Description: When you attempted to import a Deltek Time and Expense timesheet with a timesheet line that contained an invalid charge, the application partially imported the timesheet to Costpoint. In this scenario, if a timesheet line was rejected, the whole timesheet should be rejected, and the timesheet records should not be created for the timesheet.

Customers Impacted: This defect affects Costpoint users who import timesheets from Deltek Time and Expense.

Description: When the timesheet period that was being prorated included a holiday, the application prorated all days except for the holiday and auto-adjusted the holiday timesheet to the full salary amount.

Description: The manufacturing order information was not defaulting correctly when you used the direct interface to upload timesheets from Deltek Time and Expense.

Customers Impacted: This defect affects Costpoint users who upload timesheets directly from Deltek Time and Expense.

Workaround Before Fix: The following are the workarounds for this issue:

- Use the Import Timesheets screen for uploading timesheets to costpoint.
- Enter manufacturing order information through the Manage Timesheets screen.
- Use the standard file export from Deltek Time and Expense.

Description: If no rate existed in the **Override Auto Adjust%** field, the application only used the default auto-adjust rate from the TS_PD table. The application should be using the default auto-adjust rate from the child table (TS_PD_SCH) to be in sync with other timesheet applications.

Customers Impacted: This defect affects Costpoint Labor users.

Workaround Before Fix: Enter a rate in the **Override Auto Adjust%** field.
