# Deltek Specpoint 1.0

Release Notes for BPM Users

**September 15, 2021**

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## Overview

Welcome to Specpoint 1.0!

The Deltek Specpoint Release Notes for Building Product Manufacturers contain a summary of the key features for the first release.

## Specpoint Overview

Deltek Specpoint addresses three major shortcomings of today's A/E design processes: best practices, design automation, and product selection.

### Best Practices

Specpoint enables A/E professional firms to maintain their best practices throughout the entire design process of their projects. This platform preserves a firm's intellectual property as subject matter experts retire and leave the firm.

These best practices include the documentation and configuration of the underlying associative connections between project-based criteria called *modifiers* and performance properties or product property sets. These associations are the core to deploying the automation, which ensures the optimization of a firm's preferred products and installation requirements during the design process.

The associations reduce the risk of specifying inappropriate manufacturer products and materials for a given project type or set of criteria, such as building typology, geographic considerations, and industry-standardized construction types.

### Design Automation

Specpoint's design automation allows the proper use of best practices across a firm and its projects. The module focuses on selecting materials and products through a pictorial process, and then the coordination of these selections to the BIM model to ensure complete and accurate project drawing and specification coordination.

The product selection process integrates with the product selection module by presenting listed products from various building product manufacturers within the product database.

### Product Selection

For product selection, Specpoint provides an online storehouse of product listing cards for BPMs who want to present their products to designers in A/E firms during the design phase of a building design process. This module provides a self-serve environment for manufacturers to upload, maintain, and present specific products that fall within standard product types listed in the Specpoint product type listings.

BPMs can offer their products in different listing types:

- Premium MasterSpec
- Premium
- Premium Proprietary
- Manufacturer

These listing types allow BPMs to control the amount of information that their products include and the products' usability in MasterSpec sections. During the design process, Specpoint presents authors and designers in A/E firms with product listings in a visual and e-commerce-like environment.

## Release Highlights

Highlights of this release include the following:

- **Navigation:** Specpoint includes various menus for accessing the different pages, windows, and features in Specpoint.
- **Dashboard:** This dashboard serves as a single point of access to information and resources to help you manage your BPM operations. The dashboard includes the Project Research Map, Firm Contacts widget, ENR News widget, and Deltek News widget.
- **Products:** Specpoint provides features and pages in the Products area, which enable you to manage your company profile and your company's product listings.
- **Industry Analytics:** Features for industry analytics enable you to generate reports and study how A/E firms add content and manufacturers to their project specifications.
- **Admin Settings:** Use these settings to update your company account information and manage users for your BPM.
- **User Settings:** These settings enable you to update your user information, access other BPM accounts as a guest user, change your password, and log out of Specpoint.
- **Help Resources:** Specpoint provides you with multiple resources that you can access if you need information and assistance.

## Key Features

### BPM Account Setup

As the designated account administrator, you can set up the account for your firm and your own user account to enable your firm's access to Specpoint. After you receive a user invitation email from Deltek, Specpoint requires you to perform the following:

- Enter your new password.
- Update your user profile information.
- Update your firm's account settings and information.

### User Account

This portion includes descriptions of the available features for user accounts in Specpoint.

#### User Account Setup

You can set up your user account to log in and access Specpoint. After you receive a user invitation email from your BPM administrator, you must enter your new password and update your user profile information.

#### User Login

With an active user account, you can log in to Specpoint. On the Log In page, enter your valid email address and password to log in.

If you forget your password, you can reset your password from the Log In page by using your valid email address.

### Common Application Elements

This portion includes descriptions of available common application elements that you can use in various areas and pages in Specpoint.

#### User Interface

Specpoint's user interface design optimizes user experience and navigation. The platform's user interface is responsive, which adjusts your view of the available data and options on each page to accommodate various screen resolutions, browser window sizes, and devices.

## Navigation

### Top Menu

You can use this menu to access general features in Specpoint. On the top menu, the following options are available:

- **Navigation Menu Toggle** : Show or hide the navigation menu.
- **Help Menu** : Access the available help resources.
- **User Profile Menu**: Access options for your user account. For administrators, options for managing your A/E firm account are available.
- **Change Account** : Change BPM accounts. This option is only available if you are a guest user in another BPM within Specpoint.

