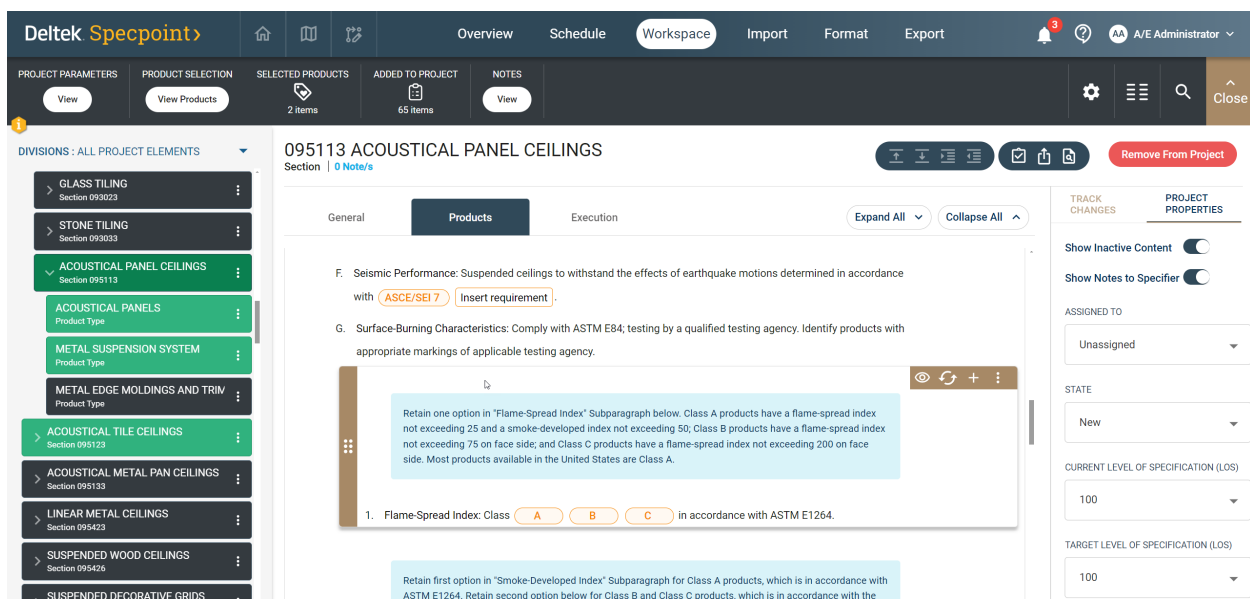

### Project Workspace Persistence in Divisions View

The Divisions view (or organization by MasterFormat®) of the project workspace now supports the persistence feature. This enhancement preserves your workflow against interruptions, such as other tasks, accidental clicks, connection timeouts, and session breaks.



In Divisions view, the project workspace and the Project Elements pane retain your opened element when you perform any of the following:

- Refresh the page.
- Leave and return to the project workspace.
- Close your browser and return to the project workspace in another session.

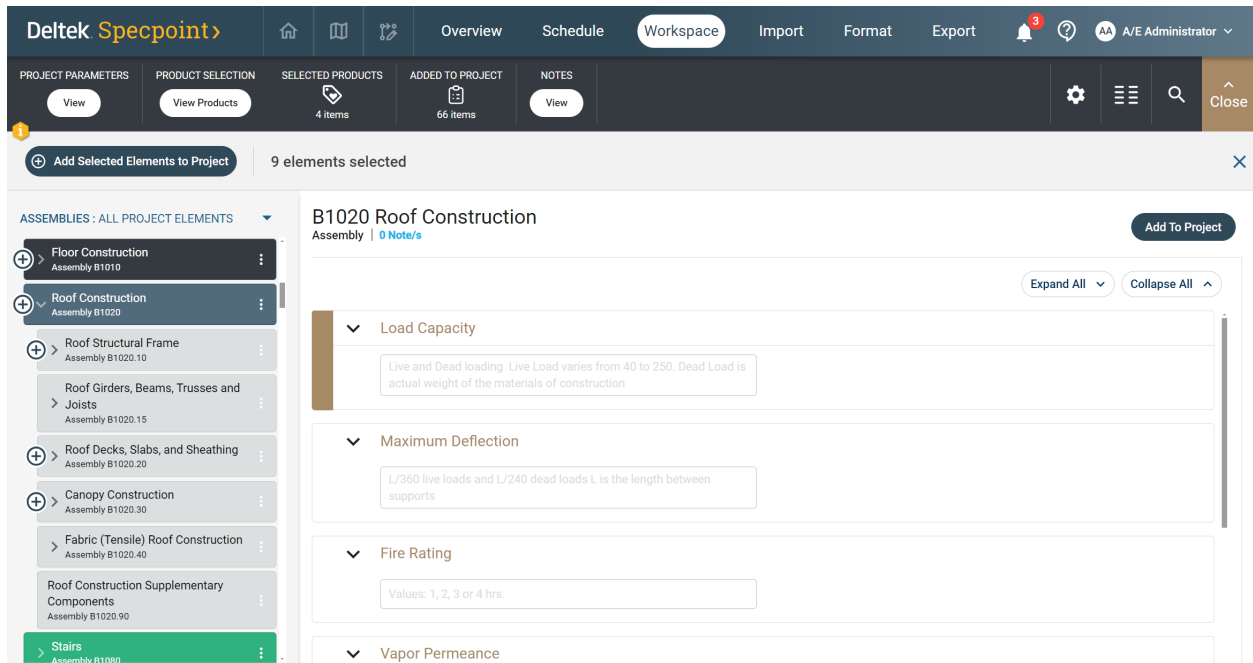

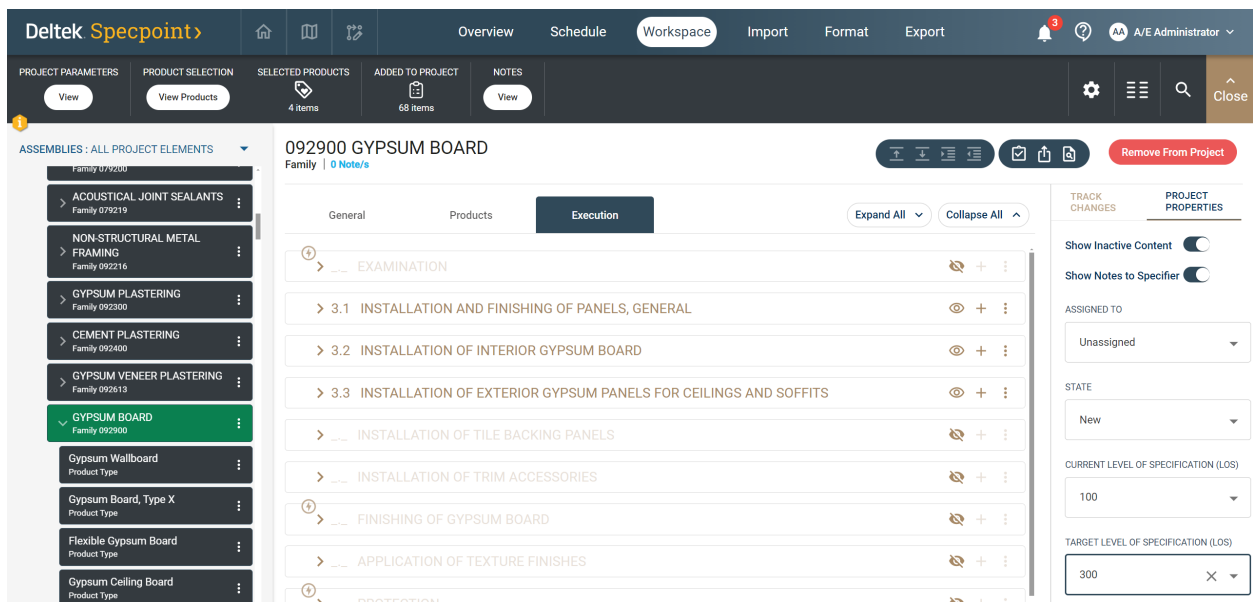
## Quick Add Without a Selected Family

**Bug 2091244:** When you selected only non-family elements for quick add and clicked **Add Selected Elements to Project**, the platform did not add your selected elements to the project and the project workspace displayed an error message.



## LOS-based Activation of Unadded Product Type Content

**Bug 2054589:** When you increased the **Target Level of Specification (LOS)** of a family in your project, the platform automatically activated LOS-associated content of product types that were not added to the project.



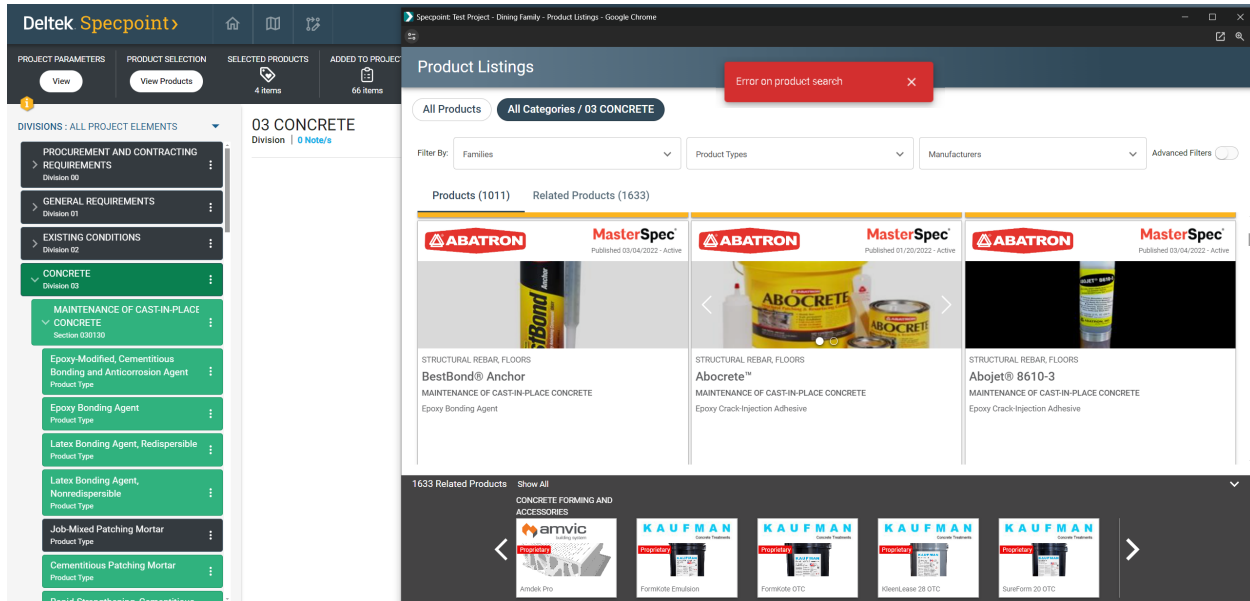
## Intelligent Product Selection

### Product Listings Window for Divisions View

**Bug 2085209:** When you opened the Product Listings window from the project workspace with Divisions view enabled, the Product Listings window displayed the following unexpected error message:

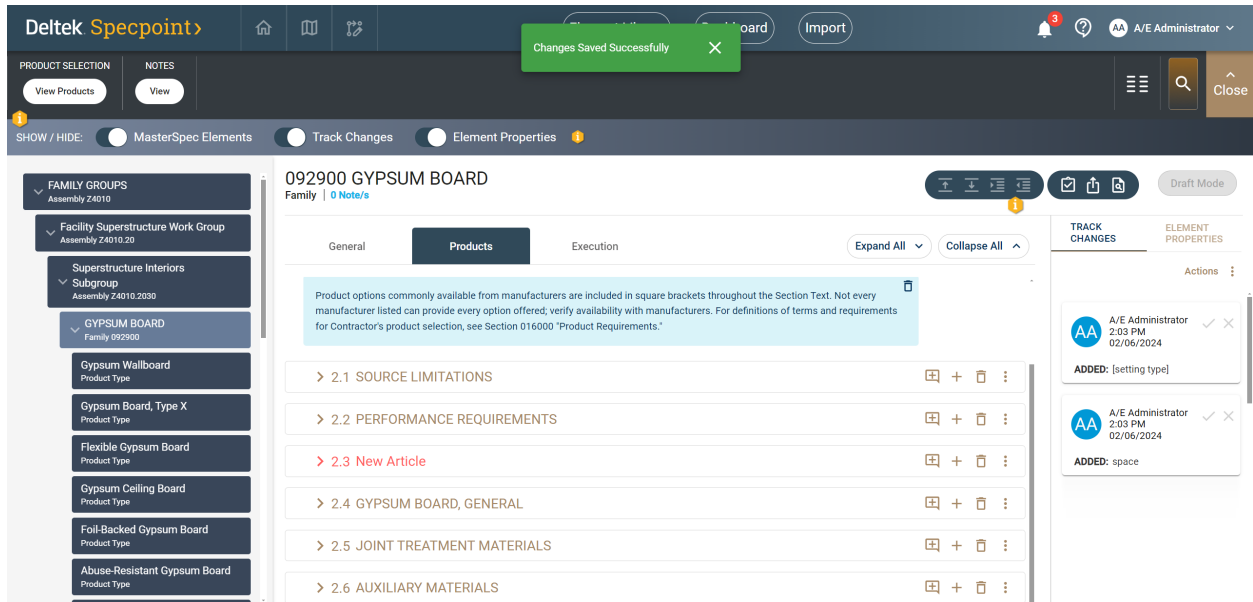


## Office Master Content

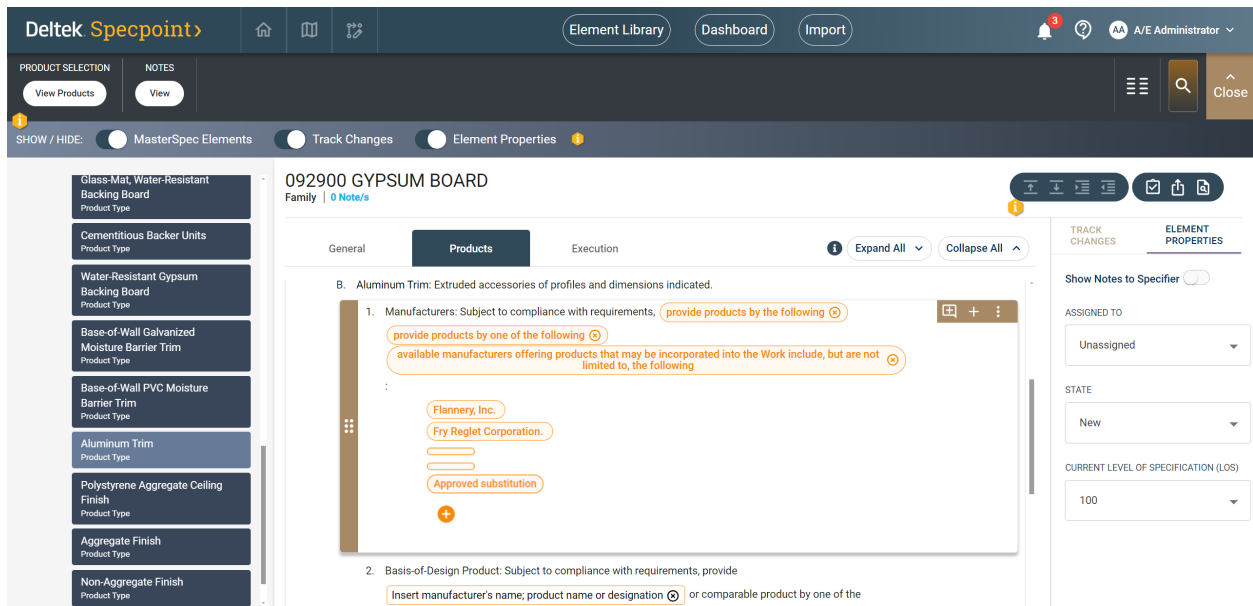
### Incorrect Article Position in the Office Master Workspace

**Bug 2087060:** When you added the article to an office master family and saved your changes, the office master workspace displayed the new article in an incorrect position.



## Empty Manufacturer Pills

**Bug 2061617:** When you added a product listing with a manufacturer key to an office master family, the office master workspace displayed the listing's corresponding option as a blank pill under its manufacturer paragraph or BOD product paragraph.



