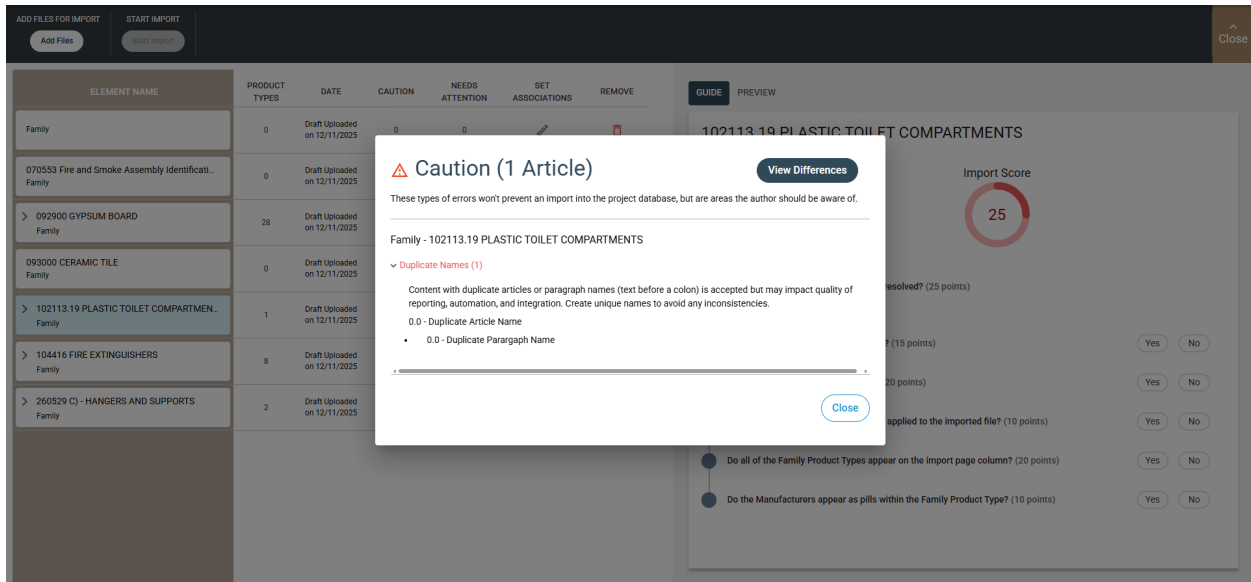


Import

This section includes descriptions of enhancements with importing families at the project level or as office masters.

Duplicate Key Processing for Imported Families

You can now import families that contain duplicate property keys without errors or upload blocking, for both project-level imports and office master imports. This includes duplicate article titles. This enhancement reduces the need for manual cleanup of duplicate keys before import, enabling seamless migration of existing content while preserving original formatting and hierarchy.



When you upload documents that contain duplicate articles or paragraph property keys, the platform converter accepts the file without blocking or failing. The Caution window flags the duplicate keys and lists them with the following message:

Content with duplicate articles or paragraph names is accepted but may impact reporting, automation, and integration. Create unique names to avoid inconsistencies.

The platform automatically changes or appends a counter to duplicate property keys.

Exceptions

Duplicate product type keys, or property keys of product type paragraphs, remain restricted.

Paragraphs in Copied Product Type Locked in Inactive State

Deltek Tracking Number 2613599: When you added a product type to your project in Assemblies view of the new workspace and then copied () the product type in Divisions view, all paragraphs within the copied product type became inactive (). You were unable to manually activate these paragraphs.

MasterSpec Content Updates Affecting Added Project Content

Deltek Tracking Number 2607345: When you added a family to a project and the family later received a MasterSpec content update, the Manufacturers paragraphs in the family had missing manufacturer pills. For updates that included additional product types, the added family displayed the new product types.

Disabled Move Block Options for Related Requirements Subparagraphs

Deltek Tracking Number 2605735: When you attempted to move a subparagraph under the **Related Requirements** paragraph within a family in the new workspace by clicking  > **Move Block** >  **Up** or  **Down**, the  **Up** or  **Down** options were incorrectly disabled.

UOM Displayed Incorrectly Across Workspaces

Deltek Tracking Number 2363786: When you entered text in a unit of measure (UOM) field within a paragraph, the UOM incorrectly displayed as a pill instead of a text field. This issue occurred in both the new workspace and the classic workspace.

Spacing Issues in the New Workspace Editor

Deltek Tracking Number 2381533: When you edited the element content in the new workspace editor, some paragraphs included incorrect spacing. Text in unit of measure (UOM) fields and custom text fields either included extra whitespace or appeared without spaces between words.

Office Masters

This section includes descriptions of resolved software issues encountered with office master content in the project workspace and office master manager.

Family Version Locked to MasterSpec

Deltek Tracking Number 2619887: When you selected an office master version from the **Office Master Selection** menu of a family node in the Elements panel and performed actions such as switching to Divisions view, leaving and returning to the workspace, or adding other elements to the project, the family reverted to the MasterSpec version and the family node did not consistently retain its OM tag.

Incorrect OM tag on a Cloned MasterSpec

Deltek Tracking Number 2616324: When you added the baseline MasterSpec version of a family to a project and that family had an existing work item for a cloned office master version on the Office Master Dashboard, the added family incorrectly displayed an OM tag in the Elements panel of the new workspace or the Project Elements pane of the classic workspace.

Preview and Export

This section includes descriptions of resolved software issues with the section preview and the exported project sections.


Failed Project Export

Deltek Tracking Number 2591535: When you attempted to export an entire project, the Specpoint Maintenance Notification Page unexpectedly displayed and the export was unsuccessful.

Best Practices



This section includes descriptions of resolved software issues encountered in best practices features throughout the platform.

Incorrectly Removed OM Tags in Office Master Families

Deltek Tracking Number 2601424: When you set a paragraph as a global best practice () within a project that contained office master families, navigated to another page, and then returned to the workspace, the OM tags for the office master families were incorrectly removed.

This issue occurred in both the new workspace and the classic workspace.

Best Practices Tags Inconsistently Displayed in the Workspace

Deltek Tracking Number 2567007: When you opened a project in the classic workspace and viewed the Project Elements pane, the project parameter best practice () and global best practice () tags did not initially appear until you performed an action, such as adding an element. The tags continued to disappear and reappeared only after you performed another action.

Error Message After Best Practices Application

Deltek Tracking Number 2618357: When your firm has an existing best practice set for a family and you added the family's parent assembly to a new eligible project, the new workspace displayed an error message. The family with the best practice tag was successfully added.

This issue occurred only for specific families. This issue also occurred in the classic workspace.

Smart Reports

This section includes descriptions of enhancements with Smart Reports.

Slow Saving Times After Generating an Office Master Report

Deltek Tracking Number 2621303: When you generated an Office Master Report, saving times slowed for you and other users in the project workspace and office master workspace.
