Enhancements

This section includes enhancements in this release.

WA Family Leave Report Updates

For the updates of WA Cares reporting requirements effective October 1, 2023, you can now view the following information in the WA Family Leave Report (**Payroll System » Reports » Tax Reporting » State Paid Family Leave Reports » WA Family Leave Report**):

- Employees that are participants in PFML or Cares or both
- PFML gross taxable wages
- PFML Exempt column and Cares Exempt column containing yes or no information
- When PFML or Cares participation is unknown, a warning message is included in the report

- When the **Date of Birth** field is blank on the Employee *Name* window (**Payroll System » Maintenance Programs » Employee Maintenance**), an error message is included in the report

These updates provide additional information on the printed report and accommodate the specification revisions for electronic filing.

Note: For details about WA Cares reporting requirements, refer to the tax authority of Washington.

Withholding Section Updates of the Taxes Tab in Employee Window

On the Taxes tab of the Employee *Name* window (**Payroll System » Maintenance Programs » Employee Maintenance**), the following enhancements were made to the Withholding section:

- The **Federal Calculation** field and **Federal W-4** field is now replaced with an ellipsis menu for federal tax beside the state labels field.
- When you click the ellipsis menu for federal tax, a Federal Tax window is displayed where you can specify the following information:
 - **Filing Status**
 - **Federal W-4**
 - **Exemptions**
 - **Federal Calculation**
 - **Additional Annual Tax**
 - **Additional Period Tax**
 - **Annual Wage Adjust**
- When you click the ellipsis menu for state tax, a State Tax window is displayed where you can specify the following information:
 - **Filing Status**
 - **Personal Exemptions**
 - **Dependent Exemptions**
 - **Additional Annual Tax**
 - **Additional Period Tax**
 - **Annual Wage Adjust**
- The Additional Tax columns are now merged with the **Filing Status** field where information is specified as a single string similar to the Employee Master Report information.

Indiana WH-4 Elections for First Time Exemptions

To note first time claims of an exemption and additional exemption amounts, the following enhancements were made for an Indiana employer:

- In the Withholding section on the Taxes tab of the Employee *Name* window (**Payroll System » Maintenance Programs » Employee Maintenance**), you can now click the ellipsis menu for Indiana to display the Indiana State Tax window. Specifically in the Indiana State Tax window, you can now enter the following information:
 - **First Time Dependents:** Indicates the number of exemptions to be calculated at \$1500 per exemption for first time dependents
 - **Adopted Dependents:** Indicates the number of exemptions to be calculated at \$3000 per exemption for first time dependents
- On the Main tab of the 2023 IN Tax Settings window (**Payroll System » Maintenance Programs » Tax Rate Maintenance » State Tax Table Maintenance**), the following fields are now added:
 - **minus First Time Dependent Credits**
 - **minus Adopted Dependent Credits**

WA PFAML and WA Cares Updates in the Employee Window

On the Advanced tab of the Employee *Name* window (**Payroll System » Maintenance Programs » Employee Maintenance**), you can now configure WA Cares without enabling WA PFAML first and vice versa on the 2023 Paid Leave section.

Also, on the 2023 Paid Leave section, a **Participant** field is now available for WA CARES.

Note: If **Enable Paid Family and Medical Leave** is **Yes (Full)** or **Yes (Employee Only)** on the Main tab of the 2023 WA Tax Settings window (**Payroll System » Maintenance Programs » Tax Rate Maintenance » State Tax Table Maintenance**), all eligible employees should be configured to **Yes** in the **Participant** field of WA PFAML, WA CARES, or both on the 2023 Paid Leave section.

Employee Master Report Tax and Filing Status Information

When you generate an Employee Master Report (**Payroll System » Reports » Employee Master Report**), the information from the Tax and Filing Status sections are now taken from the Withholding section of the Taxes tab of the Employee *Name* window (**Payroll System » Maintenance Programs » Employee Maintenance**).

Software Issues Resolved

This section includes software issues resolved in this release.

ComputerEase Sometimes Crashed when Opening with Classic Menu Enabled

Defect 1974671: When you opened ComputerEase with classic menu enabled and with some items on the favorites menu, ComputerEase sometimes crashed.

ComputerEase Crashed when Importing Units with a Category Record but without a Job Record

Defect 1991672: When you tried to import units with a category record but without a related job record, ComputerEase crashed.

ComputerEase Sometimes Crashed when Opening Report Attachments using the Hover Popup

Defect 2000185: When you tried opening a report attachment from the hover popup, ComputerEase sometimes crashed.