Typically, product listings with a manufacturer key adhere to the following format: **<Manufacturer Name>: <Product Name>.**

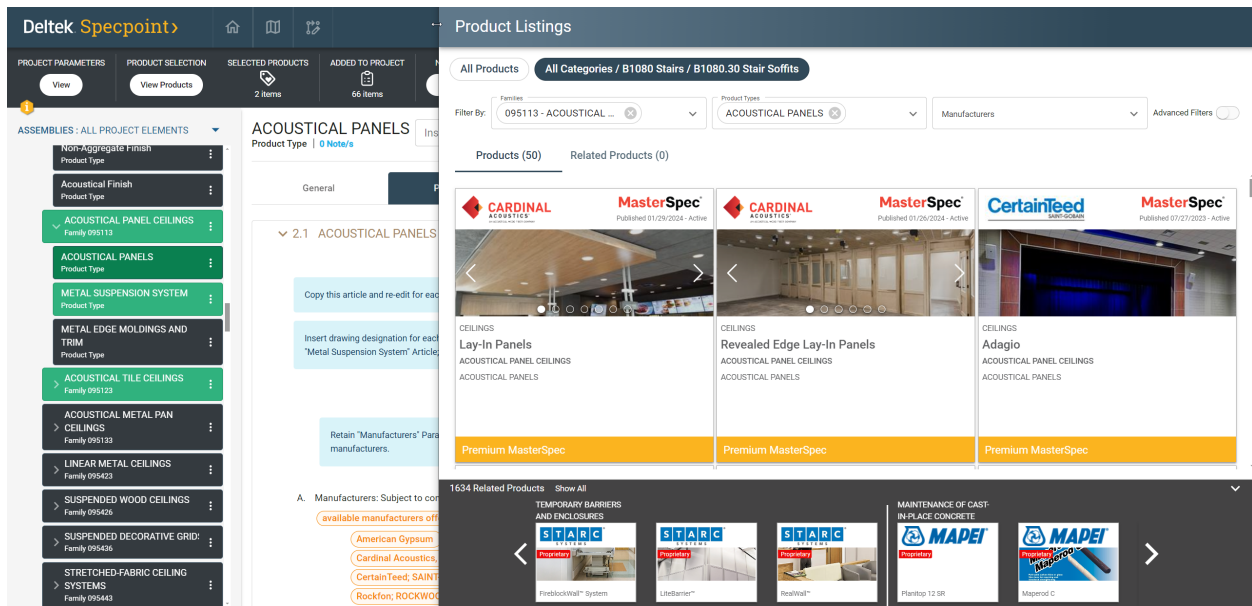

## New Features

This section includes summaries of the new features in this release.

### View Modes for the Product Listings Window

On the project level, you can now shift your view of the Product Listings window to show either all product listings or show product listings based on your selected project element in the project workspace. This feature enables you to review project data at either a high level or at a focused level. You no longer need to reset filters in both the Product Listings window and the project workspace to view all product listings.



In the Product Listings window, the following options are available:

Option/Pill	Description
<b>All Products</b>	Select this option to show all product listings and disable all filtering based on a specific project element selection.
<b>Element Path</b>	<p>This option displays an element path based on your selected element in the project workspace. This element path includes only your selected category and your selected assemblies or division. You can view your selected family, section, and product type in the <b>Families</b> and <b>Product Types</b> filter fields.</p> <p>Select this option to filter product listings by your selected project element.</p>

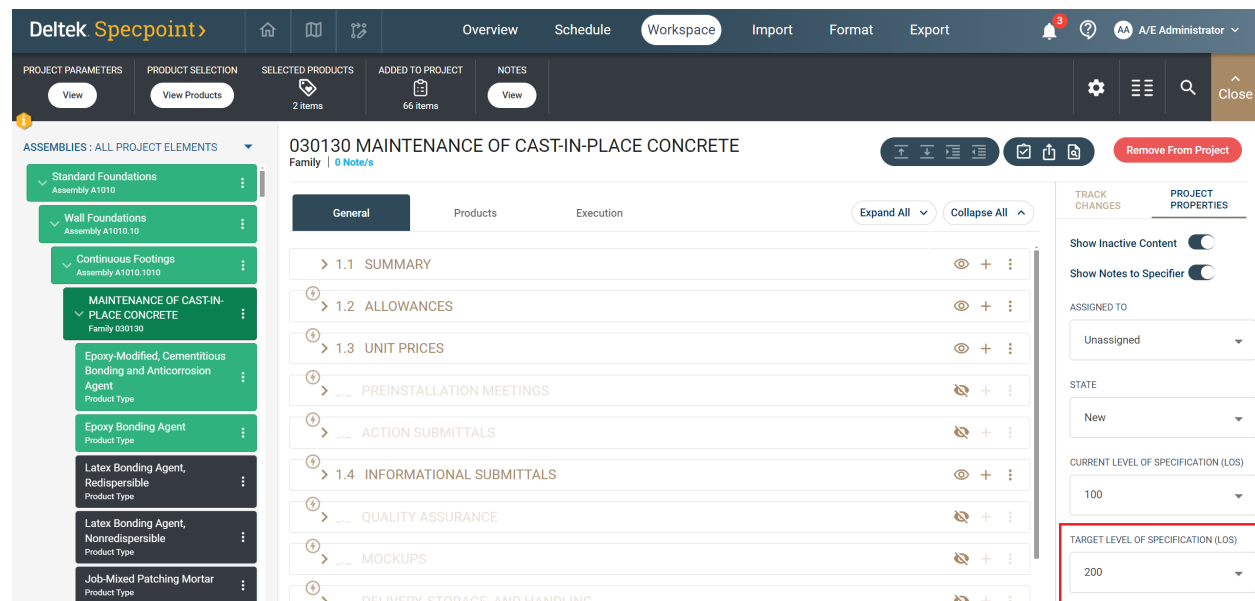

### Target LOS Automation for Individual Project Elements

On the Project Properties tab of the project workspace, the **Target Level of Specification (LOS)** field now includes design automation for LOS-associated articles and paragraphs, which are marked by . When you set the target LOS of an element, Specpoint automatically hides articles and paragraphs based on your selected LOS.

**Note:** Specpoint conceptualized the Level of Specification (LOS) schema to complement Level of Development (LOD), track progress and prioritization, and automate project development. LOS serves to automatically control the included content, such as the articles, properties, and paragraphs, of a project and its individual elements.

The default value of the target LOS of all elements within a project is based on the project's set **Level of Specification (LOS)** from project creation. A project element's target LOS overrides the project's baseline LOS only for the project element and its child elements. For example, when you set the target LOS of a family, you also set the LOS for all its product types. This includes product types that you add later.

### Keys for Product Type Generation on Import

The Specpoint converter now generates product types based on the following paragraph keys in your imported families:

- "Manufacturer"
- "Approved Manufacturers"
- "Products"



- “Basis-Of-Design”
- “Basis-of-Design Product”

These new keys are in addition to the existing keys that Specpoint uses, which include:

- “Manufacturers”
- “Basis-of-Design Product”
- Product type hyperlinks

This enhancement enables the platform to better identify product type requirements from documents that use variations of the manufacturer keys. You no longer have to edit your external families to exactly match the initial manufacturer keys.

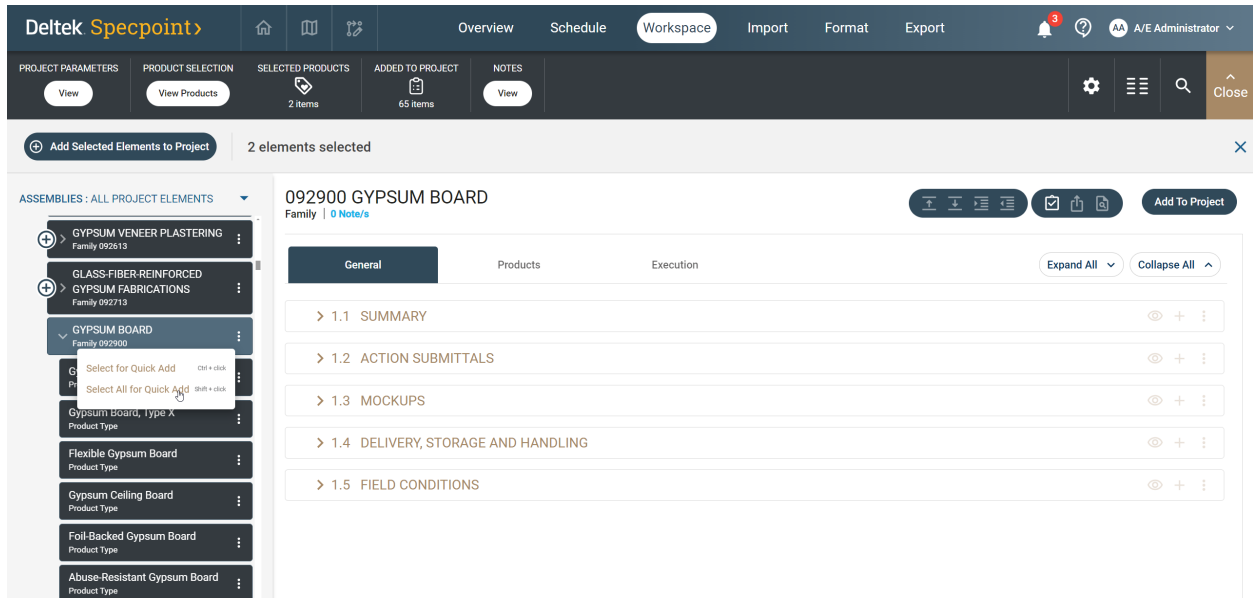

#### Select All for Quick Add Feature

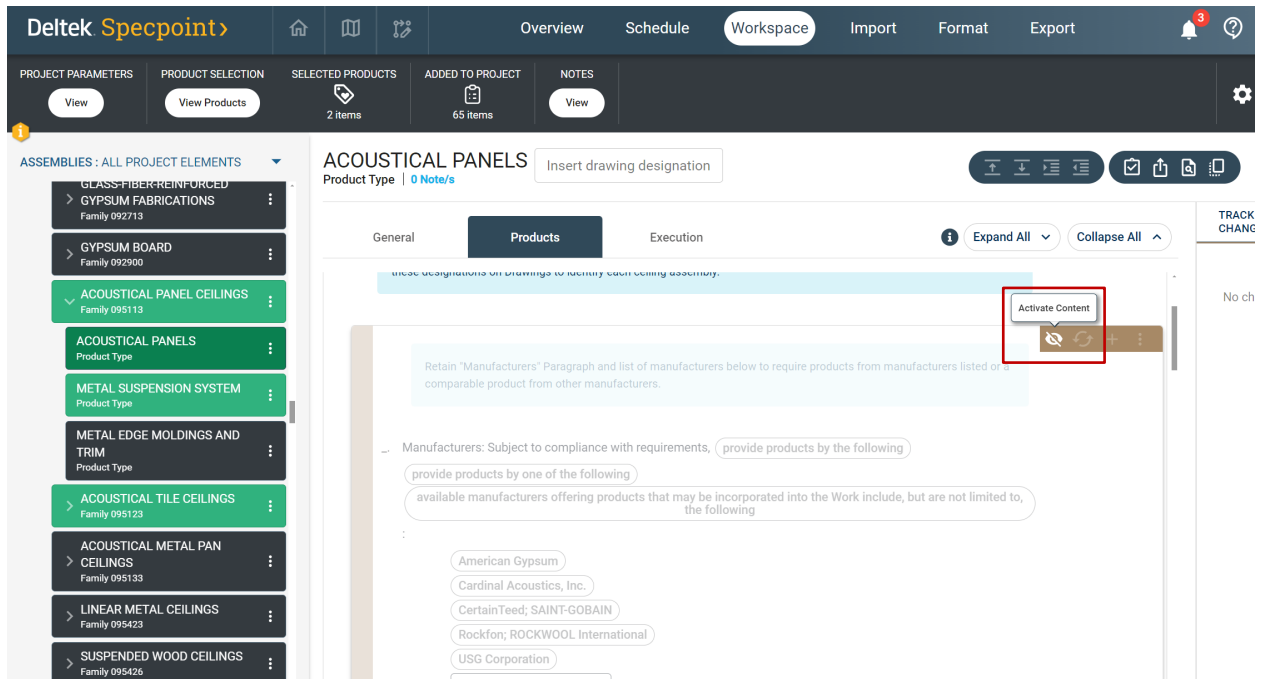
**Bug 2072746:** In the Project Elements pane of the project workspace, the **Select All for Quick Add (SHIFT+CLICK)** option did not work for some families. When you held SHIFT and clicked a family, the quick add feature did not mark all product types under the family as selected for quick add.

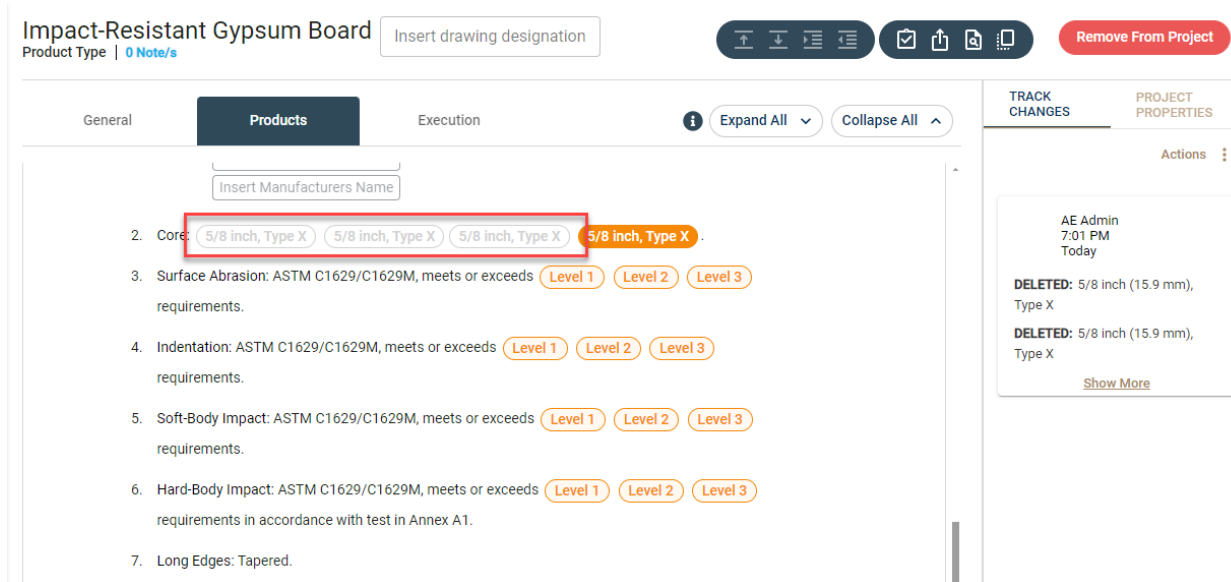
Unable to Activate or Inactivate Manufacturer and BOD Product Paragraphs

**Bug 2036187:** When you attempted to activate or inactivate a manufacturer paragraph or a basis-of-design (BOD) product paragraph, the platform did not respond. Clicking  or  in either paragraph within an added product type in the project workspace did not do anything.



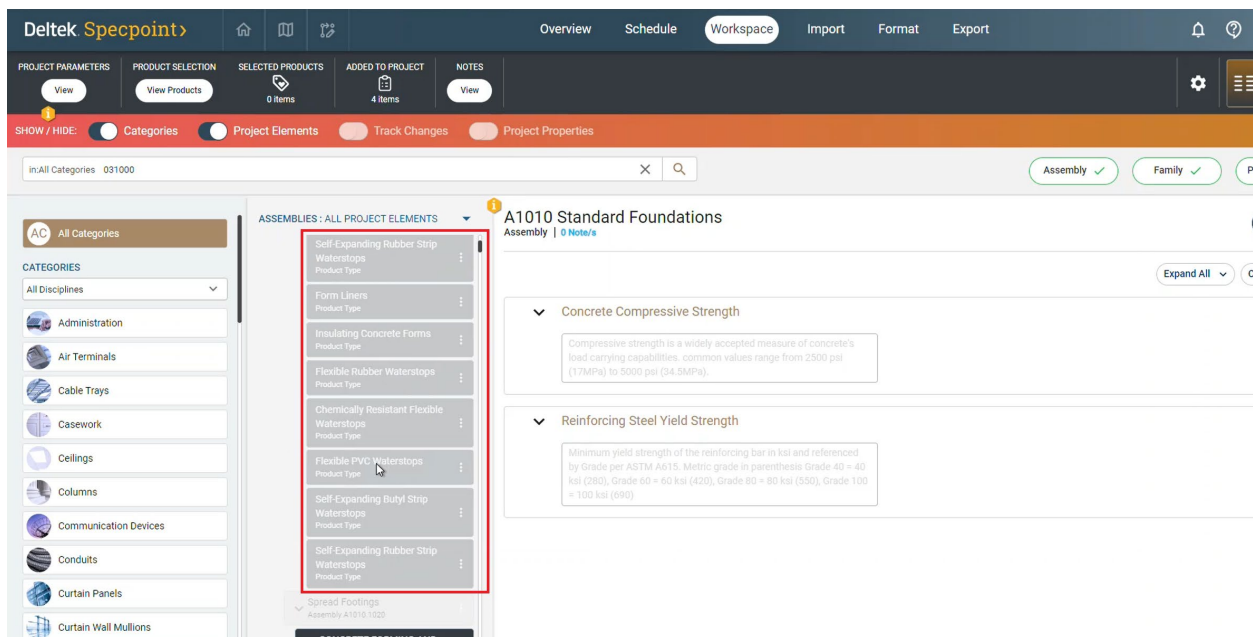
## Malfunctioning Options in Product Type Property Paragraphs

**Bug 2080890:** When you selected an added family or product type in the project workspace and selected an option/pill from an option set in a product type property paragraph on the element form, the other options in the option set copied the value of your selected option/pill. The option set also displayed an additional option with the same value.



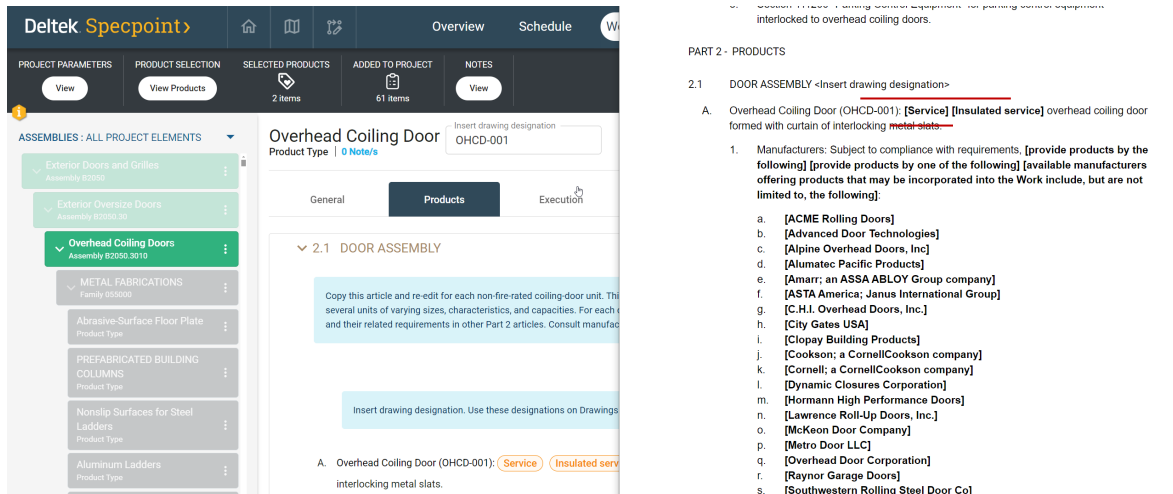
## Duplicate Product Types of Republished Office Master Families

**Bug 2052547:** When you deleted a published office master family from the element library and then reimported and republished an office master for the same family, the Project Elements pane of the project workspace displayed duplicate product types under the given family.



## Drawing Designation Field in the Preview and Exported Files

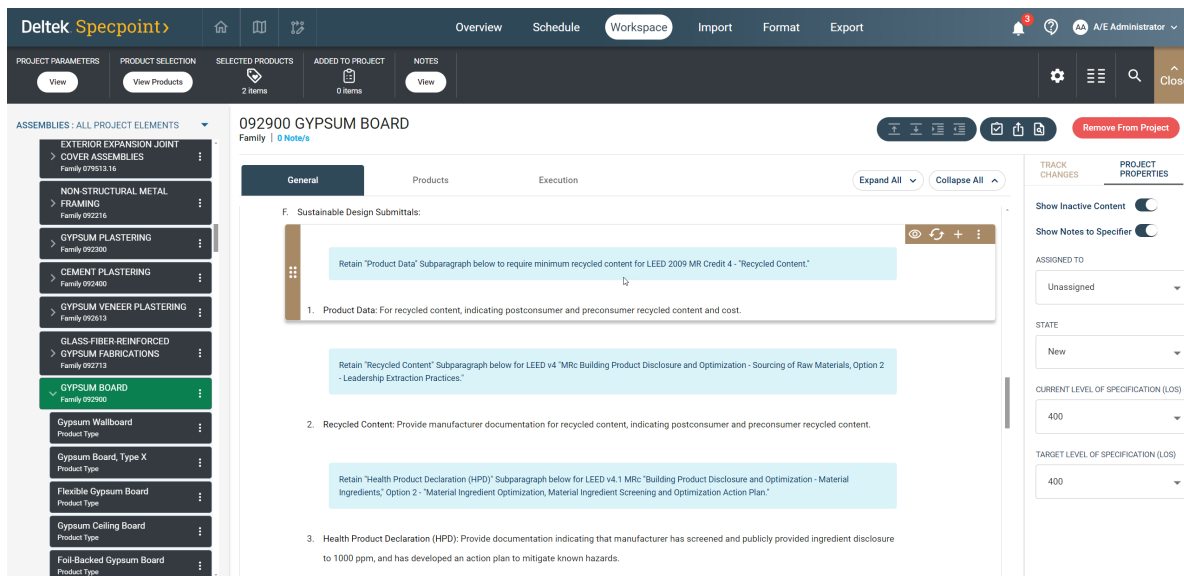
**Bug 2082721:** The parent paragraph of a product type paragraph displayed a placeholder for the drawing designation (<Insert drawing designation>) even when you entered a drawing designation for the given product type. This issue applied to select product types, such as **Overhead Coiling Door**.

## Automation for Sustainability Paragraphs in Published Families

**Bug 2036082:** When you added a family that is an instance of your firm's published office master family, the family's sustainability paragraphs did not automatically activate based on your project's set Sustainability parameter. This issue also affected some families that recently received content updates from Specpoint.

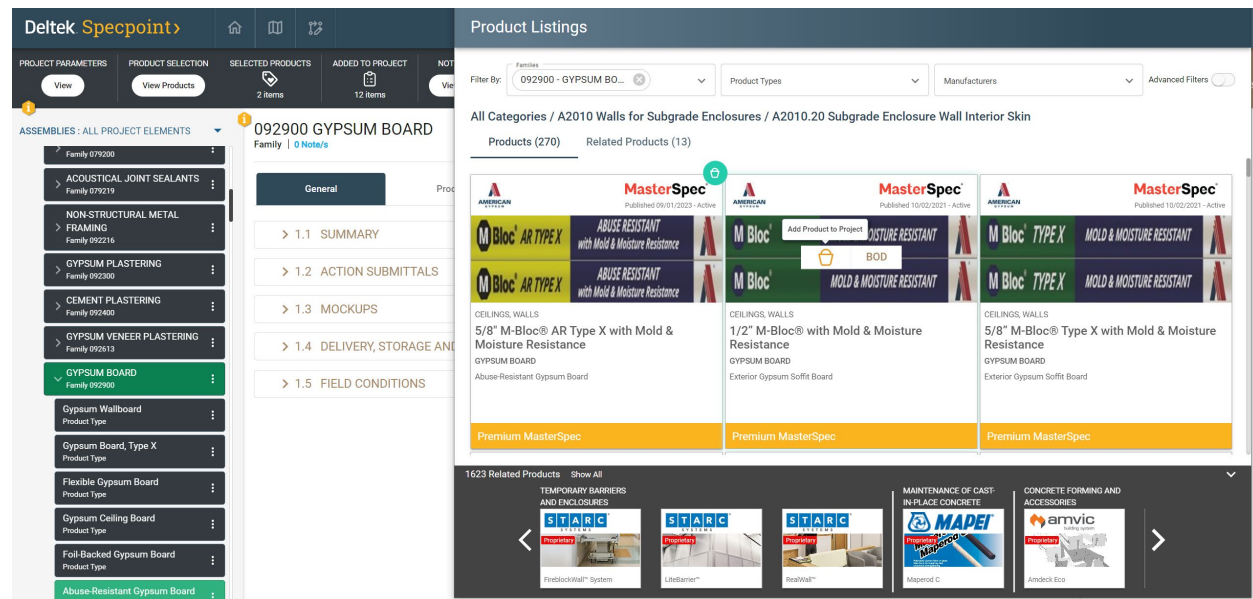

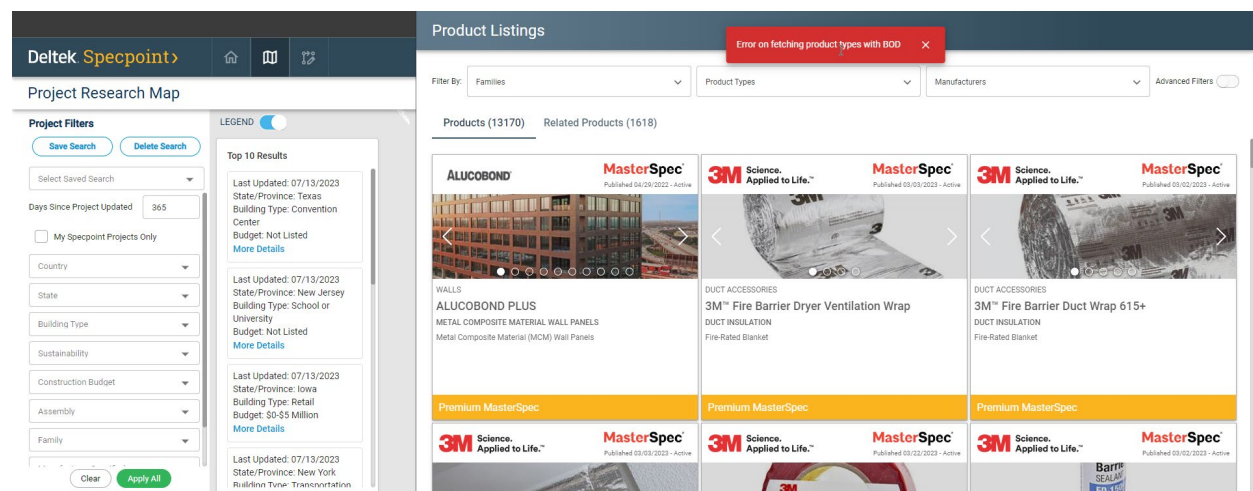
**Bug 2050226:** When you added a product listing to a project by clicking the  or **BOD** button, the product listing cards in the Product Listings window reloaded with an unexpected animation.



### Unexpected Error when Viewing Recently Listed Product Listings

**Bug 1967646:** When you opened the Product Listings window from the Recently Listed widget on the home dashboard, the Product Listings window displayed the following error message:

*Error on fetching product types with BOD*

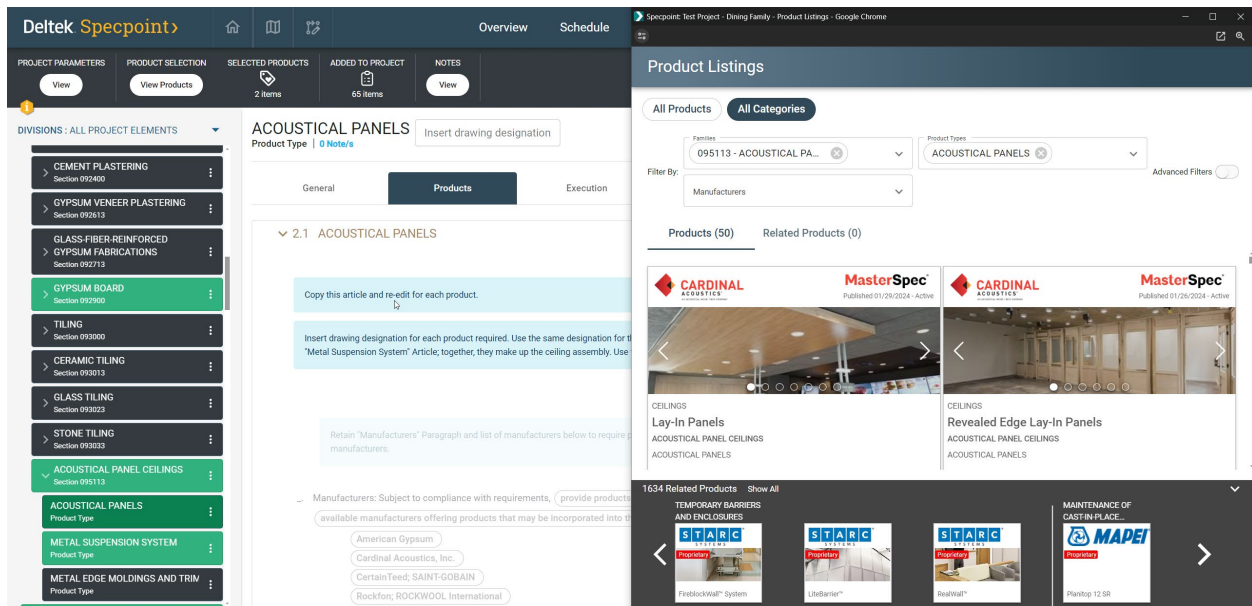

## Software Issues Resolved

### Unable to Add or Remove Product Listings

**Bug 2074972:** When you opened the Product Listings window from the project workspace in Divisions view (or organization by MasterFormat®) and added a product listing to your project as a BOD, all options on all product listing cards in the Product Listings window became unavailable. You were unable to add other product listings or remove added product listings from the project.



As a workaround, you needed to close the Product Listings window and refresh the project workspace, or you needed to work in Assembly view.

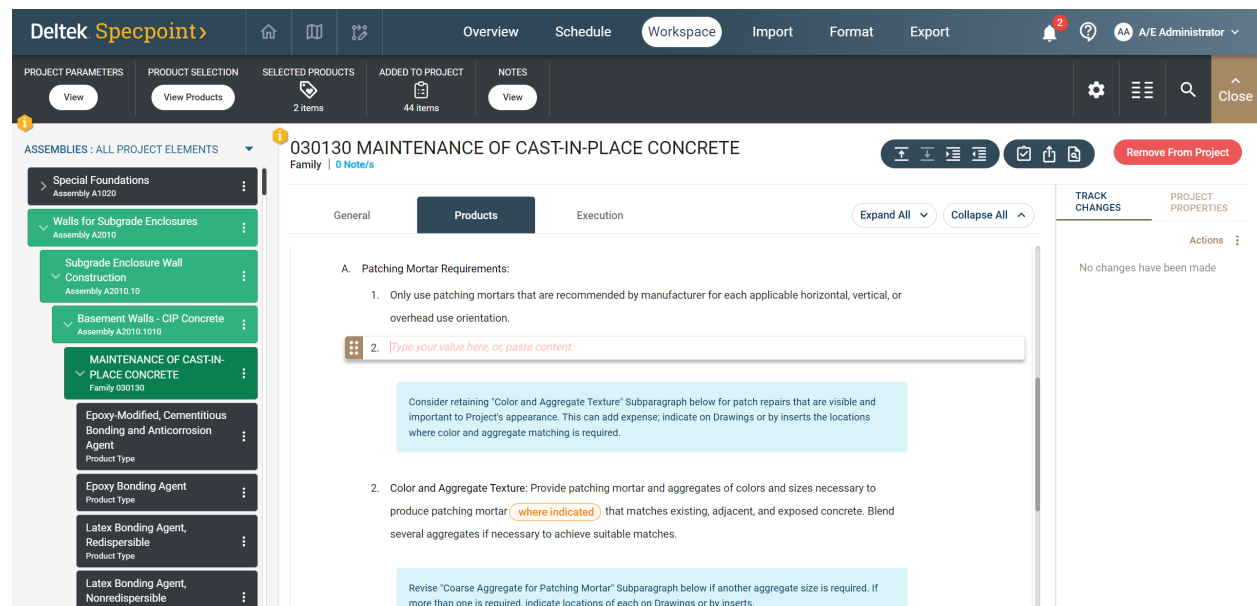

The element form of the project workspace includes new and revised options for working with your projects' families, product types, articles, and paragraphs. Use these new options to have a more intuitive and efficient workflow for building out your project specifications.



On the header of the element form, the following options are available:

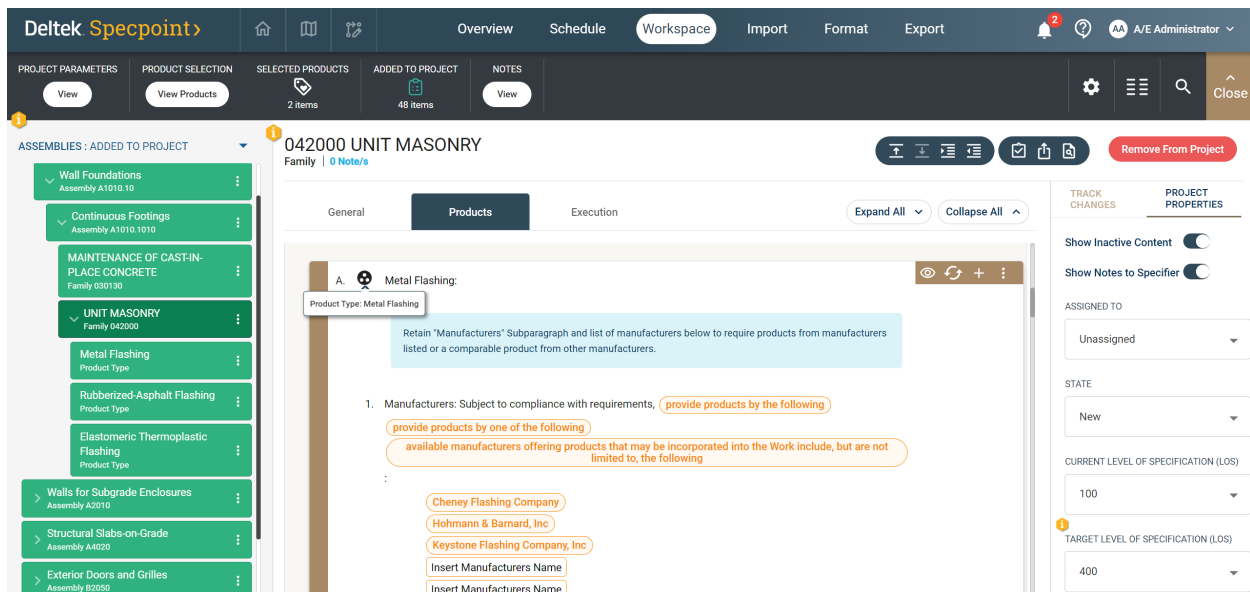

 <b>Supporting Documents</b>	Open the available supporting documents for the family, section, or product type to view relevant guidance, research, and coordination checklists.	CTRL+I

 <b>Preview</b>	Open the Section Preview window and view how the family's, section's, or product type's specified articles and paragraphs display in a traditional section view or in a project output.	CTRL+ALT+I
 <b>Copy Product Type</b>	Create a copy of a product type to define a custom product type.	CTRL+ALT+C

## Product Types at the Family/Section Level

In the project workspace, you can now view product type content as components of a family. This enables you to work on product types in context at the family level, make project decisions based on related components, and view information in a more familiar format. This view is in addition to the existing workflow of individually working on product types.



