**Description:** When you created a purchase order (PO), the GFE/GFM Inventory abbreviations did not appear and the associated Project ID was not included. In addition, the GFE/GFM Inventory Abbreviation should have pulled only the Project ID.

**Customers Impacted:** This defect affects Costpoint users.

**Workaround Before Fix:** Load the Project ID and delete the Org ID that defaults with the Project ID.
