Enhancements

The following features/enhancements are added for iAccess 1.3.4:

- Explicit Time Sheet Creation

Explicit Time Sheet Creation

Tracking Number: 526508

iAccess now supports an enhancement already available in Core Maconomy, which was introduced to prevent users from accidentally creating time sheets. You can use two company-specific system parameters in Maconomy to customize how iAccess behaves when users navigate calendars in the Weekly and Daily Time Sheet tabs. Specifically, you can customize the following:

- Whether iAccess automatically creates a time sheet whenever users click a date (or week)

If you disable the "Create Time Sheets Automatically" system parameter, the **Create Time Sheet** action is added to both time sheet tabs. Users need to click this action whenever they want to create a time sheet. This is the case whether the "Create Daily Time Sheets for Non-working Days" system parameter is enabled or disabled.

If both parameters are enabled, iAccess automatically creates time sheets for any date (or week) that users click when navigating calendars. The **Create Time Sheet** action does not appear as an option.

- Whether iAccess automatically creates a daily time sheet whenever users click a date that falls on a non-working day (depends on the normal work hours/schedule specified for each employee)

If "Create Time Sheets Automatically" is enabled and "Create Daily Time Sheets for Non-working Days" is disabled, iAccess automatically creates time sheets for any date (or week) that users click as long as the date does not fall on a non-working day. If it falls on a non-working day, users need to click **Create Time Sheet** to manually create a time sheet. This is the default setting.



This enhancement is only available if you are running iAccess 1.3.4 with Maconomy 2.3 GA in the backend.

Software Issues Resolved

There are no software issues resolved for this release.

Known Issues

Tablet Support

iPad: Headers and Sum Footers Cover Drop-down Menus and Information Bubbles

Defect: 498559

Browser: Safari

Description: The headers and sum footers in the Timesheet, Expense Sheet, Mileage, and Favorites screens cover drop-downs and information bubbles when they are opened, making them difficult to use.

While not specific to tablets, the issue is more severe on tablets because scrolling is more difficult and the screen size is limited and not resizable.

Customers Impacted: Affects all clients using iPads.

Workaround Before Fix: N/A

iPad/Android: Drop-down Opens Upwards When No Room Below

Defect: 498567

Browser: Safari (for iPad), Chrome (for Android)

Description: If you open a drop-down list for a field and there is no space below the field, the drop-down opens upwards.

Customers Impacted: Affects all clients using tablets.

Workaround Before Fix: Scroll until the field reaches the top of the screen, then open that field's drop-down list.

iPad: It Takes Two Taps to Enter Field Edit Mode

Defect: 498565

Browser: Safari

Description: If you want to edit a field, you need to tap the field twice before the cursor appears.

Customers Impacted: Affects all clients using iPads.

Workaround Before Fix: N/A

iAccess

Unicode Characters in Receipt Filename Not Displayed Correctly

Defect: 607656

Browser: IE11, Safari, and Chrome

Description: When you upload a receipt with a filename containing Unicode characters to an expense sheet, the characters are not displayed correctly after the upload.

Customers Impacted: Affects all clients trying to upload receipts with filenames containing Unicode characters to expense sheets.

Workaround Before Fix: Use the Workspace Client to upload the receipt to the relevant expense sheet.

If you do not have access to the Workspace Client, simply rename the receipt file before using iAccess to upload. Note that this does not apply for iAccess users on tablets.



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