On the element form, a product type paragraph, which represents a product type component, displays with the following icon: .

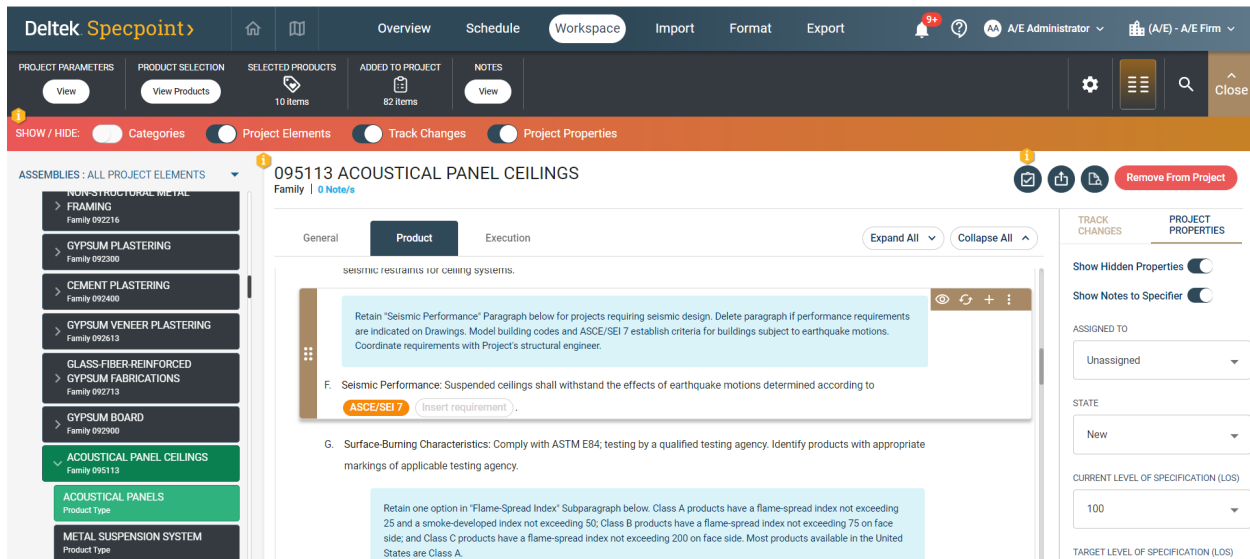


## Project Workspace Persistence

The project workspace and the Project Elements pane now retain your opened element when you perform any of the following:

- Refresh the page.
- Leave and return to the project workspace.
- Close your browser and return to the project workspace in another session.

This enhancement preserves your workflow against interruptions, such as other tasks, accidental clicks, connection timeouts, and session breaks. Use this enhancement to quickly resume work on a project element without needing to search for the element in the Project Elements pane.



The retention applies to both added and unadded project elements in Assemblies view (or organization by UniFormat®).

## Import Indicators

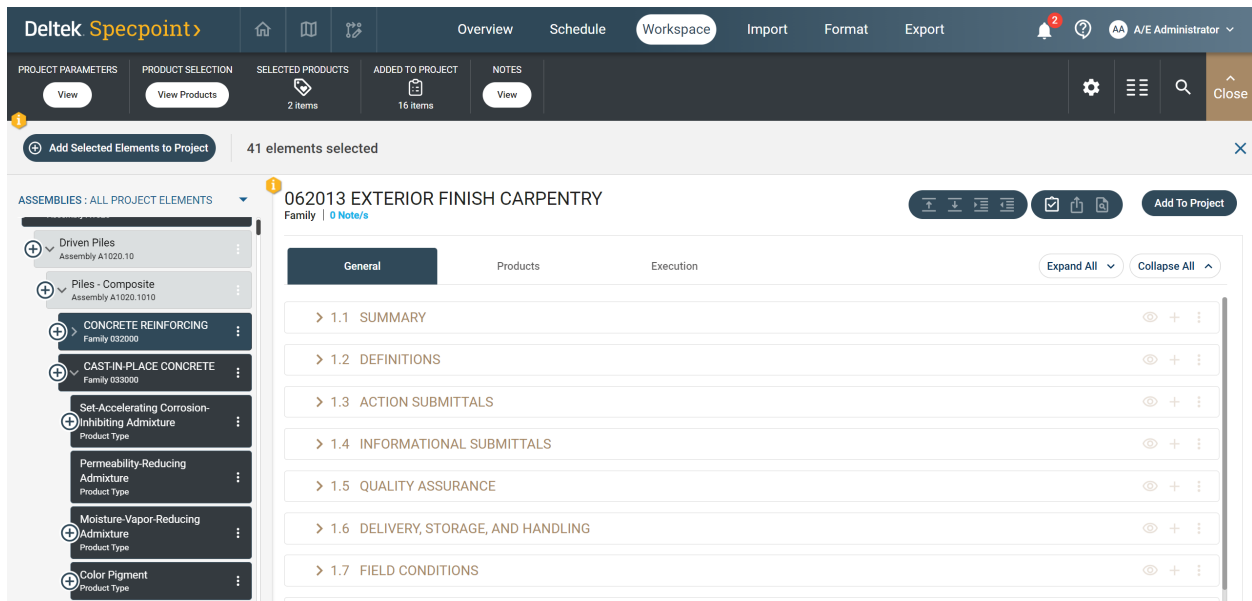
The Project Elements pane of the project workspace now includes indicators for elements that are based on imported versions. The following indicators are available:

Import Type	Indicator	Example
Project-Level Import	PI	
Office Master Import	OM	

Use this feature to identify the source of families/sections in your projects. This feature enables you to know if a family is based on Specpoint's baseline content, on a project-specific document, or on your firm's best practices.

## Quick Add Performance

The quick add feature in the Project Elements pane of the project workspace now has improved performance for loading and adding elements into your project. You will realize shorter loading times, especially in adding significantly many elements in Divisions/MasterFormat view. This enhancement improves the speed of your workflow and prevents it from being disrupted by connection timeouts.



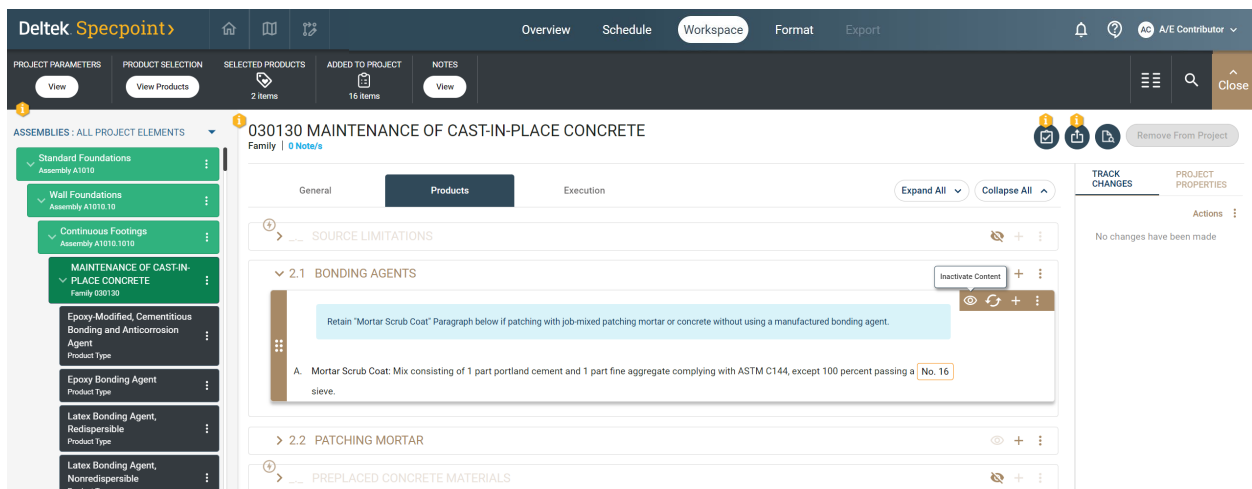
In addition, when you select a family for quick add, Specpoint expands the family so that you can view its product types. This enables you to efficiently select product types for your selected families.



## Contributor Permission

This section includes the descriptions of enhancements for users with the contributor permission.


### Content Activation by Contributors

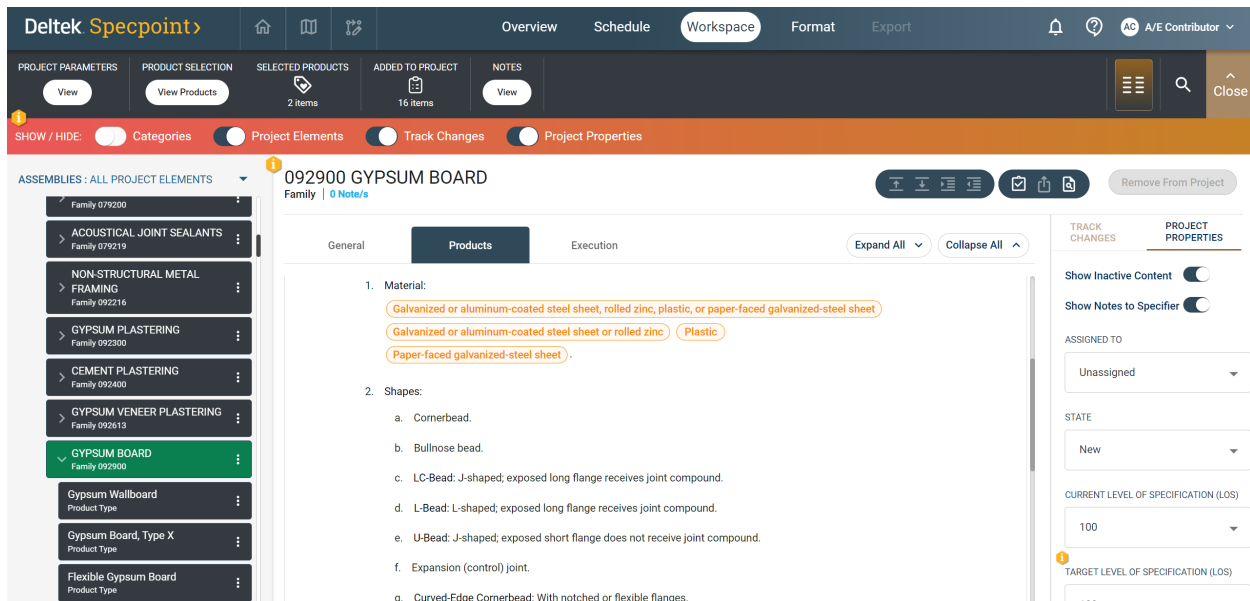
As a contributor, you can now activate and inactivate articles and paragraphs in the added families and product types of your projects.



In the project workspace, the  (activate) and  (inactivate) options in paragraphs and articles are available to contributors. This enables contributors to include and exclude drafted project content for review purposes.

## Export Restrictions for Contributors

As a contributor, you can no longer export single sections or entire project manuals. In the project workspace, the  (export) button for a given family or product type is now unavailable to contributors. The **Export** option on the project dashboard menu is also unavailable.



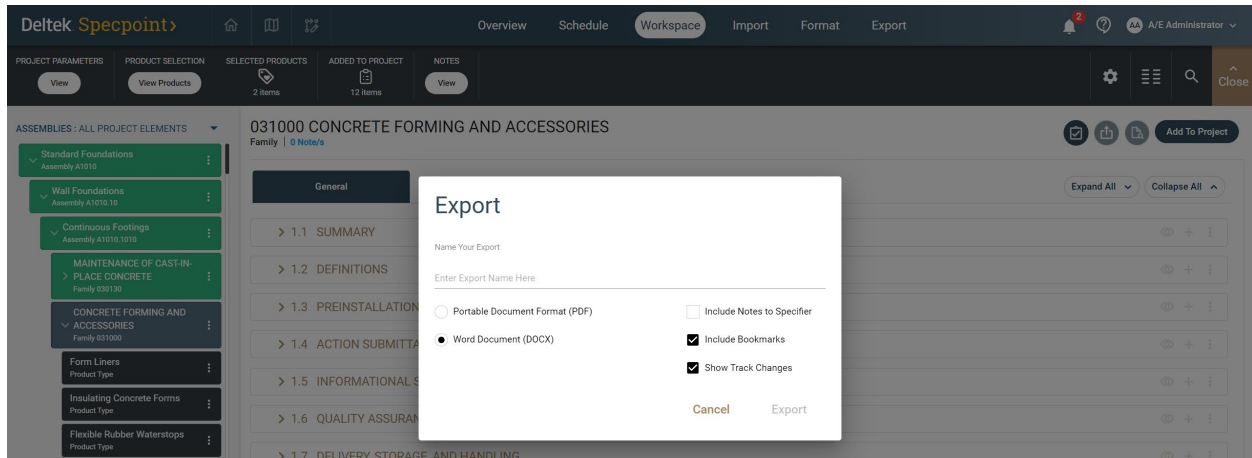
This enhancement prevents contributors and reviewers from exporting project content that is not ready for issuance and submission.

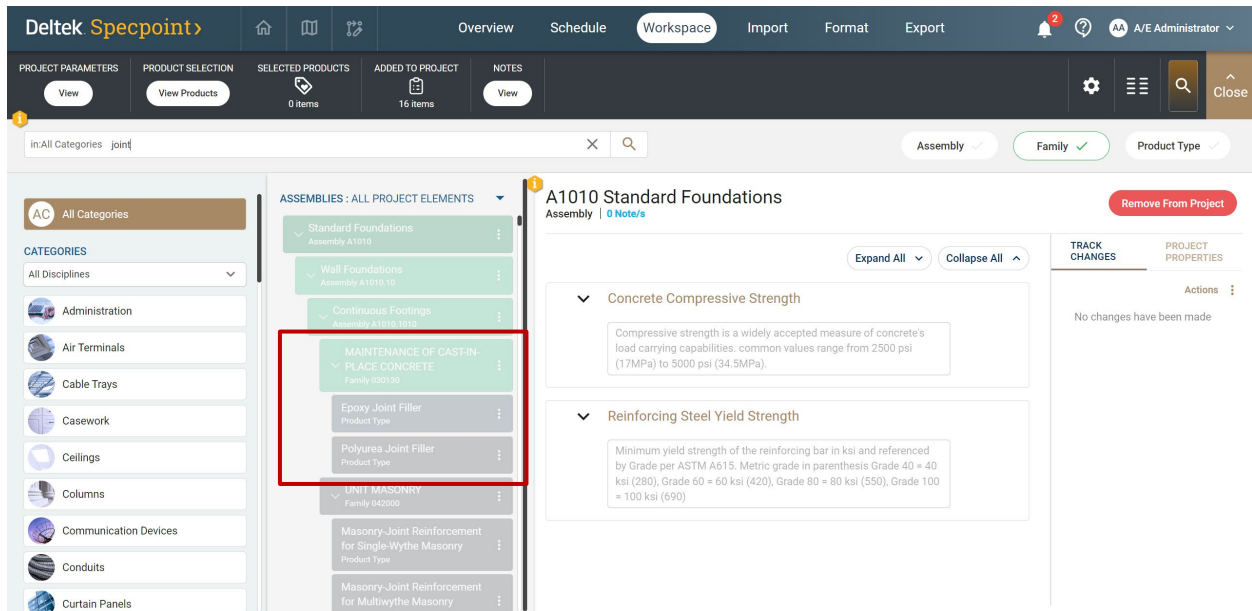
### Removed Families in Exported Project Files

**Bug 2067487:** When you removed an added family from your project and exported a project manual, the exported project files included the removed family. The table of contents also included the removed family.



