

Costpoint Enterprise Reporting (CER) Name Change to Costpoint Business Intelligence

ANNOUNCEMENT: TO ALL CER CUSTOMERS

With the launch of Costpoint version 8.0, we will be renaming CER to Costpoint Business Intelligence (Costpoint BI).

WHY THE CHANGE

While CER was mainly focused on running and creating reports, Costpoint BI has capabilities that extend well beyond reporting. It is important to remember that while the name CER is going away, Costpoint Business Intelligence is the same trusted solution, leveraging IBM Cognos Analytics which provides complete Business Intelligence. Costpoint BI 8.0 introduces innovative features that leverage Artificial Intelligence to make it easier to create dashboards and explore your data. Our new name exemplifies and aligns with all that the solution has to offer.

HOW THE CHANGE WILL BE REPRESENTED

Moving forward, you may see the product name represented in a few different ways:

- Costpoint Business Intelligence (formerly CER)
- Costpoint Business Intelligence
- Costpoint BI
- CP BI

WHERE YOU MIGHT WITNESS THE CHANGE

- **Invoices.** Moving forward, when you receive a Deltek invoice you might notice that instead of the product line referencing “Costpoint Enterprise Reporting (CER)”, it will say “Costpoint Business Intelligence (CP BI).
- **Insight.** Virtual Insight will reference “Costpoint Business Intelligence (CP BI)”, rather than “Costpoint Enterprise Reporting (CER)”. Keep this in mind as you register for sessions that “Costpoint Business Intelligence (CP BI)” sessions are still applicable for what would have previously been “Costpoint Enterprise Reporting (CER)”.
- **The Software.** You will still access in Costpoint within Reporting and Analytics, but now the menu item says Business Intelligence instead of Enterprise Reporting.
