Overview

The Costpoint 8 Cobra Integration automates the loading of actual costs from Costpoint to Cobra using Cobra Web Service.

There are three steps to implement the Cobra integration with Costpoint GovCon Cloud systems:

- Step 1: Configure Cobra and Costpoint for Integration
- Step 2: Configure Firewall for Inbound Connections
- Step 3: Submit a Deltek Costpoint Cloud Service Request

Step 1: Configure Cobra and Costpoint for Integration

Step 2: Configure Firewall for Inbound Connections

The connection from your Costpoint GovCon Cloud system to your Cobra Web Service requires allowing inbound TCP Port 443 SOAP connections from Deltek's cloud IP addresses to the network on which the Cobra Web Service is deployed.

Open a case with Deltek Customer Care to obtain the list of IP addresses to be allowed.

Step 3: Submit a Deltek Costpoint Cloud Service Request

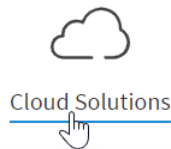

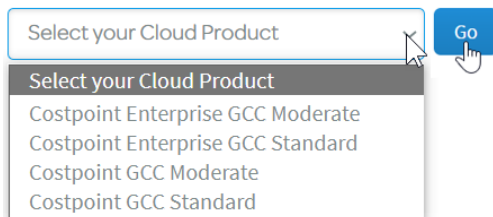
You must submit a request for each Costpoint/Cobra system pair (for example, Costpoint Production and Cobra Production).

To submit a Cobra Integration service request:

1. Log into the [Deltek Support Center](#) and navigate to [Cloud Solutions](#).



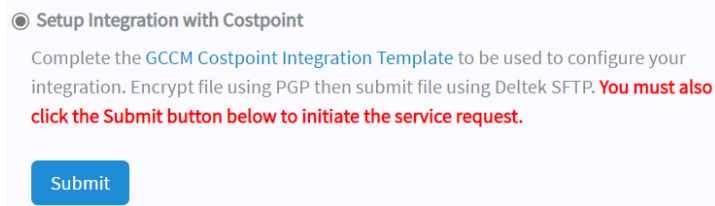
2. Select your Cloud Product, and click **Go**.



3. From the **SERVICE REQUESTS** list, select **Costpoint GCC Integration Setup**.

Please note that the name of the service request is different for each cloud product:

- For Costpoint Enterprise GCC Moderate, select **Setup Integration with Costpoint**.



Step 3: Submit a Deltek Costpoint Cloud Service Request

- For Costpoint Enterprise GCC Standard, select **Costpoint Enterprise GCC Standard Integration Setup**.

Additional Instructions (Domain Names):

Update only specified systems.

- Download and unzip the CostpointIntegrationConfigurationTemplates.zip file.
- Complete the Cobra integration spreadsheet (Cobra.xlsx).
Detailed instructions for completing the spreadsheet are included in the spreadsheet itself.
- Save and rename the completed spreadsheet to include your Company ID and the date submitted.
- Upload the completed Cobra_CompanyID_Date.xlsx spreadsheet.
 - GCC Standard** customers upload their spreadsheet directly in the service request widget. Upload the spreadsheet now and click **Submit** to open a new case for this request.
 - GCC Moderate** customers must encrypt and upload the spreadsheet using Deltek SFTP. Click **Submit** now to create a new case for this request, and then use the following instructions to perform the encryption and upload the file:
