Description: If the local tax was based on **YTD Tax** and the YTD accrual was greater than the base tax amount, the Compute Payroll process determined the negative adjustment, but then changed it to a positive number. This resulted in overstating the local tax accrual.

Customers Impacted: This defect affects Costpoint Payroll users who have a local tax based on YTD tax and change the tax tables to a lower maximum accrual after employees already reach the original maximum accrual.

Workaround Before Fix: Manual adjustment of the local tax accrual after computing payroll.
