Description: When you ran the Manage Asset Transfer Transactions application, the header label was incorrectly displayed as "Edit-Mas-Added Asset Transfer Transactions" in Table view instead of the correct "Asset Transfer Transactions", which was displayed when in Form view. The incorrect header label was only shown when in Auto-Position.