### Navigation Menu

You can use this menu to access key areas and pages in Specpoint. On the navigation menu, the following options are available:

- **Home**: Open the dashboard, the Project Research Map, and other available widgets.
- **Products**: Access the Products area and open the Product Listings page. Use this area to manage your company page and product listings as well as view company pages and product listings from other BPMs.
- **Industry Analytics**: Open the Industry Analytics page to generate reports and access industry data.
- **Settings**: This option is only available to BPM administrators. Access the following administrative settings for your BPM:
  - **Account**: Open the Account Settings page and manage account information for your BPM.

- **Manage Users:** Open the User Management page and manage users within your BPM.

You can show or hide the navigation menu by clicking the Menu icon ()

## Help Menu

You can use this menu from the help icon () to access help resources for Specpoint. On the help menu, the following options are available:

- **Online Help:** Access user documentation.
- **Email Help Desk:** Depending on your user permission, send an email to your BPM's designated account administrator or Specpoint's dedicated help desk for support requests or questions.
- **Deltek Support Center:** As the designated account administrator for your BPM, submit a case or call/chat with Deltek Customer Care.
- **Privacy Policy:** View Deltek's privacy policy.
- **Terms of Use:** View Specpoint's terms of use.

## User Profile Menu

You can use this menu to manage your Specpoint user account. On the user profile menu, the following options are available:

## Project Research Map

Specpoint includes the Project Research Map, which enables you to browse and research project data from firms within Specpoint or Deltek e-SPECS. You can use this feature to research the following layers of information for each project: overview, families, and manufacturers.

In the project research map, the following components are available:

- Project Filters Pane
- Map Tab

### Project Filters

Multiple project filters are available. In this pane, you can use the following filter options to filter or search for projects:

- Select Saved Search
- Days Since Project Updated
- Country
- State
- Building Type
- Sustainability
- Construction Budget
- Assembly
- Family
- Manufacturer Specified
- Manufacturer

You can configure any combination of filters. The filters are dynamic. When you select a value for a filter, other filters will display only the available options with respect to your current selection.

You can also save, load, and delete search criteria to maintain insight on a group of projects over a period of time. The search criteria that you specify in the project filters apply to the Project Heat Map and Top 10 Results on the Map tab and the All Search Results list on the Results tab.

### Map Tab

The Map tab displays the project data through a heat map representation. You can use the project heat map on this tab to navigate to and view project locations. You can also perform the following actions on the map:

- Pan to different map locations.
- Zoom in and out.
- Revert to the default location and zoom level.
- Show or hide the map legend.

### Top 10 Results

On the Map tab, you can access the Top 10 Results list, which displays the top 10 projects that fit the currently set filters. You can use this pane to view the top 10 search results in a list view simultaneously with the project heat map. This pane previews each project with the following information:

- Last Updated
- State/Province
- Building Type
- Budget

## Key Features

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### Results Tab

The Results tab displays all project data or filtered search results in a list view. You can view the projects with the following information and options:

- Date Last Updated
- State/Province
- Building Type
- Contract Type
- Construction Type
- Sustainability
- Construction Budget
- Level of Specification
- View Option

You can sort the projects based on the information above and export the list of projects as a CSV, XLSX, or PDF file.

You can also use this tab to access overview, family element, and manufacturer information for a specific project. The following windows are available for viewing project information:

- Project Overview Data Window
- Project Manufacturers Window

### Project Overview Window

You can use this window to view overview information about a project and its family elements. In the Project Overview window, the following information is available:

- Last Updated
- Construction Budget
- Family Sources
- Sustainability

You can also view the list of family elements and filter the families by family name and family source/base document.

### Project Manufacturers Window

The Project Manufacturers window lists the available manufacturers and their product listings for a given family as well as if the A/E firm specified the product listing in the family element. You can use this page to view the content outline of the family in the Family Detail portion.

### Firm Contacts

You can use this widget to quickly access contacts within your A/E firm. For each contact, the following information is available:

- Name
- Role

### ENR News

You can use this widget to preview and access news from Engineering News-Record. This widget lists recent ENR news articles and shows the title and snippet for each article.

### Recently Listed

You can use this widget to view and access more information about the newest available product listings. This widget lists the four latest published product listings with their respective BPM's logo or name, product name, and photo preview.

You can also use this widget to open the Product Listings page. This enables you to browse and research the available product listings within Specpoint.

### Deltek News

You can use this widget to quickly access the Deltek Media Center web page and read the latest news about Deltek.

## Products

Specpoint provides features and pages in the Products area which enable you to manage your company profile and your company's product listings.

### Product Listings Page

You can use the Product Listings page to view available product listings from BPMs within Specpoint.