## Incorrect Search Results

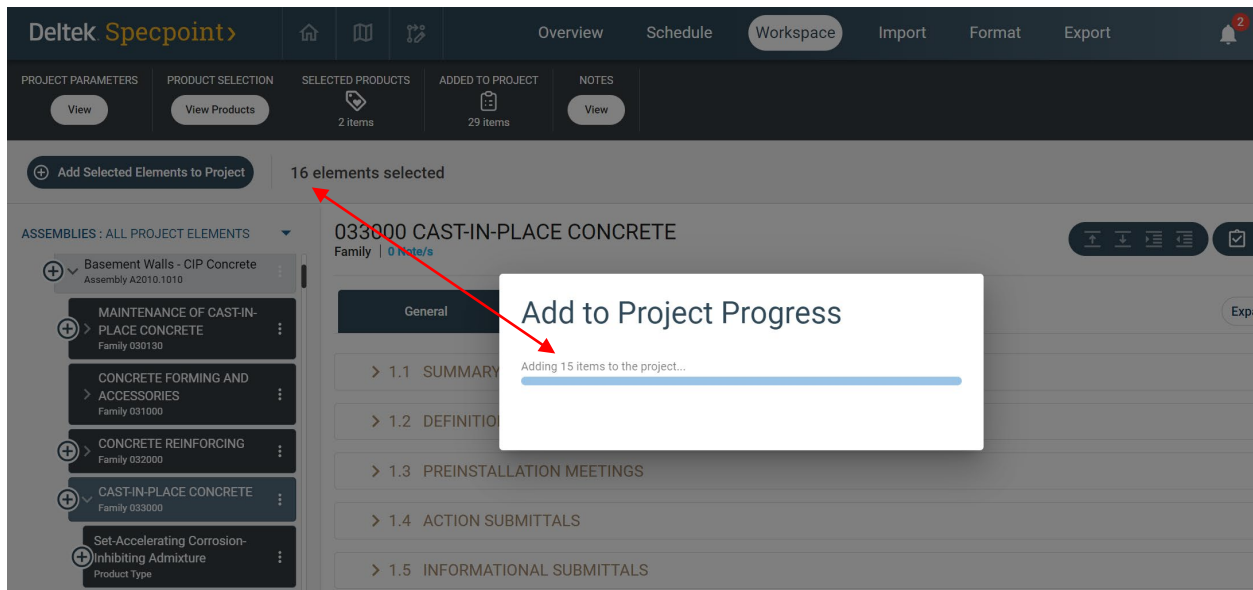
**Bug 2067217:** When you searched with both a search term and an element type filter, the Project Elements pane of the project workspace returned incorrect search results. The search results included project elements that matched the search term but was outside the selected element types.



For example, you searched for the term “joint” and filtered the search by the **Family** element type, the results included product type elements that matched the term “joint”.



## Incorrect Quick Add Count

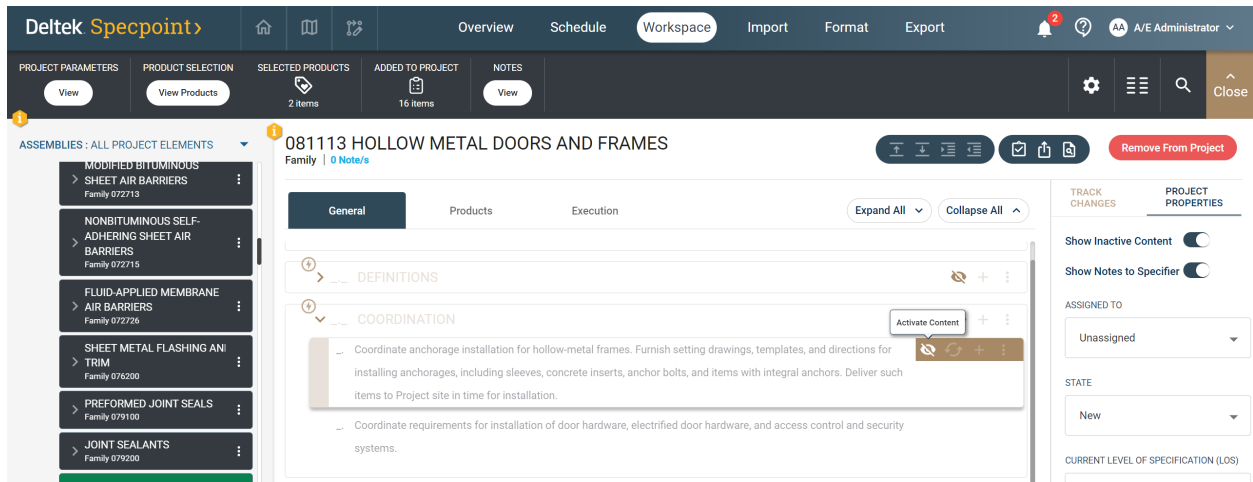
**Bug 2073051:** When you added project elements through quick add, the count for the added elements in the progress bar did not match the count on the toolbar.



## Unexpected LOS Automation

**Bug 2066487:** LOS-associated articles and paragraphs unexpectedly activated or inactivated when you performed the following steps:

1. You activated an inactive LOS-associated article (marked by ) or its inactive child paragraph by clicking the  (activate) button.
2. In the **Level of Specification** field in the Edit Project Details pane of the Project Overview page, you adjusted the baseline LOS of your project to a level that displays the LOS-associated article that you activated.

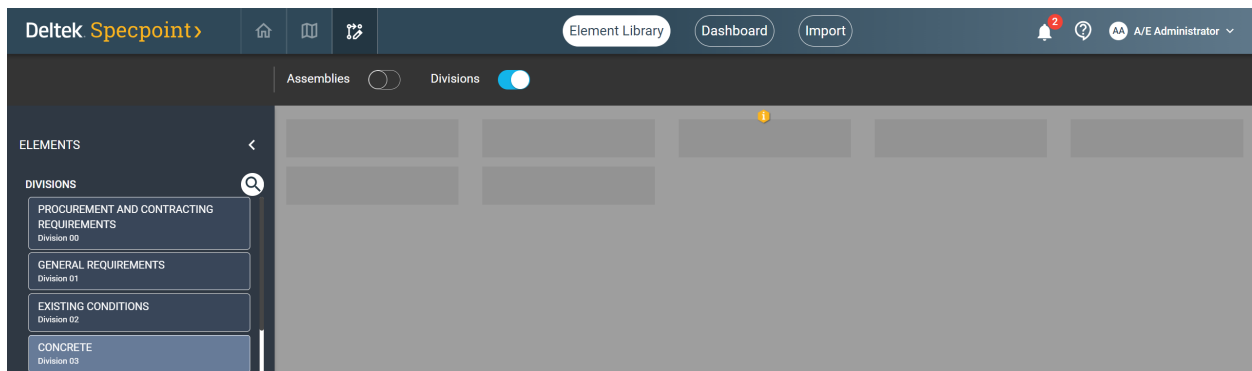

## Loading the Element Library

**Bug 2072831:** The element library loaded indefinitely when you performed the following steps:

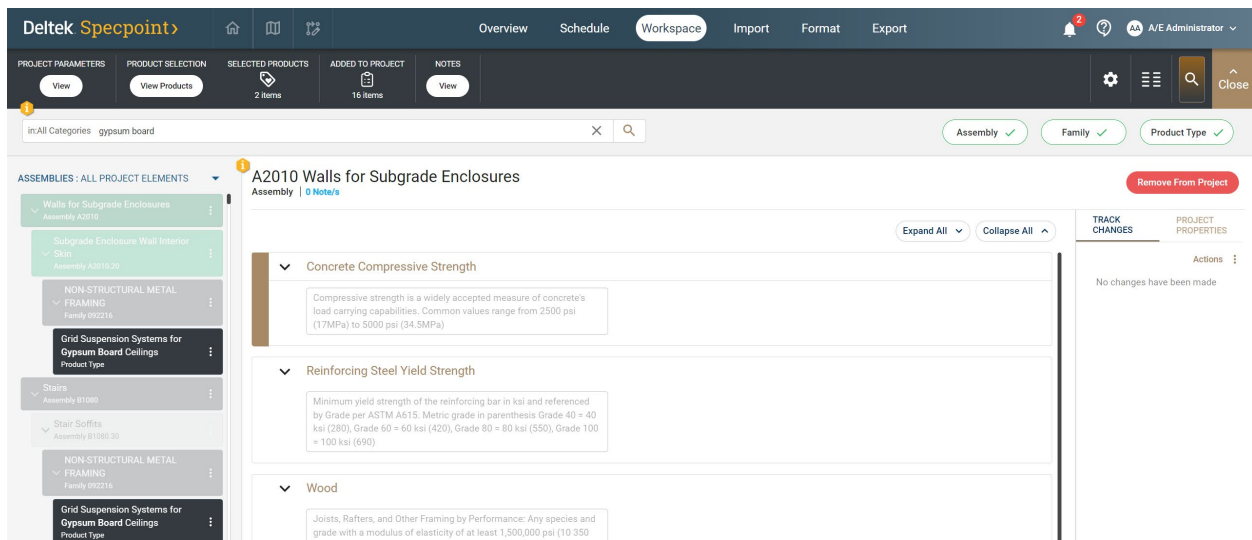
1. In the Divisions view (or organization by MasterFormat®) of the element library, you created a work item from a section under your selected division. In the Edit Option pane, you clicked **Create Work Item**.
2. You navigated away from and returned to the element library.

You were unable to use the element library in Divisions view. As a workaround, you needed to use Assemblies view.



## Searching for Families Based on Office Masters

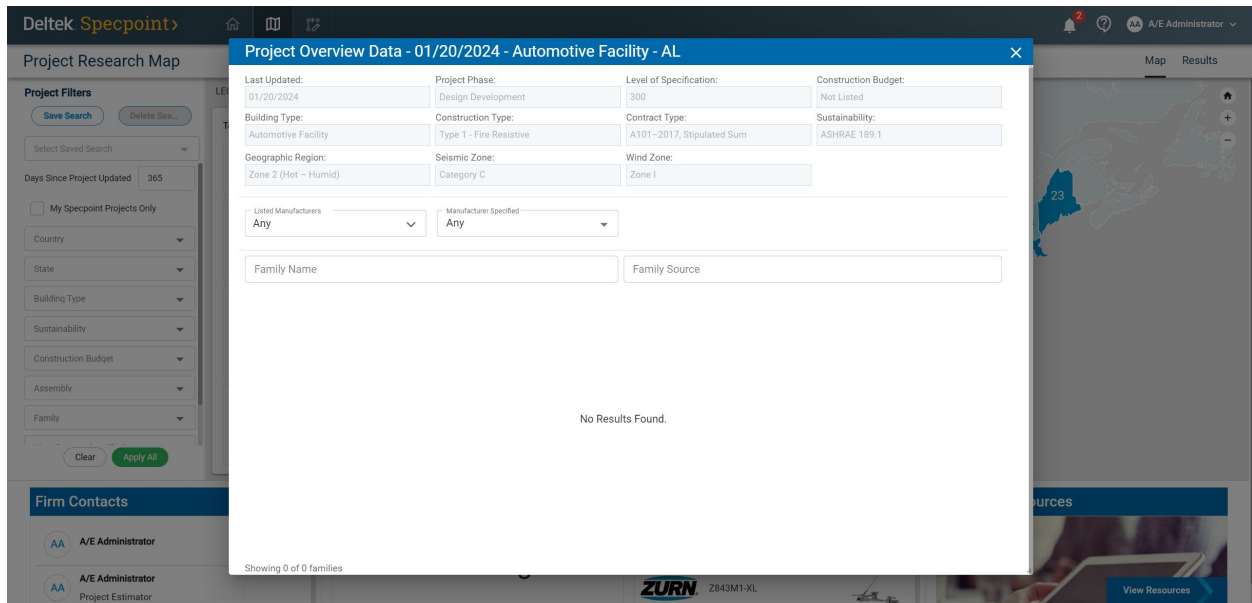
**Bug 2067156:** When you searched for a family that is based on a published office master, the Project Elements pane of the project workspace did not include the family under its parent assembly in the search results.



As a workaround, you needed to manually locate the family under its parent assemblies in the Project Elements pane.

## Missing Office Master Families from the Project Research Map

**Bug 1999773:** The Project Overview Data window of the Project Research Map did not display any added families for projects that included an added family that is based on a published office master family.

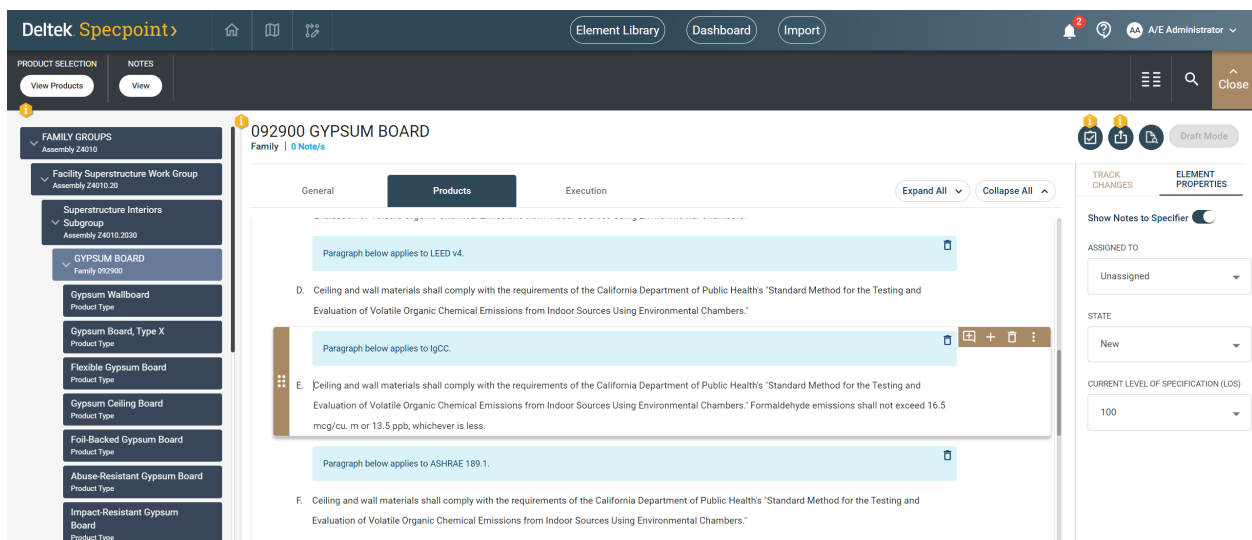


## Office Master Workspace

### Navigating through Paragraphs in the Office Master Workspace

**Bug 2059263:** When you navigated through paragraphs on the element form of the office master workspace by clicking UP and DOWN, your cursor became invisible. You were unable to see your cursor and identify the paragraph, or paragraph line, that you currently have selected.

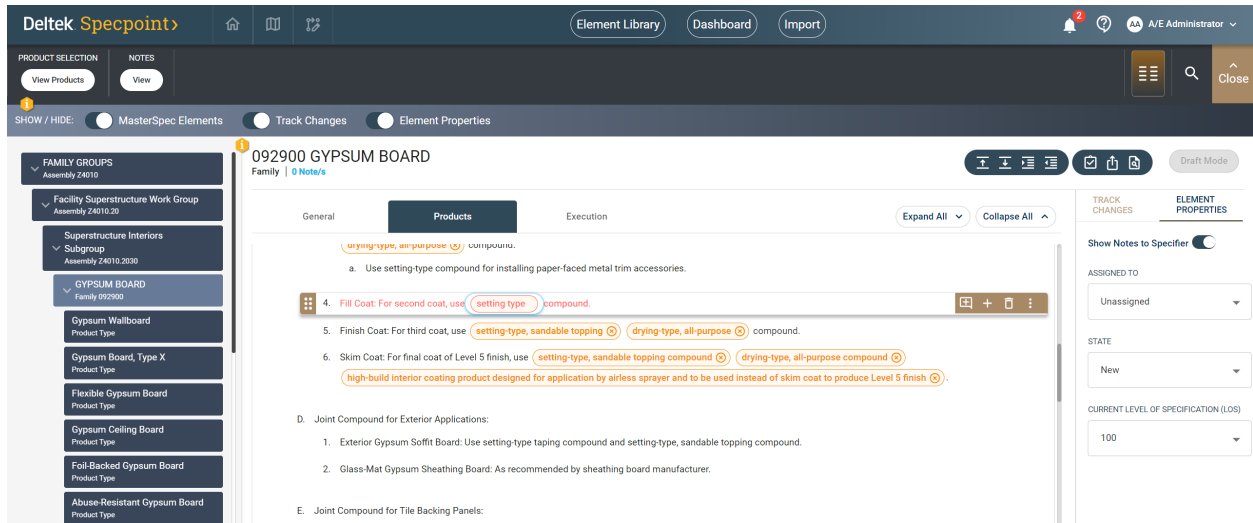




## Paragraph Retention after Adding an Option/Pill

**Bug 2070915:** When you added an option set item in between paragraph text without spaces and saved the paragraph, the office master workspace did not retain the paragraph. For example:

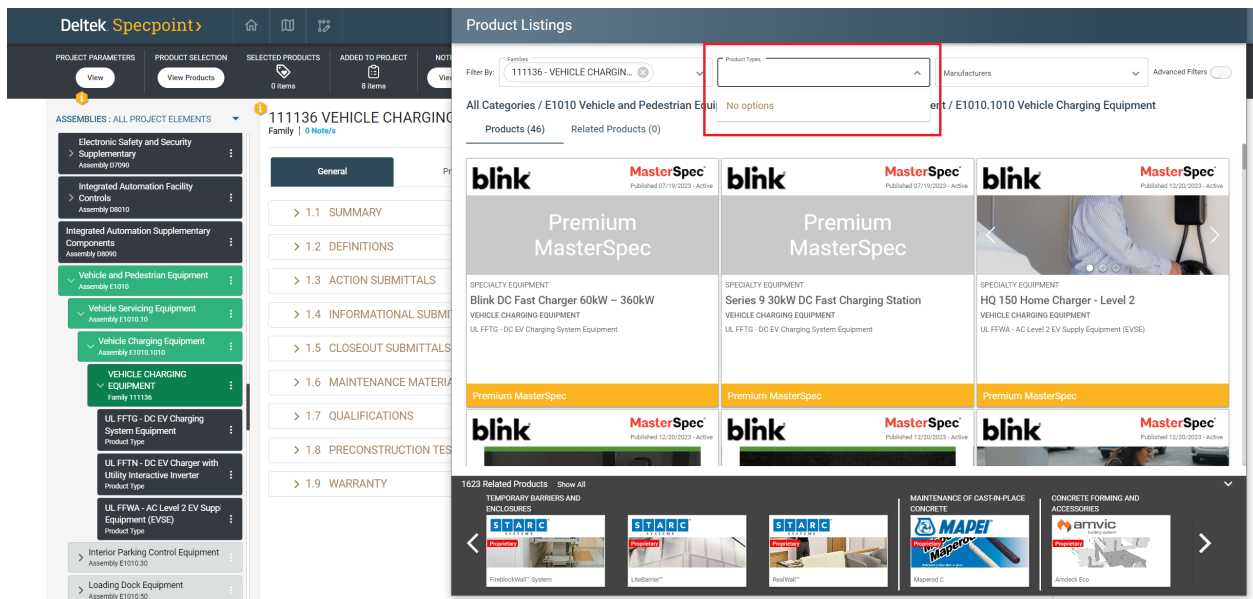
Fill Coat: For second coat, use **(option 1)** compound.