Couldn't Save Expense Type Without a Default Cost Type

Defect 2000185: When you tried saving an expense type without a default cost type, you were unable to.

Effective October 1, 2023, the tax rates have changed for the following counties of Indiana:

Enhancements

This section includes enhancements in this release.

Import User-Defined Field (UDF) Values for General Ledger Accounts

On the Account ... window (**General Ledger » General Ledger Account Maintenance**), **Import Accounts...** under **File** was renamed to **Import from Another Company....** As long as both companies have the same account number format, you can use **Import from Another Company...** to copy one or more accounts from one company to another.

Under **File**, an **Import from File** option was also added. With **Import from File**, you can now create a flat file import layout to import general ledger information including User-Defined Field values. You can also use **Import from File** to globally add User-Defined Field data across your Chart of Accounts through a spreadsheet import.

Geo Arrival, Departure, and Job Presence of ComputerEase Field Time Entries for QTool Reports

Time Center is now able to record information about geo arrival, departure, and job presence for ComputerEase Field time entries. Therefore, where applicable, you can now generate a QTool report with the following information:

- Geo Arrival Date
- Geo Arrive Time
- Geo Departure Date
- Geo Departure Time
- Geo Hours
- Geo Job Presence

User Maintenance Setting for Signing Other Employees' Entries

On the Role window (**Configure » Field Management » Role Maintenance**), you can now select the **Allow Signing Other Employees Entries** checkbox. This enables the user in ComputerEase Field to sign time entries for their employees on their behalf.

The **Allow Signing Other Employees Entries** checkbox is only available when the **Enable Time** and **Allow Multiple Employee Entries** checkboxes are selected.

Auto-Populate Employee Information in User Maintenance

On the User window (**Configure » Field Management » User Maintenance**), when you add or update the **Employee** field, a prompt is displayed to confirm auto-population of the employee name, address, email, and phone number from an employee's Employee Maintenance record.

Also, the **Employee** field is now moved from the right side to the left side of the User window. The **Employee** field is always available as an optional field. However, the **Employee** field is required when the employee has a role with **Enable Time** selected in **Field Management » Role Maintenance**.

Software Issues Resolved

This section includes software issues resolved in this release.

Unable to Provide Access to User without Previous Access when Editing Multiple Users

Defect 1768040: When you edited the access of multiple users as a PW MAINT user, you were unable to provide module access to a user without existing module access.

Comments Field Crash on Field Log Management Center Window

Defect 1969097: When you hovered over the **Comments** field with over 1024 characters on the Field Log Management Center window (**Document Management » Field Log Management Center**), ComputerEase crashed.

Work on Non-Reimbursable Expenses Changes Not Reflected in ComputerEase Field

Defect 1970666: When you edited the job, phase, or category of a non-reimbursable expense retrieved from ComputerEase Field, the changes were not reflected in ComputerEase Field after saving.

Field App Management Missing from Configure

Defect 1972368: When you logged in as a user with only an ExpenseEase license, **Field App Management** was missing when you expanded **Configure**.

Misaligned 61 - 90 Column Heading for A/P Aging Report

Defect 1973346: When you generated an A/P Aging Report by vendor, the 61 - 90 column heading was misaligned.

Image at the Top of a Report Missing

Defect 1975205: When you generated a report with an image at the top of a page, the image was missing.

Custom Attachment Name for Reports not Used in Email

Defect 1975297: When you used a custom attachment name for a report in a report book, the custom attachment name was not used when you sent the report book using email.

Wrapping Issue in Job Center with a Long Job Name and Large Dashboard

Defect 1977695: When you opened Job Center with a long job name and a large dashboard, the job name wasn't shortened to fit and parts of the dashboard were misaligned.

Incorrect Number of Active Seats when Changing the Email Address of an Active User

Defect 1978439: When you changed the email address of an active user on the User Maintenance - *Company Name* window (**Configure » Field Management » User Maintenance**), ComputerEase may miscount the number of active users on the Time Users section and Expense Users section.

Generating Labor Distribution (with Equipment) QTool Report Returns Error

Defect 1974224: When you tried generating a Labor Distribution (with Equipment) QTool Report, an error is displayed.

Too Many Active Users Error for Work on Expenses

Defect 1985070: When you opened **Work on Reimbursable Expenses** or **Work on Non-Reimbursable Expenses** with a maximum of the users you are licensed for ComputerEase Expense, a dialog box is displayed that there are too many active users than allowed.

Union Local Information Missing on Payroll Entry Window for Time Center Records In Labor Distribution

Defect 1984511: When you opened the Payroll Entry window of a Time Center record in Labor Distribution, the information was missing in the **Union Local** field.