To browse and research product listings on this page, you can perform the following actions:

- View all product listings from your firm or company.
- View all active and completed product listings from other BPMs.

## Key Features

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- Use the available filter options to filter and search for product listings.
- Open the Grouping and Sorting window and sort product listings.
- Open the Grouping and Sorting window and group product listings.
- View product listing information on the product listing cards.
- Open the Manage Listings page and view a product listing's complete details and related resources.
- Navigate to the My Company Page.

## Product Listing Filters

On the Product Listings page, you can configure any combination of filters or clear set filters. The following product listing filters are available:

- Category
- Company
- Listing Type
- Families
- Product Type and Properties
- Partnerships
- Additional Content
- Date Range
- State
- Status

The filters are dynamic. When you select a value for a filter, other filters will show only the available options with respect to your current selection. For example, if you set **Category to Ceilings**, you can only select companies that have product listings under the Ceiling category in the **Company** filter.

## Grouping and Sorting Window

You can use the Grouping and Sorting window to group and/or sort the available product listings on the Product Listings page. The Grouping and Sorting window organizes its controls onto the following tabs:

- Grouping
- Sorting

### Grouping Tab

You can use this tab to configure up to three grouping criteria which apply to the product listings on the Product Listing page. For each grouping criterion, the following options are available:

- **Attribute:** This is the product listing attribute by which to group listings, such as the product's company, listing type, state, and family.
- **Collapsed:** This determines whether the Product Listings page shows or hides the product listings under the group by default.
- **X:** Click this button to delete the grouping criterion.

When you group product listings based on an available attribute, Specpoint automatically adds a sorting criteria for the same attribute.

### Sorting Tab

You can use this tab to configure up to five sorting criteria which apply to the product listings on the Product Listing page. For each sorting criterion, the following options are available:

- **Grip Icon** : This enables you to arrange sorting criteria by your desired order.
- **Options**: This is the product listing attribute by which to sort listings, such as the product's company, listing type, state, and family.
- **Sort**: This determines whether to sort by ascending or descending order.
- **X**: Click this button to delete the sorting criterion.

### Product Listing Card

A product listing card represents a product that a BPM offers within Specpoint. On the Product listings page, you can use product listing cards to preview general information about a product. You can perform the following additional actions from a product listing card:

- Open the Manage Listing page for the product listing to view more details about the product.
- Open the Company page for the listing's BPM to view more details about the product's manufacturer.
- Download available documents for the listing.

On each product listing card, the following information is available as applicable to its listing type:

- Corporate Logo or Company Display Name
- Approval Logo
- Publication Date
- Status
- Photos and Videos
- Category
- Product Name
- Family
- Product Type
- Listing Type
- Additional Content Icons

For Premium MasterSpec, Premium, and Premium Proprietary listings, product listing cards can have additional content icons which indicate the availability of documents for download. You can use the following icons to view and download the available documents from the product listing card:

- Catalog

- Full Length or Product Specification Document 

- Short Form 

### Product Listing Type

Each product listing has a type which determines the available information about the product and how A/E firms can specify the listing in their project specifications. The following product listing types are available:

### Product Listing State

Each product listing has a state to indicate its current stage through the product submission and review process and determine its readiness for public availability. The following product listing states are available:

- Premium Review
- Premium Review - BPM Submitted

- Premium MasterSpec Review - BPM Submitted
- Proprietary Review
- Proprietary Review - BPM Submitted
- Completed

To add a product listing for your BPM, you must perform the tasks in the product submission process.

## Manage Listing Page

The Manage Listing page displays all available information about the product listing and its related resources. You can access this page from a product listing card on the Product Listings page to learn more about a product listing.

The contents of this page depend on multiple factors, such as the product's BPM, listing type, status, and state.

The following are available as applicable to the Manufacturer listing type:

- Corporate Logo and/or Company Name
- Category
- Family Number
- Family
- Product Type
- First Publish Date
- Last Publish Date

For Premium MasterSpec, Premium, and Premium Proprietary listings, the following are available:

- Product Type Properties (This is not available for Premium Proprietary listings.)

For your BPM's product listings, this page displays additional attributes about the product listing. The following product listing attributes are available for viewing only:

## Manage Listing Page - Edit Mode

You can use this page to manage your company's product listings. This page enables you to perform the following actions:

- Enable edit mode.
- Update a listing's available information.
- Update the assigned BPM users for the listing.
- Update a listing's related resources.
- Save the updates and modifications that you made to the product listing.
- Submit the product listing for Deltek review.
