Description: When users tried to save records in Manage Contracts using the **Save & Continue** function, a performance issue occurred due to the way that the application retrieves financial information. Several screens have been updated, and a new application has been created to resolve this issue. Print Project Labor Summary Report has been updated to use the fiscal year, period, and subperiod values on the Configure Contract Management Settings or Configure Opportunity Settings screen when running the Project Labor Summary Report from the Manage Contracts, Manage Opportunities, and Manage Subcontracts screens if the **Use Accounting Period Below** option is selected in Configure Contract Management Settings or Configure Opportunity Settings.

Customers Impacted: This change affects users of the Contract Management feature in Costpoint.