This applied to options/pills, insert options, and unit of measure (UOM) fields.

## No Options for Product Type Filter

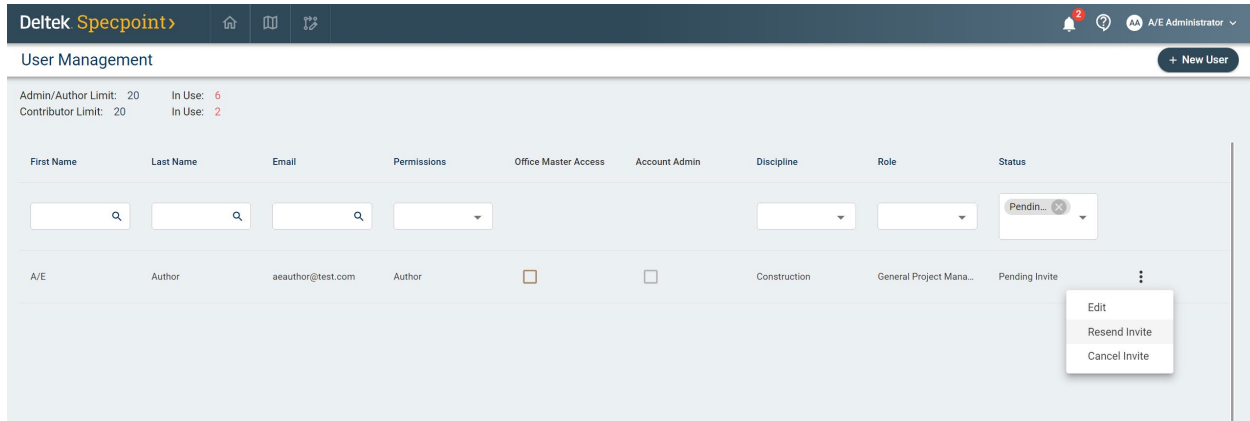
**Bug 2056608:** In the Product Listings window for your active project, the **Product Type** filter did not load the available product types. This issue applied only to the **111136 Vehicle Charging Equipment** family. When you attempted to select options from this filter, no options were available.





## User Invite Resending and Cancellation

**Bug 2067482:** As an administrator, when you resent a user invitation or cancelled a pending invitation, the User Management page displayed an error message. The platform was unable to process either action.

#### Office Master Content Customization

You can now work on your imported office masters natively in Specpoint. An office master is a custom specification which contains guidelines or standards that are recognized as effective ways to prepare and present project requirements and convey a clear understanding to all stakeholders. Office masters enable a firm to preserve its knowledge and use the firm's best practices to enable success in future projects. Typically, a custom office master builds upon industry guide specifications, such as MasterSpec, and integrates custom families, properties, and requirements.

Prior to this release, you were only able to import office master families. You no longer need to edit the external files of your office masters and re-import them into Specpoint to update your office masters. Specpoint's office master workspace enables you to update the baseline or default starting content of your A/E firm's projects. You can work on office master content similarly to how you work on project element contents. This includes existing collaboration tools, such as notes and track changes, as well as additional features for establishing firm-wide standards.

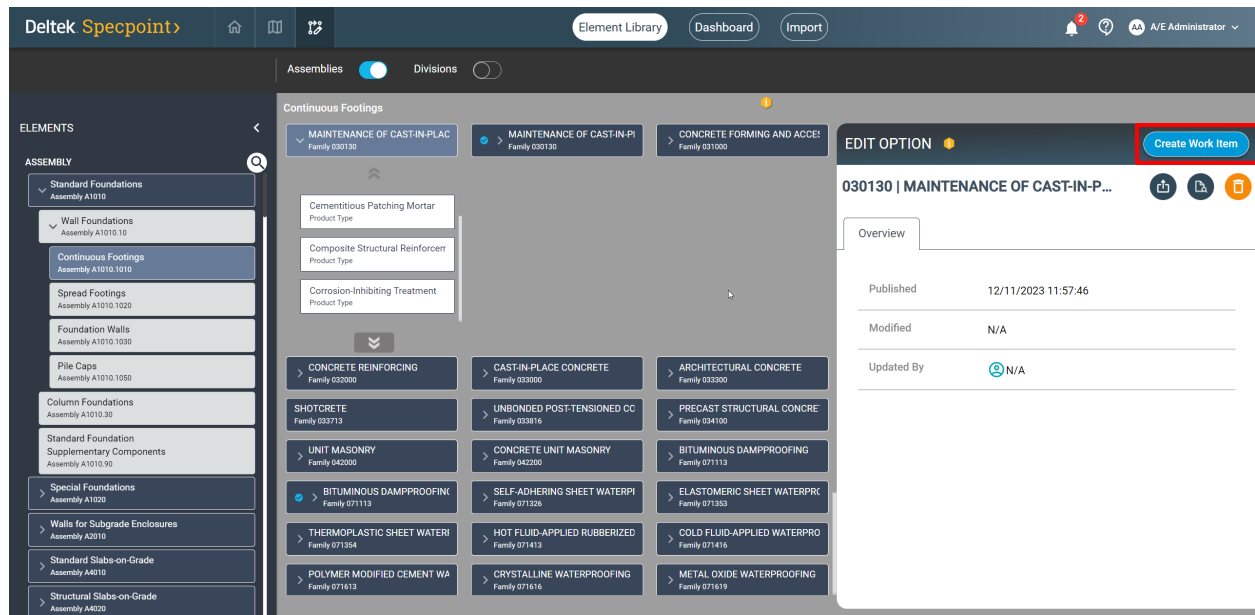
Use the new available features to perform the following general steps of the office master content customization workflow:

1. In the [element library](#), create a work item for your office master family.
2. In the office master workspace, modify the content items and properties of your office master family.
3. On the [office master dashboard](#), publish the office master family.

#### Work Item Creation

You can now create work items for your firm's imported and published office masters. For a selected office master family in the element library, the **Create Work Item** button is now available in the Edit Option pane. Click this button to create a work item on the office master dashboard for the given office master family.





A work item functions as a draft version of a published office master family. An office master family can have only one work item at a given time. On the office master dashboard, you can click a work item to open and work on its office master family in the office master workspace.

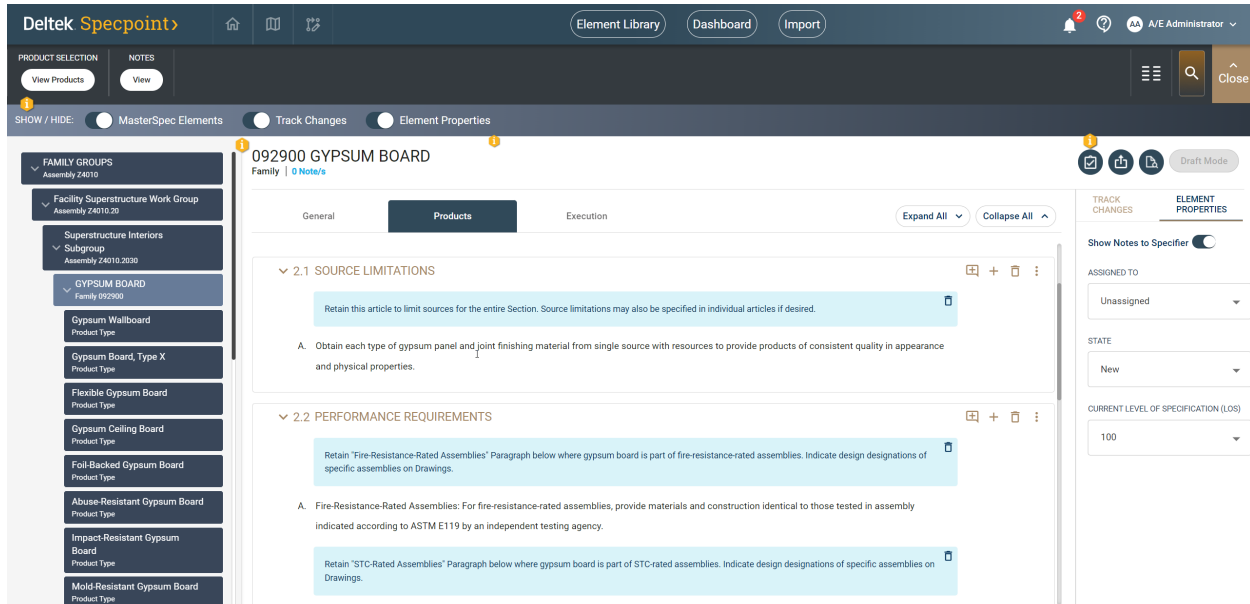

- View related elements.
- Modify the family's product types.
- Work on its content items, which include articles, paragraphs, and notes to specifier.
- Track changes in content items.
- Manage its element properties.

- Add notes.
- View its supporting documents.
- Open the family in the section preview.
- Export the family.

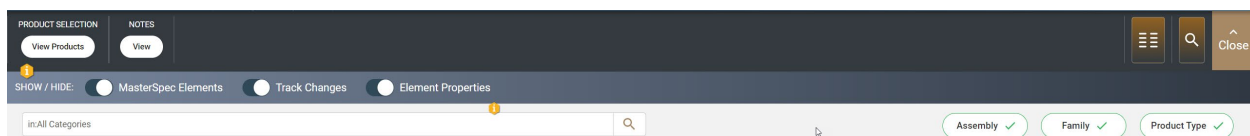


The office master workspace functions similarly to the project workspace. However, the office master workspace enables you to work on baseline or office master content instead of project content. Use this workspace to customize the baseline or default starting content for all your firm's projects and establish firm-wide standards. As a member of the [office master access group](#), you can open the office master workspace for your office master families with active work items from the office master dashboard.



The office master workspace organizes its features into the following main parts:

## Office Master Workspace Action Bar

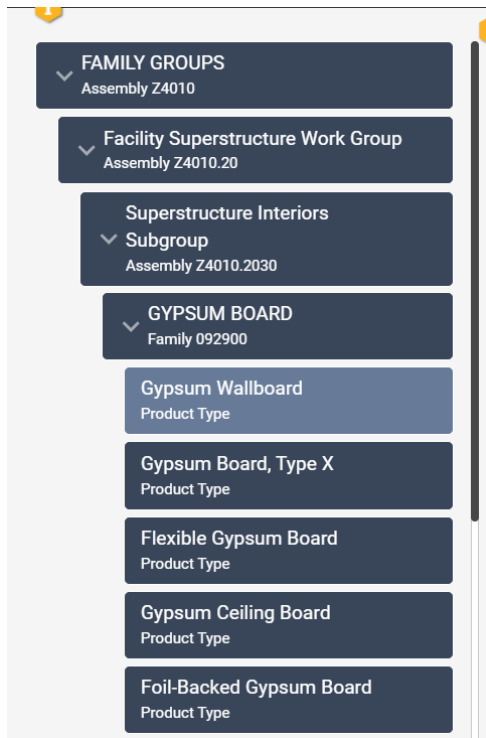

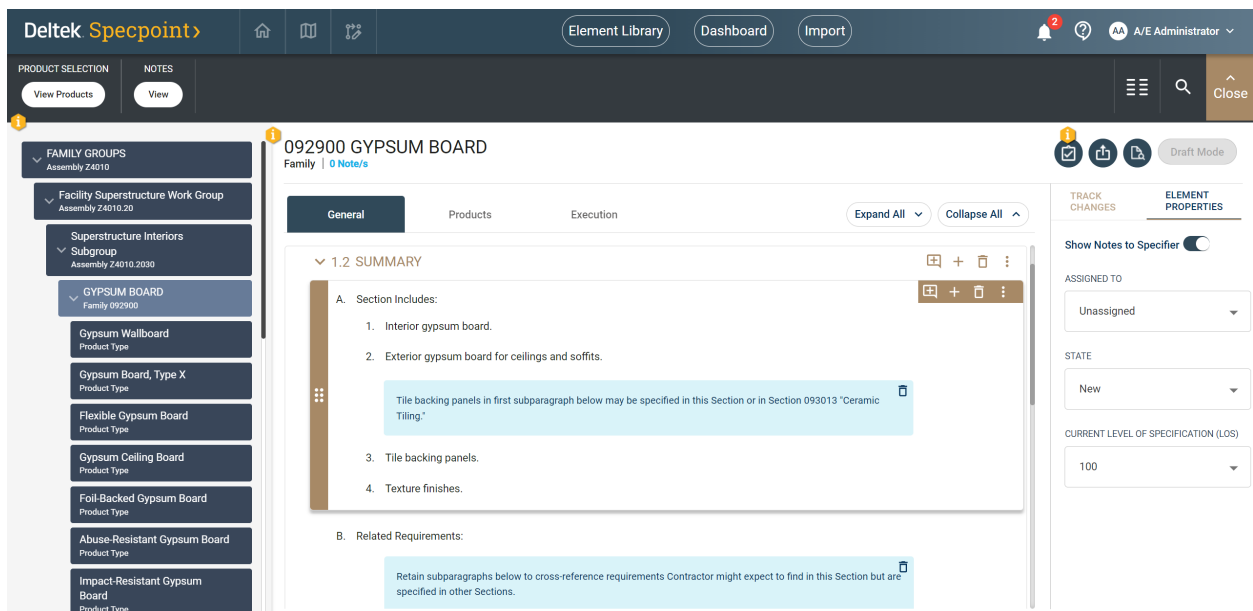

In the project workspace, they can modify paragraphs and articles to create properties and build out project requirements based on Specpoint's baseline content or based on your firm's office masters. When you use office master families, you override Specpoint's baseline content with your firm's office masters. All instances of families in your firm's projects that have active corresponding office master families will be based on their respective office master families.

### Parts/Element Tabs



On the first outline level, use element tabs or parts to organize the contents of an office master family or product type based on each content item's functional nature. The following parts are available:

Click on each element tab to view and begin working on its articles and paragraphs.

### Articles

For a given office master family or product type, use articles to group paragraphs and property sets under a part in the office master element. An article is a heading in a single line or a title that describes its paragraphs.

When you modify an article in a given office master family, you modify the baseline or default starting content of all your A/E firm's projects. The respective article in the family on the project level reflects your modification. This feature enables you to set firm-wide best practices and preserve knowledge on the article level.

