

## Cost Volume Pro 3.6.101.1 Release Notes

Release Date: March 25, 2026

Welcome to the **Cost Volume Pro 3.6.101.1 Release Notes**, which describe the new features and enhancements introduced in this release.

These release notes address all of the modules associated with Cost Volume Pro version 3.6.101.1, some of which your firm may not use. Skip the sections that do not apply to your implementation.

### New

- Added a feature to include section titles when document is appended, which automatically inserts section titles from appended documents at the beginning of each corresponding section in the combined document. This preserves navigational context and improves clarity for users reviewing or exporting combined documents, particularly valuable for reviewers and auditors who require clear demarcation between appended content.
- Added a feature to preserve header/footer spacing to the Word Export feature that ensures when exporting an appended Word document, the 'from top' and 'from bottom' settings for headers and footers are preserved exactly as in the original uploaded document. This enhancement maintains visual and structural consistency between imported and exported Word documents, reducing manual reformatting effort for users after export.
- A new feature allows users to assign specific people to individual Structure sections in the Responsibility Assignment Matrix. This enhancement improves clarity and accountability in cost volume planning, helping to clarify ownership without changing existing editing permissions or triggering notifications.

### Enhancements

- Continuous numbering support has been added for appended Word documents. When AutoNumber is enabled, headings from appended documents are renumbered to continue the existing section outline, ensuring a coherent structure in delivered documents.
- Users can now insert pivot tables directly from ProPricer data into Cost Volume Pro documentation and analysis views. This feature streamlines the integration of financial data, supports dynamic reporting, and maintains formatting across various export formats.
- Header and Footer spacing settings from original uploaded Word documents are now preserved when exporting appended documents, ensuring consistent layout and reducing manual reformatting.

- The Section Editor now always displays current Header and Footer values, both for new and existing sections. This improves visibility and reduces accidental overwrites of important information.
- Auto numbering is now displayed for parent sections when users are creating a new section or copying an existing section, helping users quickly identify the correct parent section.
- Compatibility with ProPricer 9.6.101.1 has been added.

## Fixes

- A bug has been fixed where the 'Continuous' numbering option for batch reports was not functioning correctly. The system now properly applies continuous numbering across all reports in a batch when this option is selected.
- An issue where tables in headers and footers were losing alignment formatting in processed documents has been resolved. Tables in headers and footers now retain their configured alignment and indentation settings after document processing.
- A bug causing font setting changes to not apply inside tables has been fixed. Updates to font settings now correctly affect content within tables as expected.
- The issue of additional blank rows being added to bulleted lists, checklists, and numbered lists during cost volume processing has been resolved. Lists now appear in the output document without unwanted extra spacing.
- The Save button in the Header/Footer editor now correctly disables after the first save, preventing unnecessary subsequent saves when no changes have been made.
- A bug where header and footer alignment overrides were not persisting after saving has been fixed. Custom alignment settings for headers and footers now correctly save and maintain their overridden values.
- An issue where highlighted header text was being output to Word as text-specific shading has been corrected. Highlighted text now appears as expected in the exported Word documents.
- The problem of extra line breaks being added when appending Word documents has been resolved. This fix prevents unintended page breaks and maintains the original document structure more accurately.
- A bug where landscape PDF files were being imported into CVPro as portrait has been fixed. Landscape PDFs now correctly maintain their orientation when imported.
- The issue of appended document section titles not being included in the output document has been resolved. Section titles from appended documents now appear correctly in the final output.

- A documentation error where the 'Update from Template' feature was duplicated in release notes has been corrected. This feature is now correctly listed only in the 3.6.100.1 release notes.
- The problem of table alignment not being preserved in processed output has been fixed. Tables now maintain their assigned alignment settings (center, right, justify) in the final processed document.

### **Tech Debt**

- An improvement has been made to make attachments remember their positions. This enhancement will provide better consistency and user experience when working with document attachments in the system.
