Description: When you added a new record on the Salary Details subtask of the Manage Employee Information screen and ran Export Data To Deltek Time and Expense, the default expense class was not exported in the Employee History file, even though there is an expense class listed on the Manage Vendors screen for the employee. This caused Deltek Time and Expense (TE) to assign the default expense class setup in TE, which may differ from what is set up in Manage Vendors.

Customers Impacted: This defect affects you if you export data to Deltek Time and Expense.

Workaround Before Fix: None.

Description: When an Employee ID was linked on the Manage Vendors screen, it was not considered a change in employee record. The record for the corresponding Vendor ID was not included when data was exported to Deltek Time & Expense. This happened even if the **Changes Since Last Download** check box was selected.

Customers Impacted: This defect affects you if you export data to Deltek Time & Expense within Costpoint.

Workaround Before Fix: None.

Description: The quotation marks (") and commas (,) inside a string value in the exported file should be preceded by a backslash (\) to indicate that the characters are part of a string value. This should be applied to avoid errors when uploading the file in the Deltek Time and Expense import application.

Customers Impacted: This defect affects Costpoint Labor users who export data to Deltek Time and Expense.

Workaround Before Fix: Manually correct the .CSV file that the application generates.

Issues Resolved:

Description: The application created a blank UDT02 file when exporting both projects and manufacturing orders at the same time. This issue occurred when the project data contained updates and the manufacturing order data did not have any updates.

Customers Impacted: This defect affects Costpoint users who export data to Deltek Time and Expense.

Workaround Before Fix: When exporting Base/Link Tables, run the export for manufacturing order data separately from project data.