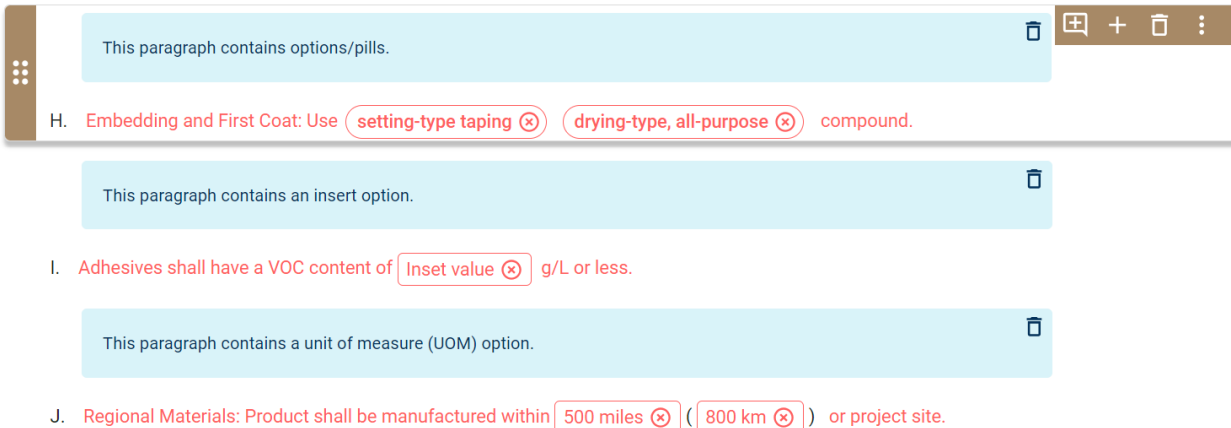

## Option Sets

Use an option set to provide your firm's design professionals with options within a paragraph. Typically, baseline paragraphs include option sets to provide authors with guided property selection. Examples of these property selections are measurements, materials, and inclusions.

As a member of the office master access group, you can configure options sets within paragraphs in your office master families. This enables design professionals to specify properties according to their project requirements and within your firm-wide standards and best practices.

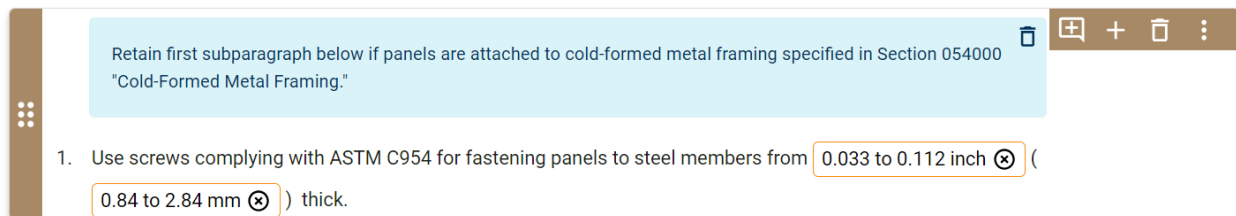

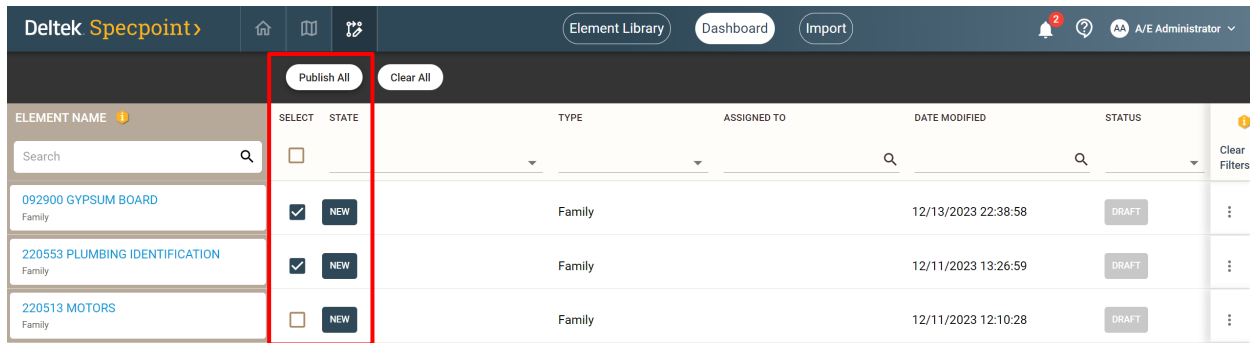

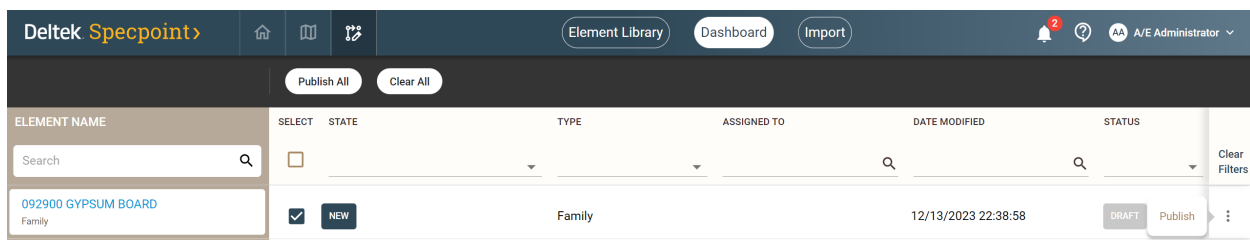
## Publishing Office Master Families

On the office master dashboard, you can publish an office master family with a work item after you complete making changes to the family in the office master workspace. Publishing an office master family saves it as baseline content. All instances of the family, in their default state, in all your firm's projects will be based on the published office family.

To publish an office master family, select the family and click **Publish All**.



Alternatively, click **» Publish**.



## Level of Specification (LOS) Integration

The level of specification (LOS) is a schema that Specpoint conceptualized to complement level of development (LOD), track progress and prioritization, and automate project development. The LOS serves to control the included information, such as articles, properties, and paragraphs, within a project's elements based on the project's design phase and other factors determined by your firm's design professionals.

200	<p>LOS 200 Assembly Description and Performance: This level adds non-graphic information to LOS 100 to describe the functional and performance requirements of the finished assembly, including major products. This information should further develop the ability of project team members to capture cost or schedule impacts of the assembly. Since, for the most part, assemblies are built from a number of families, these performance</p>

	requirements combine into an assembly-based document and ultimately provide the necessary details for early assembly design and pricing for long lead time elements.
300	<p>LOS 300 Product Type Specification: This level adds non-graphic information to LOS 200 material to describe the element in more detail required for administrative requirements, drawing coordination, and engineering development. At this level, product types should be complete as well as major accessories, finishes, and important testing or startup requirements. LOS 300 information is delivered as a 3-part specification. However, users can also edit this portion to create a best practices office master by “filling in” some blanks and making choices in Specpoint.</p>
350	<p>LOS 350 Tailored Project Specification: LOS 300 is expanded, modified, and considered “complete” for a specific project.</p> <p>Traditionally, these are “ready to bid” specifications. In the current construction environment, contents for this level would more commonly be labeled as “Issued for Construction.” Along with the graphic documentation, LOS 350 non-graphic data contains all the information needed to select assemblies and products for “final” costing and procurement by the construction team. Note that in the real world, both graphic and non-graphic “issued for construction” documents are not completely finished but are complete enough to bid.</p> <p>By this point in the design process, assemblies are quite complete and seldom change. There will be a few minor details to be solidified during construction, such as final product selection, finish colors, and other decisions made in the field. These modifications are covered in change orders and/or in “As-Built” drawings, which are outside the scope of a guide specification.</p> <p>All the text in Specpoint will have been edited by the user at this level.</p>
400, 500	<p>LOS 400 and 500 contain information completely sourced from the user and not Deltek. We would be providing the platform or library system for the organization and output of this information. There is no “Summary of type of elements extant in Specpoint” for these two LOS stages.</p>

Specpoint now integrates LOS as an intelligent project parameter with your project content. You can set the LOS for your project to automatically activate or inactivate associated content.

### Project-Wide Level of Specification (LOS)

You can now set the default project-wide level of specification (LOS) during project creation to automate a baseline for your project.

In the New Project Details pane of the Projects Home page, the **Level of Specification** field is available under Initial Project Milestone. The default value of the LOS is based on your initial selection in the **Design Phase** field. You can select any value for the LOS for any given design phase. Refer to the following default values:

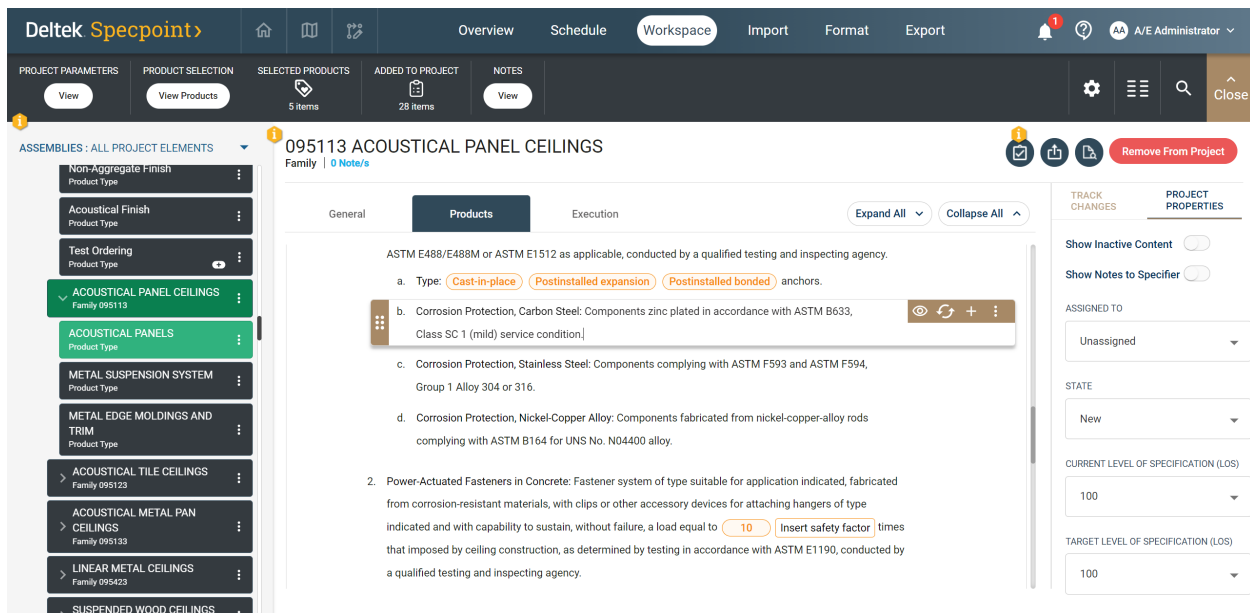
Paragraph text no longer has character limits. You can enter paragraph content of any length. For pasting text into paragraphs, the character limit is 1000.

## Paragraph Shortcuts

This section includes the descriptions of enhancements for working with paragraphs in the project workspace. These shortcuts are also available in the office master workspace.

### Shortcuts for Paragraph Navigation

On the element form of the project workspace, you can now press UP and DOWN to navigate through the available paragraphs of a given family, section, or product type. Use this feature to intuitively navigate through and work on the contents in your added product elements.



The following actions are available:

Action	Description
<b>Previous Paragraph</b>	When you place your cursor in the topmost line of a paragraph text and <b>press UP</b> , your cursor moves to the paragraph above your current paragraph, and you can immediately make changes to the paragraph text.
<b>Next Paragraph</b>	When you place your cursor in the bottommost line of a paragraph text and <b>press DOWN</b> , your cursor moves to the paragraph below your current paragraph, and you can immediately work on that paragraph.
<b>Multiple Paragraph Lines</b>	You can <b>press UP and DOWN</b> to navigate through the lines within long paragraph text that spans multiple lines.

This feature includes the promotion or demotion of the paragraph's subparagraphs. Specpoint limits the promotions and demotions to ensure adherence to the prescribed structure and hierarchy.

## Moving and Promoting Newly Added Paragraphs

In the project workspace, you can now move, promote, and demote a newly added paragraph prior to saving it for the first time. Use this enhancement to perform actions for content addition in your preferred order, such as prioritizing setting a paragraph's position and indent level.

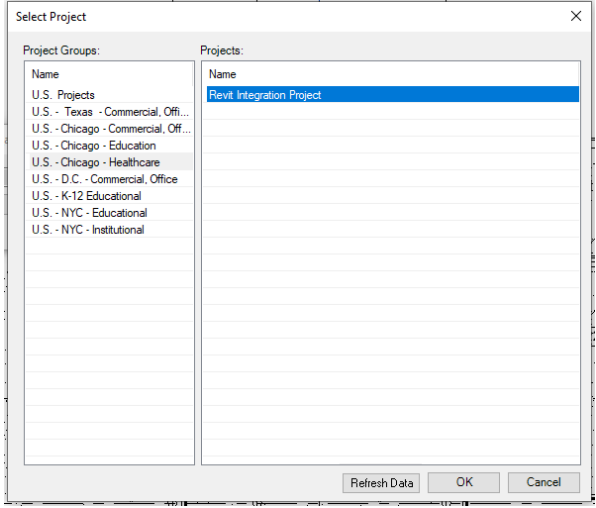

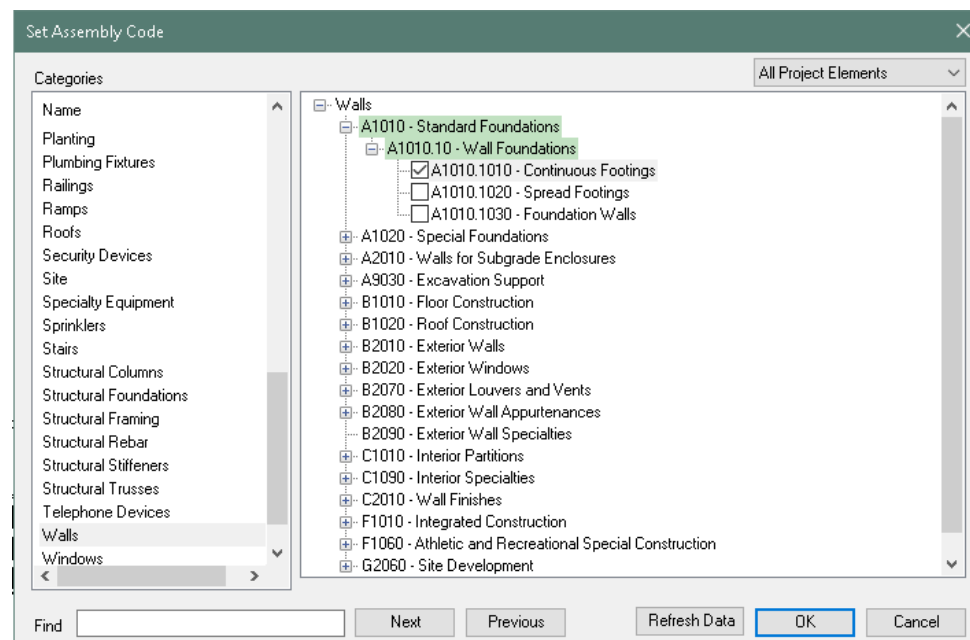

## Project Workspace

### Adding Articles

**Bug 2034045:** When you added a new article in an added family, section, or product type in your project (by clicking  in an existing article), the project workspace created a new article that had an incorrect layout. The article number and the article title were in separate lines.



### Character Limit for First Paragraphs

**Bug 2015738:** The first paragraph of each article had a 500-character limit. When you tried to enter or paste paragraph content that exceeded 500 characters, the paragraph cut off the content that exceeded the incorrect limit.

## Insert Options Not Retaining Values

**Bug 2050336:** When you entered a value in an insert option (**[Insert]**) of a paragraph, the insert option did not retain your entered value. When you refreshed the project workspace or navigated away from and returned to the project workspace, the insert option reverted to its default value and converted to an option or a pill in an option set.

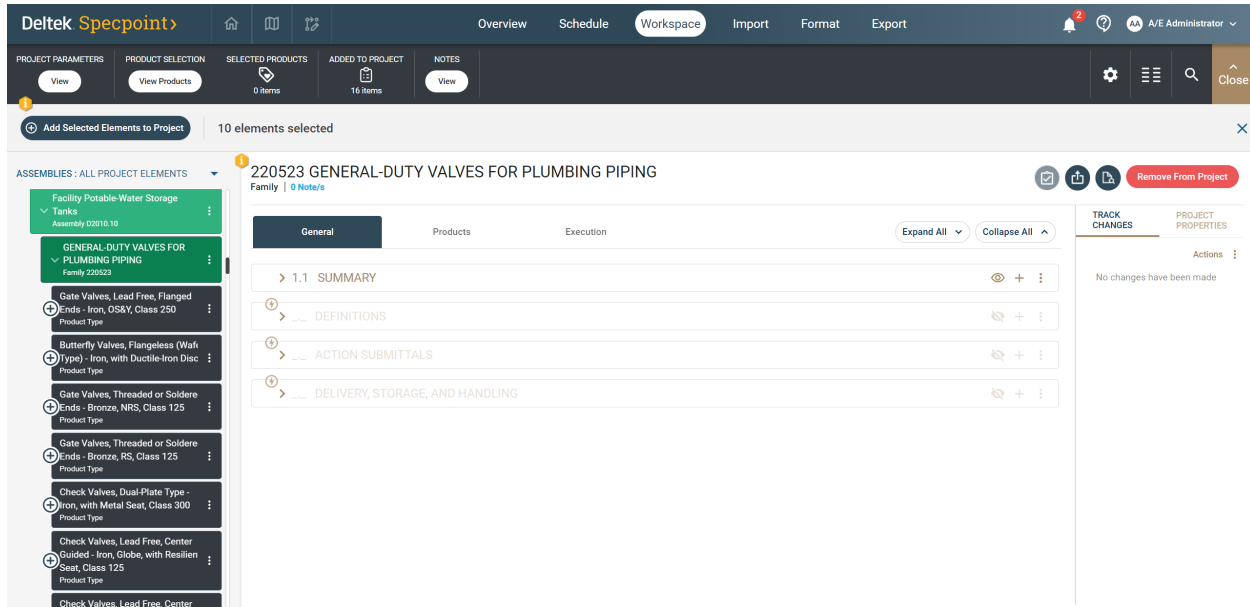
This issue applied to paragraphs in select families, such as **096813 Tile Carpeting** and **096816 Sheet Carpeting**.

## Crashing after Multiple Quick Add Selections

**Bug 2052203:** When you selected multiple specific families and/or product types for quick add, the project workspace crashed.



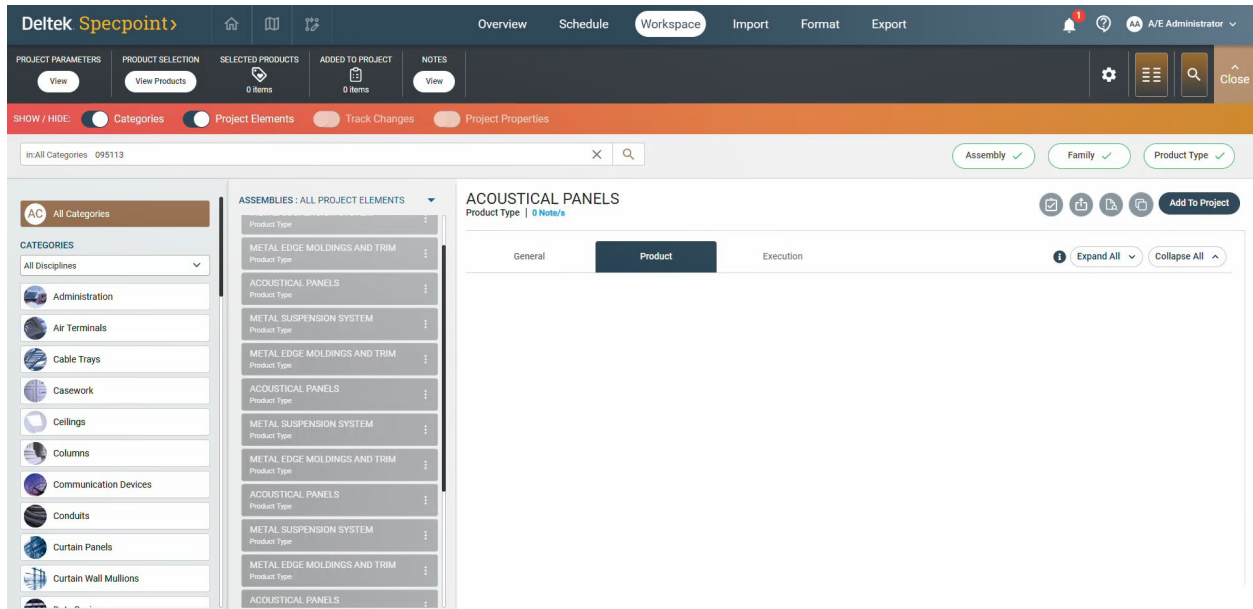
This issue applied to specific elements, such as the first 10 product types under the **220523 General-Duty Valves for Plumbing and Piping** family.

## Imported Families or Sections

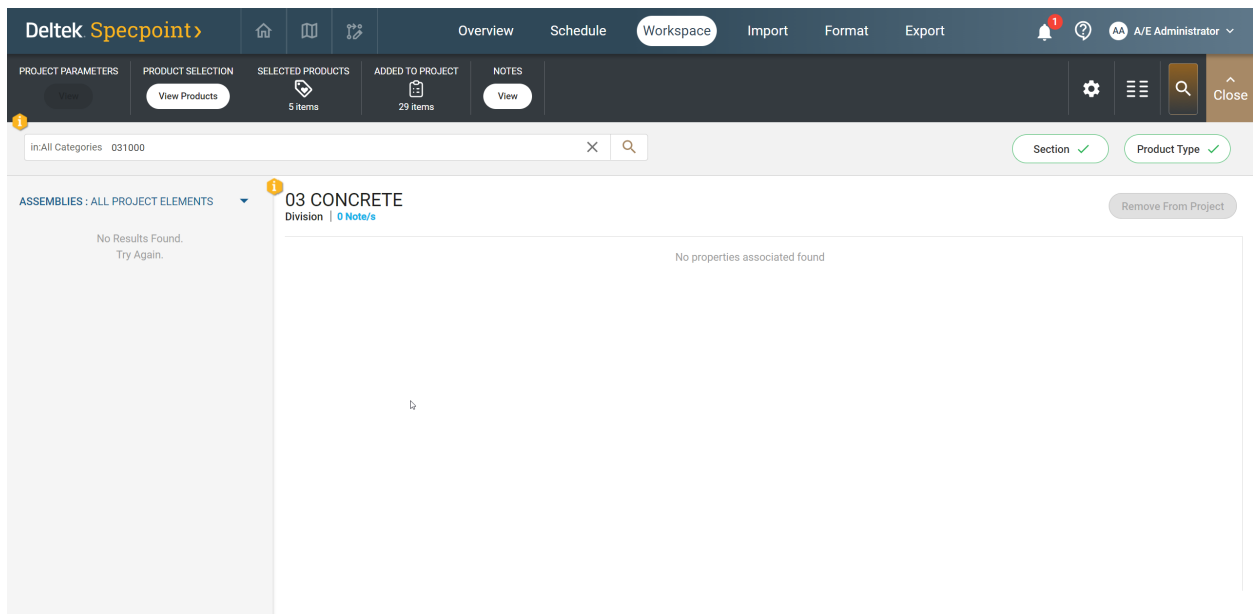
### Missing Parents of Imported Families

**Bug 2013170:** When you deleted an imported family that you added to your project and searched for the family (which reverted to its MasterSpec version) or its parent assemblies, the Project Elements pane of the project workspace did not display the family or its parent assemblies in the search results. In addition, the element form failed to load succeeding content. On the project level, you can delete an imported family on the Import page.



## Searching for Imported Families


**Bug 2037351:** When you imported a family on the project level that replaced a family that was an existing office master version and then searched for that family in the project workspace, the Project Elements pane of the project workspace did not return any search results.

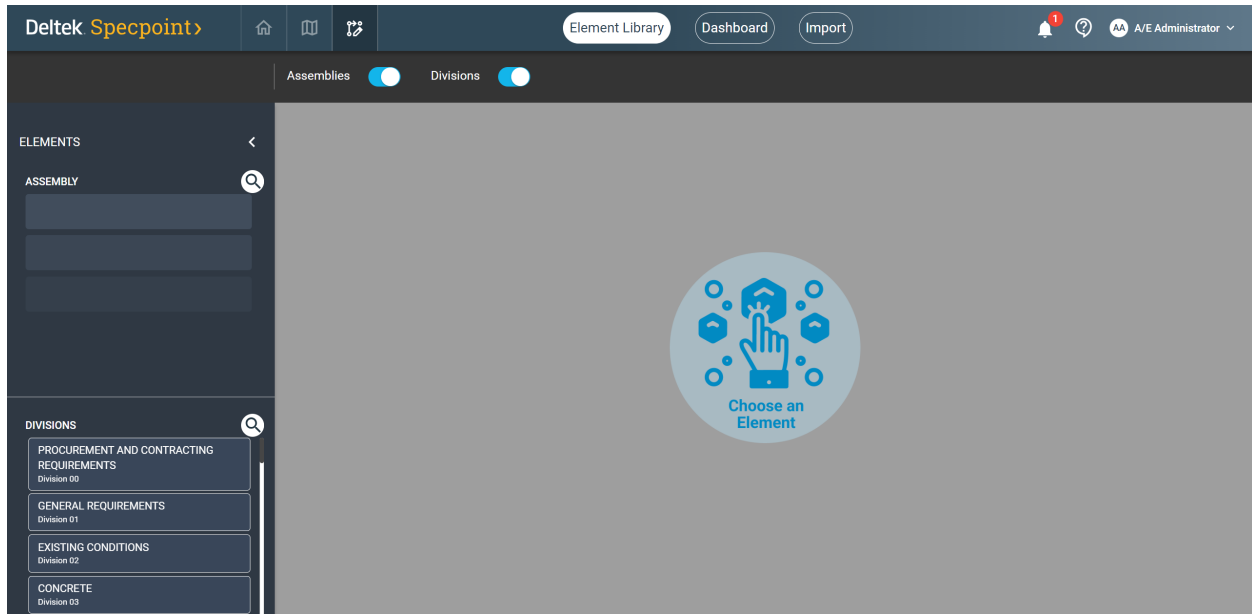

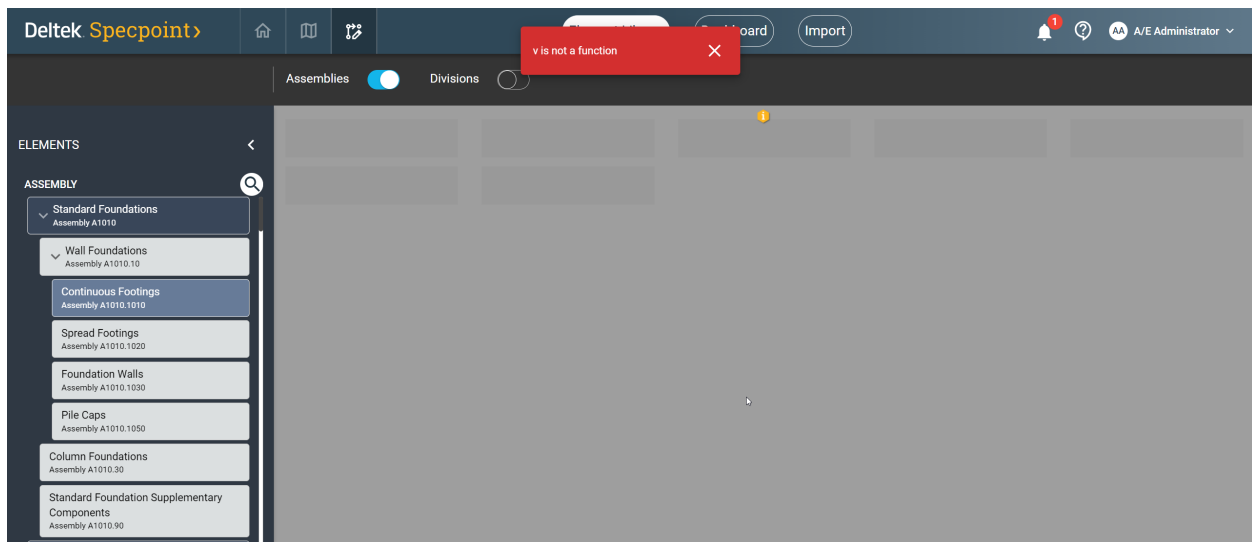
## Loading Assemblies in the Office Master Element Library

**Bug 2000757:** When you opened the office master element library and immediately displayed the Divisions view in the Elements pane (by selecting the **Divisions**  option), the Assembly view in the Elements pane indefinitely remained in loading animation. You were unable to view assemblies and work in UniFormat®.



## Deleting an Office Master Family from the Element Library

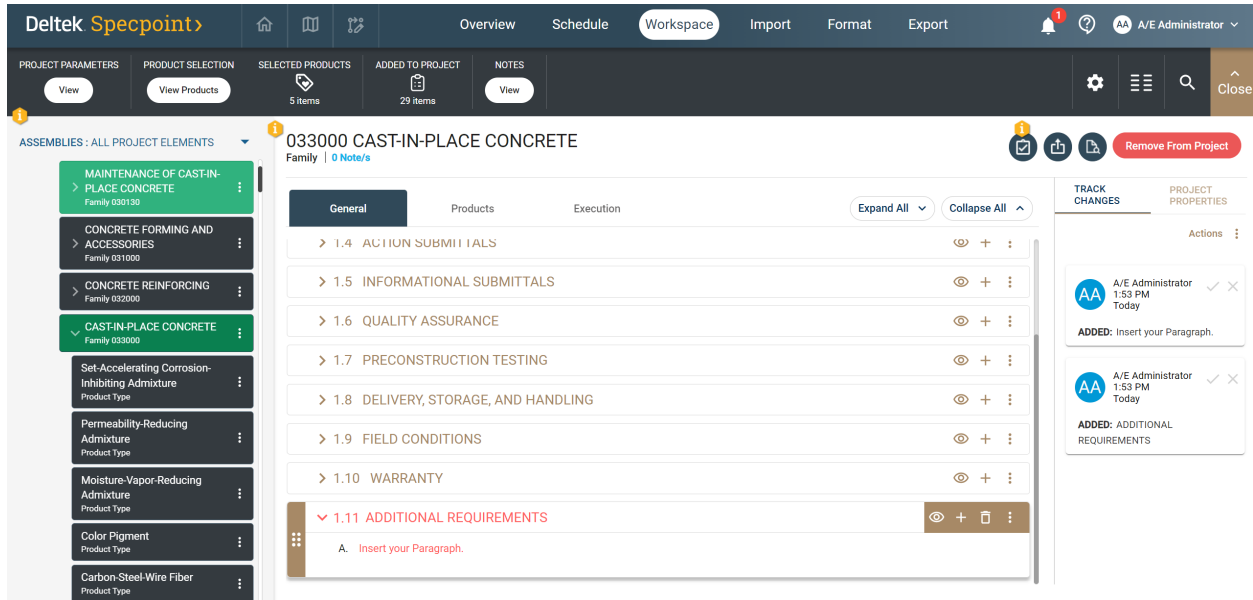
**Bug 2037601:** When you deleted a published office master family from the office master element library, the element library displayed an unexpected error message.





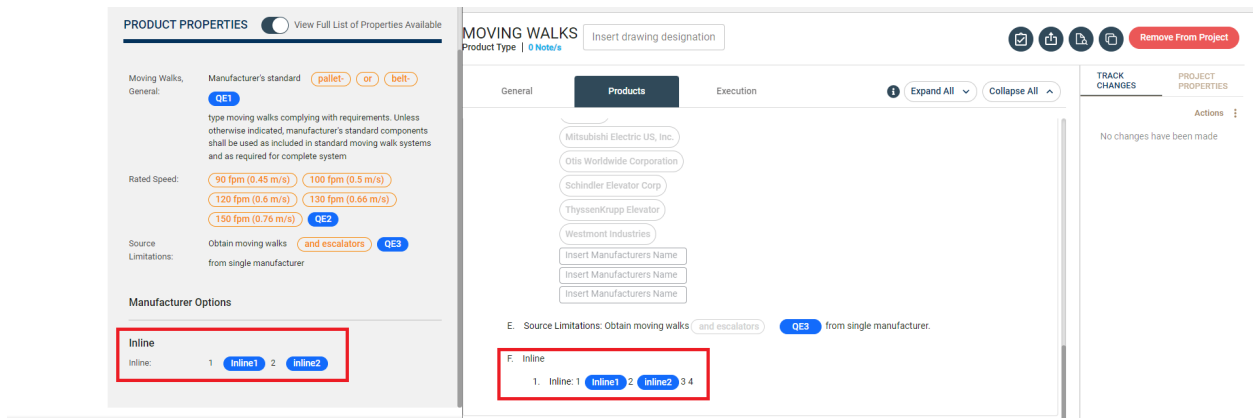
## Adding Articles in Added Office Master Families

**Bug 2013757:** When you added a family that is an office master version to your project and then added an article in the added family, the project workspace did not save the added article.



## In-Line Text for Manufacturer Properties

**Bug 2026966:** The in-line text for some manufacturer properties, which is a product property that consists of only manufacturer options, of affected product listings were inconsistent with their respective manufacturer property paragraphs.




The Product Properties tab of the Product Listings window displayed incomplete in-line text for manufacturer properties. When you added a product listing with a manufacturer property into your project, the project workspace automatically added manufacturer property paragraphs that included the complete in-line text.

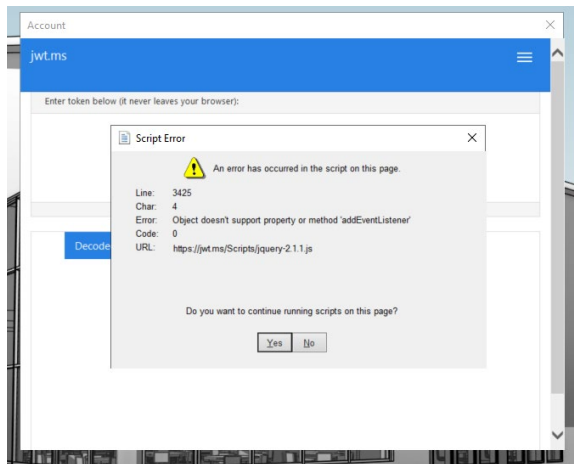
